Paris


DAY 2


In the Steps of Vincent Van Gogh

Conflans

Early this morning, arrive in Conflans-Saint-Honorine, a charming town at the meeting point of the Oise and Seine rivers. From here, join a guided tour to Auvers-sur-Oise, a picturesque village that inspired many Impressionist painters, including Cézanne, Pissarro, and Daubigny.

Auvers-sur-Oise is perhaps most famously linked to Vincent van Gogh, who spent his final days here. Walk through the town's narrow lanes, past shuttered houses and blooming gardens, and visit Van Gogh's final resting place. Depart in the late afternoon, continuing your scenic cruise along the Seine.





DAY 3 The City of 100 Spires

Rouen

Arrive in Rouen, the capital of Normandy, known for its impressive Gothic architecture and rich history. Start with a guided walking tour of the city, where you'll visit the magnificent Rouen Cathedral, famously depicted by Monet, and the Church of Joan of Arc, with its stunning 16th-century stained glass.

In the afternoon, travel to a traditional Normandy farmhouse, Le Pressoir d'Or, for a cider tasting experience. Explore the orchard and learn about the region's apple traditions before enjoying free time in the charming village of Lyons-la-Forêt. Later, return to the ship and continue your journey northward along the Seine.

DAY 4

Le Havre



CLIFF PATHS AND HISTORIC HARBORS

Arrive in the bustling port city of Le Havre, your gateway to Normandy's stunning coast. Begin the day with an excursion to Honfleur, a picturesque town with a historic harbor framed by 16th- to 18th-century townhouses. Stroll along the waterfront and enjoy the charm that has inspired countless artists.

In the afternoon, explore the breathtaking cliff paths of Étretat, known for its dramatic chalk cliffs and needle-like rock formations. Later, return to the ship for an evening of French culture on board, with local chanson singers providing an authentic taste of Normandy's musical heritage.



DAY 5

WWII History and Normandy Heritage

Le Havre & Caudebec-en-Caux



Begin the day with an exploration of Normandy's WWII history, visiting Arromanches, the site of the D-Day landings, where remnants of the Mulberry harbors still stand. This moving experience offers insights into one of history's most pivotal events and the bravery of those involved.

Alternatively, visit Fécamp, a charming seaside town known for Le Palais Bénédictine, the historic distillery of the renowned Benedictine liqueur. In the afternoon, return to Caudebec-en-Caux, where you'll rejoin the ship for a relaxing evening as the vessel continues along the Seine.

Monet's Garden and French Royalty

Start your day in Les Andelys, with an option to visit Château Gaillard, the historic fortress of King Richard the Lionheart. Continue to Giverny, where you'll explore Claude Monet's home and stunning gardens, the inspiration for many of his iconic works.

After lunch, enjoy an excursion to Château de Malmaison, the elegant former residence of Joséphine and Napoleon Bonaparte. In the evening, rejoin the ship in Mantes-la-Jolie for the Captain's Gala Dinner as you sail back toward Paris.





DAY 7

Paris

Exploring the City of Light

Arrive back in Paris in the early morning for a full day of exploration. Begin with a city tour to iconic landmarks like the Eiffel Tower, the Champs-Élysées, and Notre-Dame Cathedral, immersing yourself in the charm and history of Paris.

In the afternoon, stroll through the artistic neighborhood of Montmartre, with its cobbled streets, quaint cafés, and the stunning Sacré-Cœur Basilica. Conclude the day with the Captain's Gala Dinner on board, enjoying a final view of the illuminated Parisian skyline.
