About Sydney Trains

We operate rail services across the Sydney metropolitan area bounded by Berowra, Emu Plains, Macarthur, Richmond, Leppington, Cronulla, Bondi Junction and Waterfall. We also operate intercity services across NSW to Scone, Dungog, Richmond, Bathurst, Leppington, Goulburn, Bomaderry, and Port Kembla.

With a staff of over 13,000 people, Sydney Trains also operates and maintains assets such as tracks, trains, signals, overhead wiring, stations and facilities, as well as maintaining trains and a large proportion of the infrastructure used by NSW TrainLink. The total value of the asset portfolio we maintain is around \$44 billion, with a cost of operations of \$5 billion – which makes Sydney Trains the largest public transport system in Australia.

Sydney Trains also plays a vital role in supporting the freight supply chain, helping to transport goods and services across the rail network.

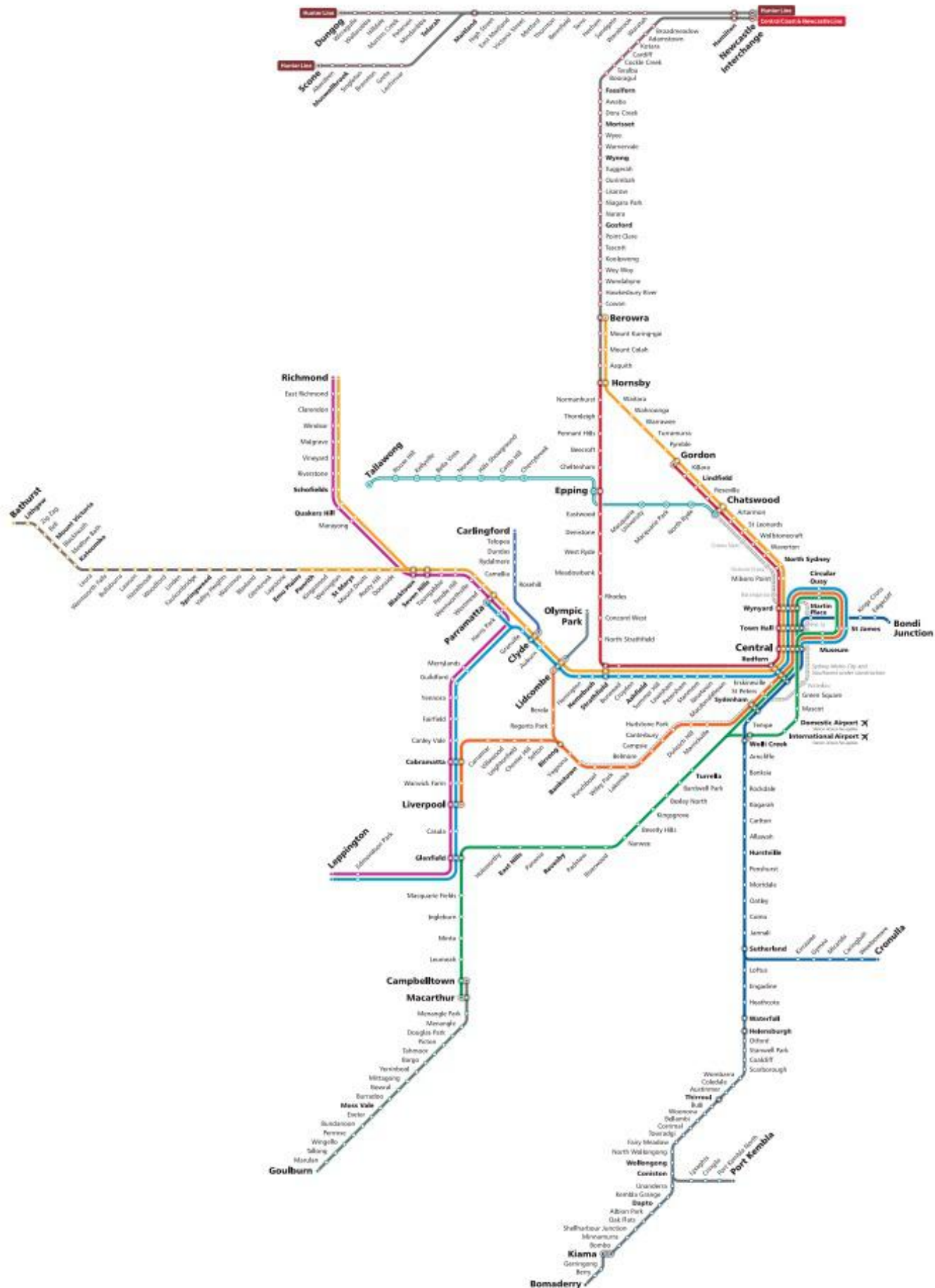

(including intercity services)

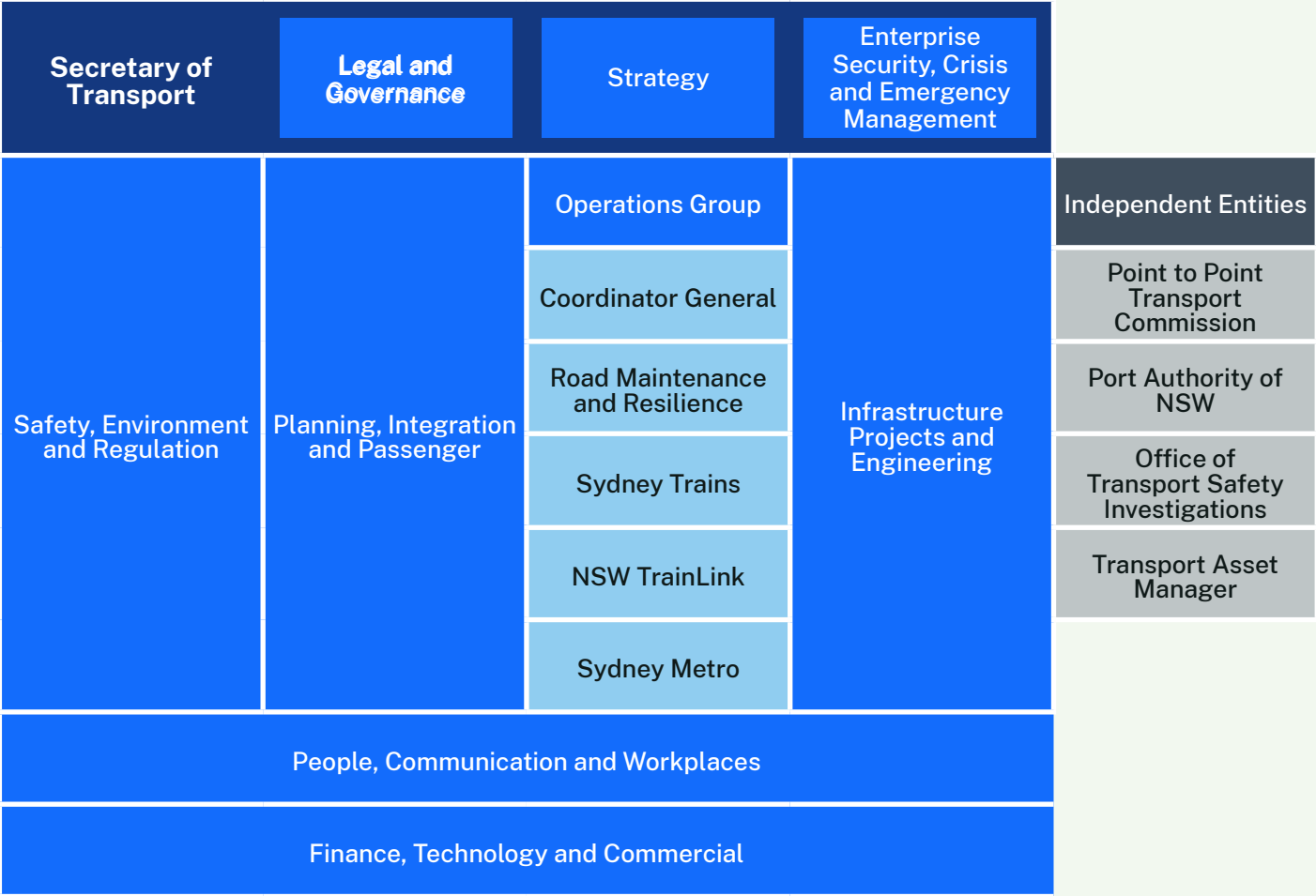


Transport’s operating model
