• Please note that ALL absences must be reported/requested using the attendance@surreymathsschool.co.uk inbox, including instances where your child needs to leave during the school day. We take registers throughout the day, to ensure that each student is safe and in the right place: and if we don't know where a young person is this presents a safeguarding risk. It also potentially places a member of staff at risk (e.g. if we have a fire evacuation).

PASTORAL UPDATE

On Monday, all students will attend an assembly about being an Active Bystander. This will be led by an organisation called "Talk Consent", who also visited Year 13 last year to deliver a workshop around consent. The assembly is designed to empower students to feel confident challenging attitudes and expressions like misogyny, harmful stereotypes and objectification. The session will cover:

- Why it is important to challenge negative behaviour and sexual violence.
- What needs to be challenged and how certain beliefs and attitudes can enable sexual violence.
- How to feel confident challenging someone in a way that ensures you stay safe.

We are aware that these themes may be difficult for particular students, and have asked them to contact us if they have any concerns about the assembly. If you would like more information about the content then please also get in touch.
