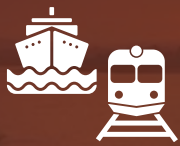

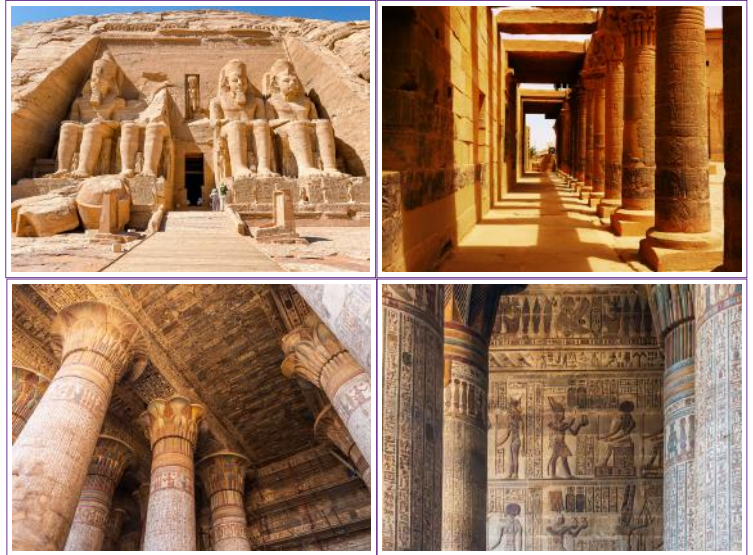
Enjoy a relaxing walk around the island, experiencing the beauty of nature and local village life, before spending a memorable overnight stay on board.

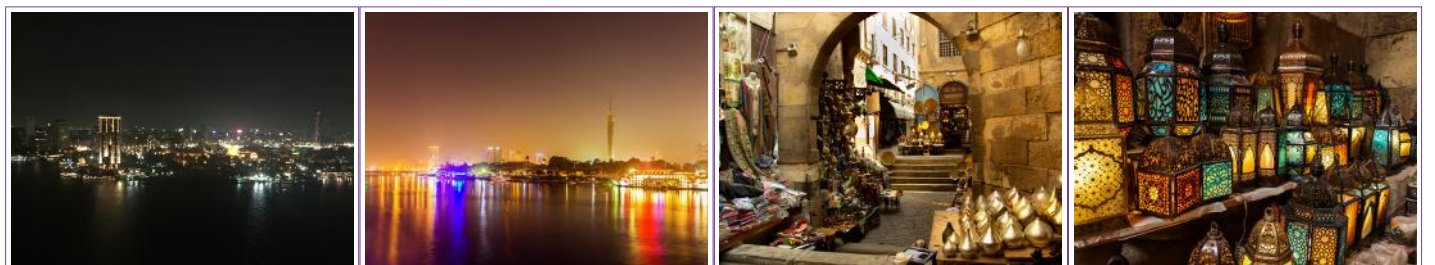
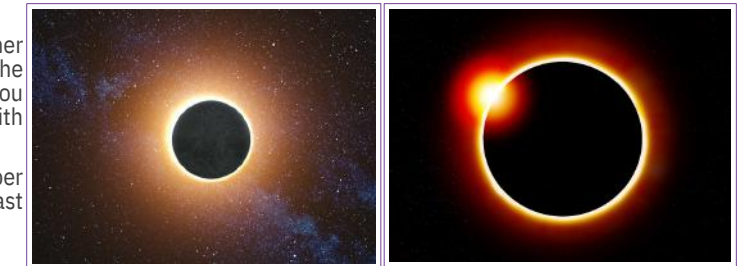

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to Cairo International Airport for your onward flight.

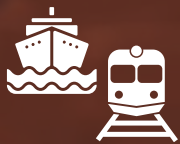

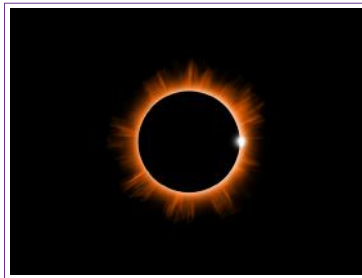


August 2 – Arrival in Luxor & Eclipse Viewing

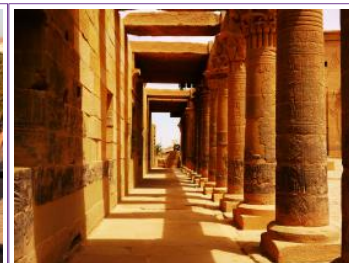
August 5 – Highlights of Aswan

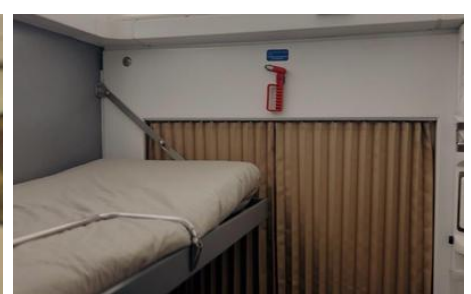
