The project begins with a comprehensive review and refinement of the analytical framework for STEM talent demand and supply, ensuring that it is well-aligned with the objectives of the Demand Dynamic Analysis (DDA). This step is crucial in establishing a robust foundation that accurately captures the dynamics between workforce needs and talent availability. A detailed assessment of data readiness and availability is conducted, involving collaboration with relevant agencies to evaluate existing datasets for both demand and supply components. This includes identifying gaps, inconsistencies, and opportunities for data integration to strengthen the overall analysis. To further support the implementation of the framework, participants are equipped with essential analytical skills through targeted training sessions.

These sessions focus on basic analytical techniques and the development of projections using real datasets, with hands-on application through tools such as Excel and modelling approaches. Collectively, these efforts aim to enhance both the quality of analysis and the capacity of stakeholders to generate data-driven insights for informed decision-making.

This activity enhanced the Ministry's reputation through the production of high-impact academic publications, and strengthening officers' capabilities in making evidence-based decisions. Overall, it enhanced MOSTI's capacity to formulate more effective policies and interventions.

NATIONAL WAGES CONSULTATIVE COUNCIL MALAYSIA

The initiative focuses on conducting a comprehensive study on wage levels across various sectors nationwide, alongside analysing key economic factors such as inflation, cost of living, and workers' basic needs to assess the necessity of increasing the minimum wage. As part of this effort, discussions and consultation sessions were held with key stakeholders, including employers, labour unions, employee representatives, and government agencies, to gather diverse perspectives and feedback. Particular attention is given to collecting views from affected groups, such as informal sector workers and small employers, to ensure a more inclusive and balanced assessment.

The expected outcomes of this initiative highlight its broader significance. An increase in the minimum wage has the potential to improve the standard of living for low-income workers, enabling them to better meet their basic needs. At the same time, establishing an appropriate minimum wage level can help reduce income inequality between low- and high-income groups within the country. It contributes to a more sustainable economic environment by ensuring that workers possess sufficient purchasing power, which in turn supports domestic demand and overall economic growth.

An Anti-Sexual Harassment talk was conducted for Form 4 students to raise awareness about the various forms of sexual harassment, students' rights in risky situations, as well as the appropriate preventive measures and reporting channels. Students were exposed to topics such as safe body language, personal boundaries, and appropriate ways to respond when facing uncomfortable situations. Interactive activities were also carried out through brief case discussions to help students identify situations involving sexual harassment and understand the appropriate actions to take.

The objectives of this initiative are centered on equipping students with essential knowledge and awareness to ensure their personal safety. It aims to increase students' understanding of the meaning, various forms, and warning signs of sexual harassment, both within the school environment and in their daily lives. In addition, the initiative seeks to educate students about their right to personal safety, with a strong emphasis on respecting personal boundaries and understanding the concept of consent. It also focuses on helping students identify potentially risky situations and equipping them with practical preventive measures, enabling them to better protect themselves from sexual harassment and respond appropriately when faced with such circumstances.

The programme centred on fostering deeper awareness and stronger appreciation of sustainable practices, particularly within the framework of the circular economy. It seeks to increase participants' understanding of the importance of integrating green practices into their daily lives, highlighting how individual actions can collectively contribute to environmental sustainability. At the same time, the programme exposes participants to practical and innovative approaches to reusing resources, demonstrating how materials that are often discarded can be repurposed in meaningful and valuable ways. In doing so, it also introduces participants to the potential of generating income through upcycling, encouraging an entrepreneurial mindset where waste is transformed into marketable products.



Overall, the programme was positively received, with participants expressing a high level of satisfaction with both the content and delivery of the activities. Many indicated their interest in seeing similar programmes organised in the future, reflecting the relevance and impact of the initiative. Participants also reported that the programme had successfully encouraged them to adopt a more creative approach in repurposing materials and to become more mindful of their consumption and waste habits. This suggests that the programme not only raised awareness but also inspired behavioural change, reinforcing its role in promoting sustainable practices and supporting the broader goals of environmental responsibility and resource efficiency.

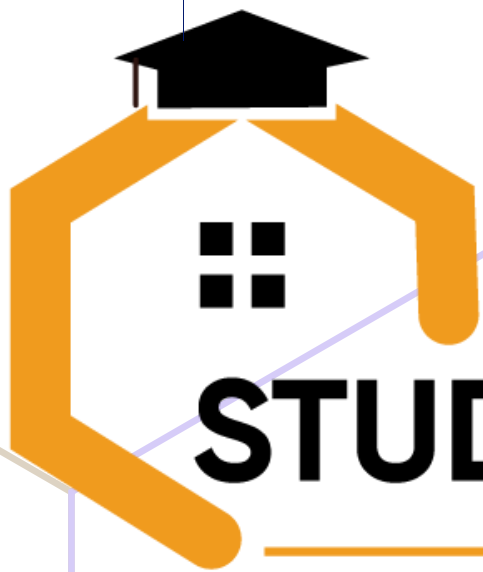

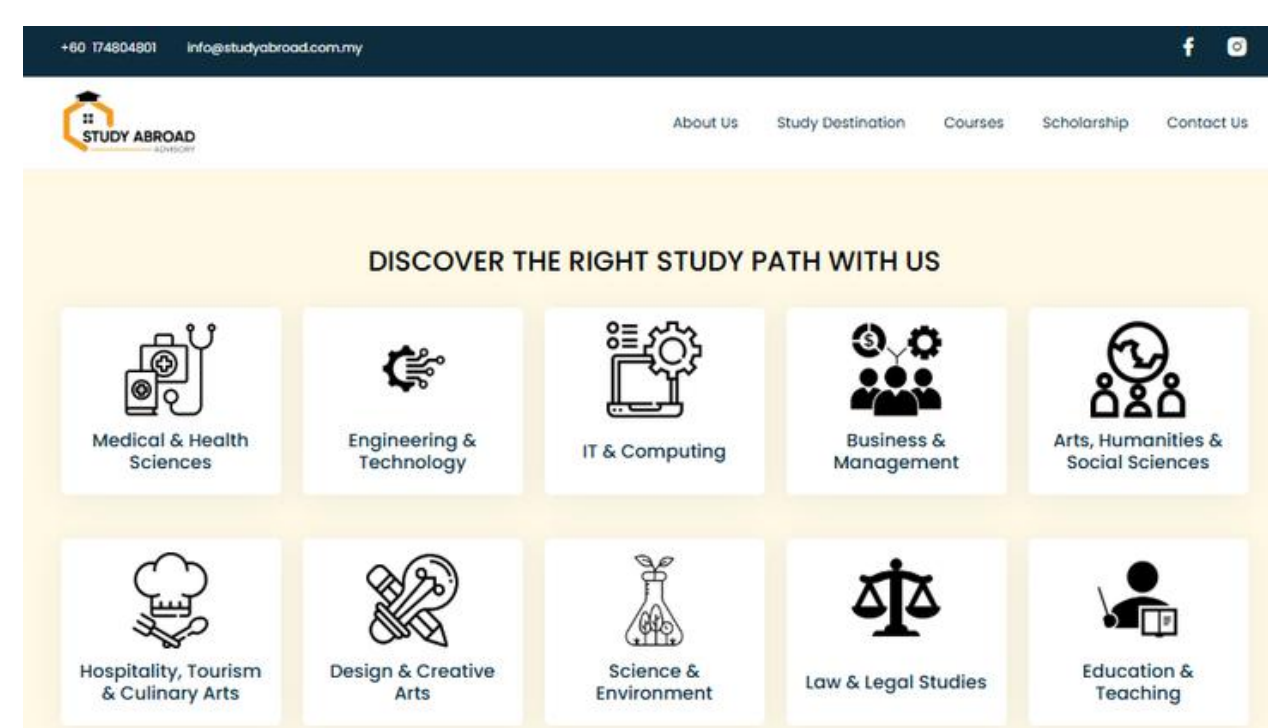
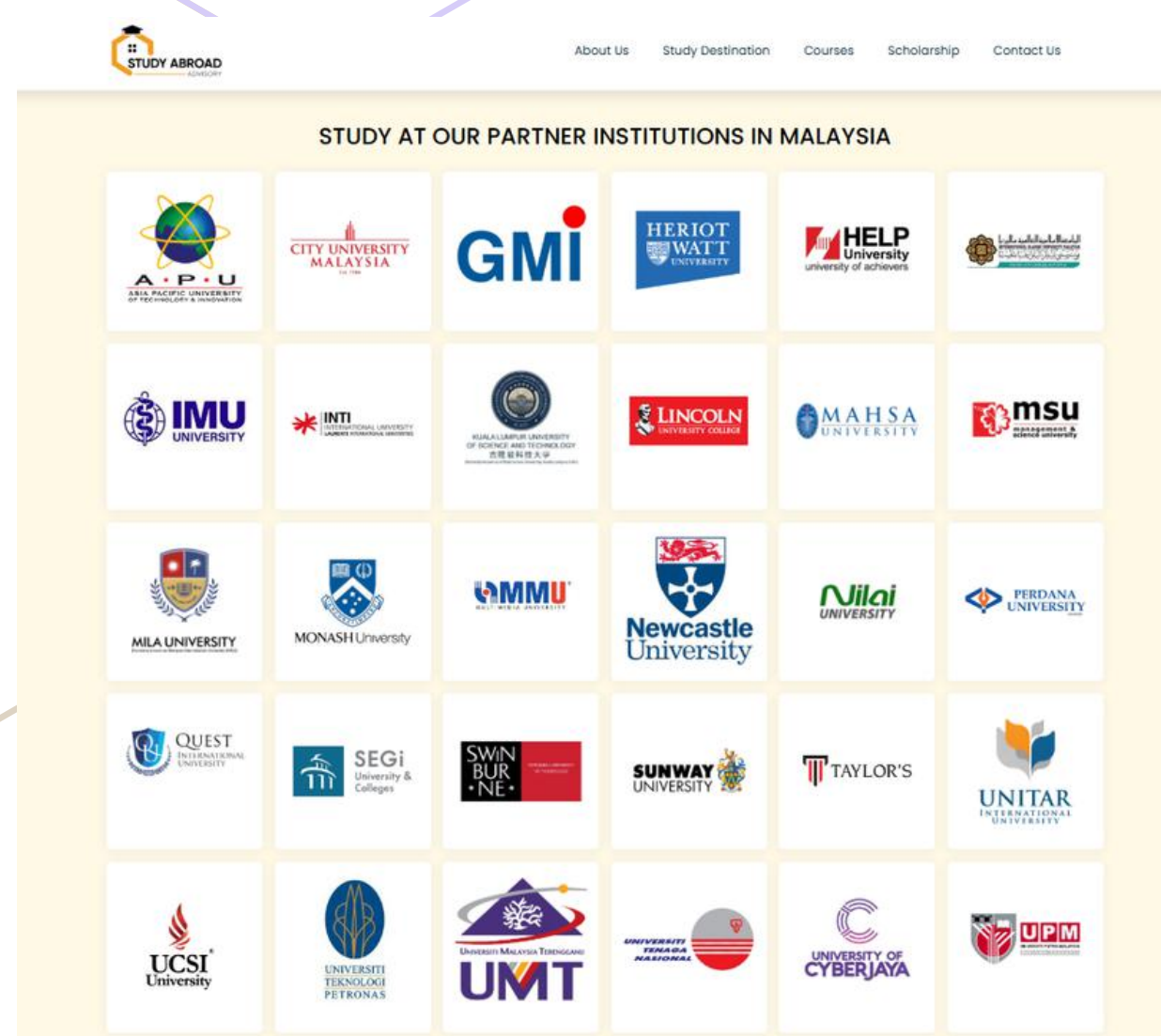
