As cancer incidence rises and survivorship increases, the need for accessible, wrap-around supportive cancer care has never been greater. InspireHealth plays a critical role in bridging gaps in care, ensuring that those affected by cancer, regardless of geography or



Strategic Goals

Expand InspireHealth's Reach and Impact

Support more people affected by cancer through increased access to supportive care by expanding InspireHealth's programs and services in priority communities, delivering responsive and culturally relevant programming, strengthening outreach and collaboration, and raising awareness of services. This goal is grounded in InspireHealth's whole-person model of care and aligns with broader health system priorities to contribute to system-wide impact.

2 Diversify Revenue to Enhance Financial Sustainability and Support Growth

Build a flexible and resilient funding model by strengthening traditional fundraising, developing new revenue streams, maintaining Ministry funding and relationships, and demonstrating InspireHealth's value through person-centred storytelling and outcomes. Diversifying revenue sources will ensure long-term sustainability and support continued program growth and mission impact.

Strengthen Organizational Capacity and Effectiveness

1 Expand InspireHealth's Reach and Impact

InspireHealth is committed to increasing access to supportive cancer care through expanded presence, relevant and timely programming, stakeholder collaboration, and greater service awareness. Guided by its values and whole-person approach to care along with broader health system priorities, InspireHealth will deliver equitable, person-centred care across the province and beyond.

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Grow InspireHealth's reach to those affected by cancer

Increase InspireHealth's reach to cancer patients in current Centre locations and expand InspireHealth's presence in priority communities, including Kamloops and Surrey, to increase access to supportive cancer care across BC. Growth efforts will focus on removing geographic barriers and reaching underserved groups, including Indigenous, Asian & South Asian, rural and remote, Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) cancer patients, and other equity-deserving communities. InspireHealth will also expand services beyond BC, where aligned with its mission and capacity.

* Deliver timely and relevant programming to meet the needs of those affected by cancer.

Ensure programs remain relevant by using feedback and evaluation to identify gaps and meet the needs and priorities of patients and their loved ones. As caregiver support is a core part of InspireHealth's model, programming will continue to reflect their essential role in the cancer journey. Delivering compassionate and culturally relevant, personcentred care will help ensure services reflect the diversity and complexity of cancer experiences and contribute to a more equitable cancer care system.

* Strengthen outreach and collaboration to deepen healthcare and community relationships and expand impact.

Take a collaborative, relationship-based approach to outreach and partnership development, grounded in shared purpose. This mission-driven work will strengthen connections with priority communities, community organizations, and healthcare partners, extending patient access to supportive cancer care. InspireHealth will work with key cancer care partners and organizations to help fill gaps and to help ensure patients and caregivers receive comprehensive, person-centred support.

* Increase organizational and service awareness through targeted marketing and communications.

Build awareness through marketing and outreach to ensure more patients, along with their families, caregivers, and support networks, are aware of and can access InspireHealth's supportive cancer care services. Increase awareness among healthcare providers and community organizations to strengthen referrals, enhance credibility and deepen community engagement.

* Support & collaborate in research that demonstrates the impact of supportive cancer care.

Collaborate with researchers by providing Letters of Support and also as an implementation partner to demonstrate the health benefits and cost-savings of supportive cancer care. This work will strengthen the broader healthcare system, inform policy, and help secure ongoing support for integrated, person-centred supportive care services.



Diversify Revenue to Enhance Financial Sustainability and Support Growth

Achieving long-term sustainability requires a balanced mix of funding sources that support InspireHealth's mission and growth. This goal focuses on broadening traditional fundraising efforts, developing new revenue-generating models, strengthening key donor relationships, and demonstrating InspireHealth's value through storytelling that deepens donor and community engagement.

* Broaden traditional fund development strategies to strengthen financial stability, sustainability, and impact.

Expand and diversify fundraising efforts to build a more resilient and sustainable funding model. While recognizing that events could remain an important part of the approach, InspireHealth will continue to grow other traditional fundraising channels such as individual and monthly giving, and other areas of philanthropic giving. These efforts, along with ongoing income from established investment strategies, will continue to support the organization's financial health, strategic priorities, and mission impact, without compromising its vision.

* Identify and develop new revenue models and partnerships to increase flexible and sustainable funding.

Explore opportunities such as social enterprise, education and training programs, licensing, franchising, and product-based offerings to complement existing funding. Strategic partnerships may support program growth regionally or nationally, while considering select international initiatives that align with InspireHealth's mission. Assessing feasibility and resource requirements will ensure new models are mission-aligned, viable, and impactful.

* Amplify InspireHealth's communication and story to strengthen donor engagement and funding.

Develop a clear and compelling narrative about the impact of InspireHealth's programs and services on those affected by cancer, supported by evidence of patient satisfaction and outcomes. Demonstrating InspireHealth's value through both stories and data will deepen donor engagement and advance the organization's revenue strategy.

* Maintain and strengthen Ministry funding through alignment of priorities and impact.

Maintain and deepen key relationships with the Province, including the Ministry of Health, by demonstrating alignment with health system priorities including the Province's 10-Year Cancer Action Plan, and the value of InspireHealth's community-based supportive cancer care model. Ongoing strategic engagement and impact reporting will help ensure this critical funding remains stable and positioned for continued growth and long-term sustainability.



Strengthen Organizational Capacity and Effectiveness

Investing in technology, internal systems, and people is central to delivering a seamless, engaging, and person-centred experience for all patients. This goal focuses on optimizing digital infrastructure, fostering a strong, values-driven team, strengthening partnerships and networks, and embedding clear, sustainable risk management practices. These efforts will ensure InspireHealth has the capacity, adaptability, and infrastructure needed to grow its impact and remain a trusted leader in supportive cancer care.

* Invest in technology to enhance patient experience and improve efficiency.

Building on existing efforts to optimize systems and workflows, InspireHealth will expand its digital capacity to meet growing organizational and patient needs. Strategic investment in infrastructure, tools, and support, including continued development of InspireHealth's website and hybrid delivery model, will improve access to care by delivering an easy and engaging patient experience, streamlining operations, and supporting data-informed decision-making. These efforts will reinforce InspireHealth's leadership in supportive cancer care and help the organization remain competitive in an evolving healthcare landscape.

* Maintain and enhance human resources practices to support staff engagement, development, and well-being.

InspireHealth is committed to sustaining strong human resources practices that foster staff engagement, professional development, recognition, and well-being. Through a comprehensive approach to employee support, InspireHealth will continue to attract, retain, and grow a resilient, values-aligned team capable of delivering compassionate, personcentred care.

* Strengthen networks and partnerships to enhance service delivery and organizational capacity.

Build and leverage a broad network of support, including volunteers, advisors, consultants, and strategic partners, to strengthen InspireHealth's capacity and enhance all aspects of operations including program delivery. These partnerships also bring valuable knowledge, expertise and resources that help InspireHealth remain responsive to the needs and priorities of those it serves. Together, these efforts will expand reach, sustain operations and ensure organizational growth.

* Strengthen organizational resilience through clear and sustainable risk management practices.

Build on InspireHealth's existing enterprise risk management (ERM) framework to support a simple, organization-wide approach to identifying and managing key risks, including financial, operational, reputational, and information systems. A structured process for regularly reviewing and refining risk mitigation strategies will support long-term sustainability and adaptability. Board-level oversight and accountability will help ensure strong governance and foster a culture of proactive risk management across the organization.
