GUIDANCE

HOW TO WORK SMARTER ?

1 NO DISTRACTIONS

Distractions like social media, texting, or even just the notification sound are proven to be the number one cause for low productivity in work. Decide on a specific period of time you're going to work and turn off your phone/turn on the airplane mode so you don't have any distractions while working. Only practising this daily take your focus and productivity to a new level.

2 USE THE POMODORO TECHNIQUE

Studies show that working in chunks of work increase productivity in work. Cut your work into 25-30 minutes of work, and then 5-10 minutes rest. In the working time, your only focus is getting one thing done. Turn on the airplane mode and focus for 30 min. Once the timer goes off, take a break to get physically moving, take a short rest, and prepare for the next Pomodoro. Usually after 4 sessions of 30 minutes it's better to plan a longer break for 30-50 min.

3 OUTSOURCE

Find your strengths and focus on them. Find your weak areas, and find the right person whose weakness is his strength. For example, you are really good at copywriting for your business, but design is your weakness. Focus your time writing more copy, and find the right person to take that copy and make designs out of it. This will help you achieve more in less time and maintain the highest quality.

4 THE 6 GOALS RULE

Aiming to finish 20 tasks in one day will probably just get you to procrastinate most of your work without focusing on quality. Every single day, aim to finish not more than 6 things. Work until finishing those 6 goals for the day. Tasks that you didn't finish will always move to the next day. So if you have finished 4 tasks, you can only add 4 more for the next day, keeping your list clean with 6 tasks at a time.

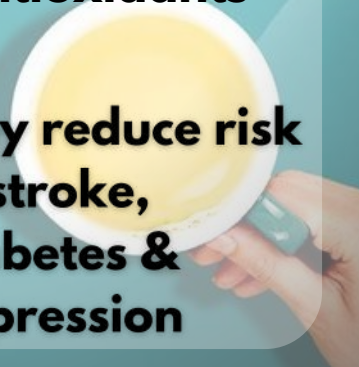

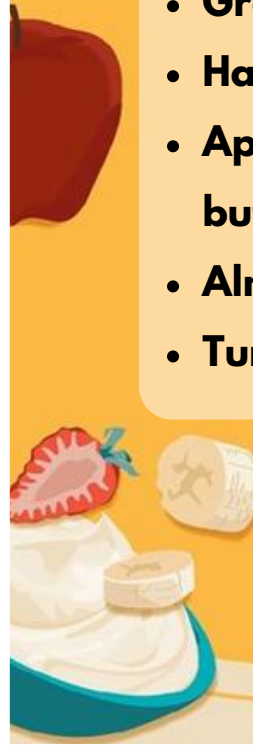

FALL OF AFGANISTHAN, RISE OF TALIBANS

Afghanistan's name was changed to the "Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan" – a name that was given to the country 20 years ago by the Taliban government that was ousted by United States-led forces after the twin tower attack in September 2001.



WHO ARE THEY?

TALIBAN is an armed extremists group that ruled Afghanistan from 1996 until the U.S. led invasion in 2001.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN AFGHANISTAN?

Taliban's lost control over Afghanistan is now renewed. They are an International terrorist threat and, more the terror attacks the many will flee the fight as refugees, putting strain in neighbouring countries. The region will destabilise further allowing more extremist groups to thrive. Women will lose their complete freedom, they will neither be able to go to school nor work.

WHO IS FUNDING THEM?

According to a U.N report most of The Taliban's money comes from various criminal activities such as drug trafficking, illegal mining etc. Drug trafficking and illegal mining may have alone earned them \$924 million. There has been some reports which state that U.S has indirectly supplied them with money and arms. Contradictory U.S blames Russia and China for supplying them with arms.

For the past 20 years, the U.S has spent around \$ 1000 billion, lost thousands of their soldiers, killed countless Afghan civilians and displaced nearly 4 million Afghans. What for? To make peace with enemy they had created in the first place and wanted to eliminate. At the end to leaving Afghanistan in the same, if not worse, situation that they started with. While there is no clear solution to this problem, we need to confront it now before it becomes the next Syria or Iraq.

CODE RED FOR HUMANITY

The landmark study warns of increasingly extreme heatwaves, droughts, and flooding, and the temperature limit is broken in just over a decade. The IPCC report "is a code red for humanity" says the UN chief. The rise of sea level of 2m by the end of this century cannot be ruled out - and neither can a 5m rise by 2150. Such outcomes, while unlikely, would threaten millions of people in coastal areas with flooding by 2100. IPCC reports state that coastal cities in India will get submerged by 2150. China received a rain of 300 days in just 3 days. The authors believe that 1.5 degree Celsius will be reached by 2040 in all scenarios. If emissions aren't slashed in the next few years, this will happen even earlier.



The consequences of going past 1.5 degrees Celsius for years would be unwelcome in a world that has already experienced a rapid uptick in extreme events with a temperature rise since pre-industrial times of 1.1 degrees Celsius.

What can be done:

- Use of electric vehicle
- Conserve forest & protect green space
- Increase of recycled products
- Reduce fossil energy use & switch to renewable source of energy
- Educate yourself & others about impact of climate change and how to act against it

Canada: The searing heat that scorched western Canada and the US at the end of June was "virtually impossible" without climate change, say scientists.

Europe: At least 120 people have died and hundreds more in western Europe are unaccounted for after the worst flooding in decades.

TESLA SAYS IT IS BUILDING A 'FRIENDLY' ROBOT THAT WILL PERFORM MENIAL TASKS, WON'T FIGHT BACK.

SAN FRANCISCO — Tesla has a history of making big promises. But its newest one is just average size, about 5-foot-8 and 125 pounds, according to CEO and self-professed “Technoking” Elon Musk.

Tesla says it plans to build a humanoid robot to perform basic tasks, such as wrenching on cars or making grocery runs. It's part of the company's broader ambitions in automation, which include building its own computer chip, dubbed the D1, to power the networks for vehicles it hopes to one day make self-driving.





DIY PALLET PLAQUES

Here's what you'll need for each plaque:

- 1 piece of 1/2" x 3" x 36" craft boards
- 1 piece of 1/2" x 2" x 36" craft board (you'll only need about 16" of the board for each plaque)
- Wood Glue
- Sander or sandpaper
- Chalk paint craft paint, or stain depending on the look you're going for.
- Bulldog Clips
- Small 1/2" - 3/4" long screws
- Saw (I simply used a handsaw to cut through the boards)
- Jute rope | twine | ribbon | yarn to make a hanger for your pallet.
- Staple gun or tack to hold hanger onto the back of the pallet

Steps

And here's how they come together:

1. Using a saw, cut your 3" board into three 12" sections.
2. Next, cut the 2" board into 8" sections (you'll need two of these 8" sections for each plaque).
3. Using a hand sander or sandpaper, sand the edges and corners of all the pieces to create a worn look.
4. Because I wanted to paint to look thin ... almost like a stain with the wood grain showing through, I watered gray chalk paint down with equal parts water and paint before painting it onto each piece.
5. After the paint has dried, simply place wood glue onto the back of each 2" piece, and glue these to the three 3" boards on the top and bottom as shown in FIG2

6. Allow the glue to dry, then create a jute hanger for your pallet.

7. Cut a piece of jute or (twine/ribbon/yarn) and staple each side to the back of the plaque as shown. Don't have a staple gun? You could simply use a thumb or small nail to secure the jute ends to the plaque.

8. Next, attach your bulldog clip to the front of the plaque with a short screw
