The tournament also allowed for small business owners and entrepreneurs in the constituency to earn an extra dollar by retailing their goods during matches. The tournament is expected to be an annual tournament but interruption from Covid19 has temporarily paused the execution of the annual event. The constituency is rich with talent and Ryan intends to build on this and execute a full calendar of sporting events.

#### **CONNECTING THROUGH SUPPORT**

Our communities have been hard hit by the coronavirus. Many persons have been displaced from work or have seen a reduction of income due to curfews and lockdowns. Ryan has been there for his constituents and he continues to, where possible, provide for vulnerable families. In April of 2020, Ryan delivered over 250 Covid Care packages to needy persons across the constituency. This out reach program continued into a hamper distribution during Christmas.

In 2019, Ryan spearheaded a fund raising event to assist one of his constituents who was in need of critical medical care abroad. He was glad to be apart of such an initiative that in the end contributed to the constituent and her family overcoming a very difficult period in the lives.
