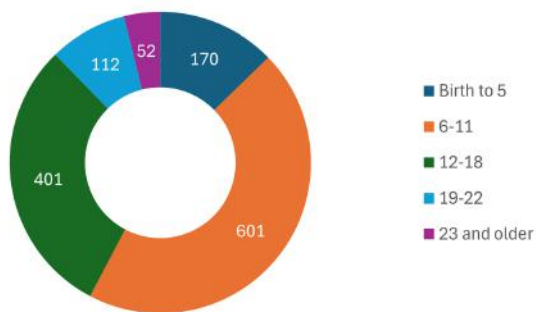
CONNECTING TO PARENTS

Inclusion. We believe inclusion is vital both for our work culture and for families with disabilities. We strive for inclusive communities where children and adults with disabilities can live the life they choose.

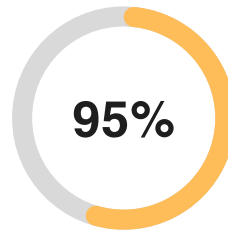
Our Impact on Children with Disabilities and their families



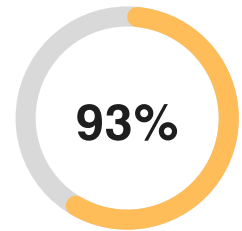

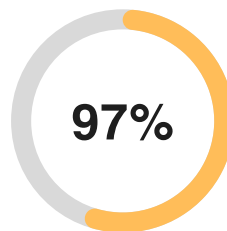
OUR IMPACT ON FAMILIES:



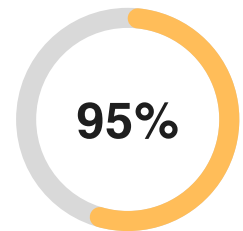
Of families reported receiving relevant information needed to make decisions about their child’s education.
