CREATING PLACEMENT STABILITY

It is all too common for children to move between placements multiple times during their time in foster care.

Every time a placement changes, a child's caregivers, siblings, home, school, friends, and routines also change. This instability, combined with past trauma, can not only cause children to feel unworthy, but also lead to falling months behind in school and missing crucial developmental milestones.

Placement stability is one of THE most important aspects of healing for a child experiencing foster care.

There are so many amazing foster parents out there, but the unfortunate reality is that half of foster homes close within the first year - not because they lack heart or intention, but because they are not equipped or are poorly supported.

We provide whole-family care encouraging and supporting both
parents and children, and ensuring that
parents have all of the tools they need to
keep children in their home for as long
as possible.

LOVE BOX

Every year over a quarter of a million children enter into foster care in the U.S.

The Charlotte Angels Love Box program focuses on holistically supporting and sustaining fostering families. Volunteers spend time building relationships with all members of the family by playing games, sharing meals, and connecting, while also delivering monthly personal care packages (referred to as "Love Boxes") based on the family's current needs. The program is designed to increase placement stability and build an infrastructure of support around the home. Volunteers are matched with a fostering family based on location, compatibility, and scope of needs. This program requires a one-time-per-month, one-year commitment.

DARE TO DREAM MENTORSHIP

25,000 youth age out of foster care every year, often with limited resources and family ties.

The Dare to Dream program focuses on one-on-one mentoring for youth (ages 11-22) who are in care, at risk to age out, or have aged out. Mentors serve as positive role models who meet with their youth to build relationships and empower them to accomplish their goals. Our tailored developmental milestone model equips youth to succeed and be prepared for adulthood. A mentor commits to initiating hangouts with the youth twice monthly to build a relationship, set and accomplish goals, and help them achieve their dreams. The program commitment is one year, but these connections will hopefully last a lifetime.
