

GOAL FEST FRANKS

To twas raining goals across South Yorkshire this weekend as local clubs went on a scoring spree that lit up the non-league scene.

Top of the pile were Armthorpe Welfare, who stunned Glasshoughton Welfare with an astonishing 8–1 demolition in the Northern Counties East League Division One. Even more remarkable was the late flurry—five goals after the 88th minute—as Bayley Lowe bagged a hat-trick, Alfie Charlotte struck twice, and Will Mendonca, Harley McCormack, and Charlie Clegg all got in on the act.

Not to be outdone, Dearne & District flexed their title credentials on Friday night with a 7–0 thrashing of Nostell Miners Welfare, extending their lead at the top of the table to five points. Adam Baskerville was the star of the show with four goals, while Justin Circuit added a brace and Theo Walman rounded off the rout.

In the Premier Division, Parkgate made a statement in the South Yorkshire derby by smashing six past Penistone Church. Goals came from Harry Day, a double from Alex Wonham, and further strikes by Niall Loughlin, Jacob Pearson, and Brandon

Elsewhere, there were four-goal hauls for Sheffield, Handsworth, and Maltby Main. Sheffield edged Barton Town 4–2, Handsworth cruised past Knaresborough Town 4–0, and Maltby overcame Winterton Rangers 4–2 in a thrilling encounter.

There was also a solid away win for Worsbrough Bridge Athletic, who stay third in the table after a 3–0 victory at Doncaster City.

Meanwhile, Athersley Recreation pulled off one of the shocks of the weekend, holding second-placed Harrogate Railway Athletic to a 1–1 draw. Athersley, who had lost nine of their previous ten games, took a surprise lead with eight minutes to go through Luca Cancello, only to be pegged back two minutes from time.

Dronfield Town came within seconds of pulling off a major cup upset in the United Counties League Cup against higher-tier Nuneaton Town. Dronfield stunned their visitors by taking the lead in the first minute, but Nuneaton, who are comfortably top of the Premier Division South, hit back with two goals to turn the tie around. Just when it looked like the underdogs were heading out, Dronfield struck a dramatic injury-time equaliser to force penalties. Despite their valiant effort, they were edged out 5–3 in the shootout, but left with heads held high after a spirited performance.

Stocksbridge Park Steels had to wait until Tuesday for their FA Trophy clash at Silsden, after Storm Amy forced a post-ponement. The rearranged tie proved dramatic, with the underdogs holding Steels to a 1–1 draw before the visitors edged a 5–4 win in a 14-penalty shootout.

Hallam endured a mixed week—holding promotion-chasing Emley AFC to a goalless draw on Saturday (despite missing a penalty), before falling 2—0 at Matlock Town on Tuesday night, as the big-spending hosts notched their sixth straight win.

Yorkshire Cricket Stars Shine in 2025 Awards!

he Yorkshire **Cricket South**ern Premier League has unveiled its 2025 individual award winners, celebrating a season of exceptional performances across all divisions. From seasoned veterans to rising stars, the honours reflect the depth of talent and passion for the game across the region.

Appleby Frodingham's Alex Grimes was the standout performer in the Premier Division, amassing a phenomenal 1101 runs at an average of 68.81 to claim the senior batting award. In the junior category, Barnsley WM's Owen Smith made his mark with 412 runs at 29.43, underlining his potential as a future star.

Cleethorpes' Mayank Mishra was a dominant force with the ball, taking 72 wickets at a miserly average of just 10.92 to secure the senior bowling accolade. Doncaster Town's Matthew Carroll led the junior bowling charts with 27 wickets at 16.96, showcasing his growing prowess.

In the wicketkeeping department, Tickhill's Ollie Wilson was a safe pair of hands behind the stumps, claiming 24

catches and executing seven stumpings to earn the senior award. Barnsley's Harry Dixon was recognised as the top junior wicketkeeper with nine dismissals.

Kieran Lindley, also of Appleby Frodingham, was named the Premier Division's top all-rounder, thanks to his consistent contributions with both bat and ball. Grimes and Mishra added to their accolades by securing the Most Runs and Best Bowler Cups respectively, while Wilson was awarded the Best Wicketkeeper Cup.

These prestigious awards will be formally presented at the

League's annual dinner, set to take place at the OEC Sheffield on Saturday, 15 November 2025. The event promises to be a night of celebration, bringing together players, officials, and supporters to honour the achievements of the season and reflect on another memorable year of cricket in Yorkshire.

With such a wealth of talent on display, the future of the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League looks brighter than ever, and the upcoming awards night is set to be a fitting tribute to the stars who lit up the 2025 season.

FA Trophy Draw Hands Steels Sixth Straight Away Day

Park Steels just can't catch a break on the road. The draw for the First Round Proper of the Adobe FA Trophy has handed them yet another away tie—remarkably, their sixth consecutive away fixture across all competitions this season.

Fresh from a dramatic penalty shootout victory at Silsden on Tuesday night, the Steels now face a quick turnaround as they prepare to travel to Hyde United on Saturday, 25 October. In a twist of scheduling fate, the two sides will have already locked horns just days

earlier, with a league clash at Hyde scheduled for the preceding Tuesday. It sets up a double-header that could define a crucial stretch in the Steels' campaign.

Meanwhile, in the FA Sunday Cup Second Round, both local representatives have also been drawn away from home. Scawthorpe Athletic, flying the flag for the Doncaster & District Sunday League, will head to North Lincolnshire to take on Beckwood Beauty, based in Scunthorpe. Westville, representing the Mexborough & District League, face a longer journey to the Lincolnshire coast, where they'll meet



Humberston, a village side located just south of Cleethorpes. Both ties are scheduled for Sunday, 9 November, and promise to be tough tests for the South Yorkshire outfits.

In the Adobe Women's FA Cup, Dronfield Town remain the region's sole survivors as the competition enters its later stages. With Women's Championship clubs set to join in the Third Round Proper, Dronfield face a stern challenge in the First Round Proper when they travel to face Durham Cestria on Sunday, 26 October. The National League Northern Division One side will be formidable

opponents, but Dronfield will be hoping to continue their impressive cup run and make history.

With a string of away days on the horizon, South Yorkshire's nonleague and grassroots teams are bracing for a challenging but exciting few weeks on the national stage.



Stocksbridge Edge Past Silsden on Penalties

Park Steels advanced to the next round of the FA Trophy after a tense and dramatic evening at the Angel Telecom Stadium, overcoming Silsden AFC 5-4 on penalties following a 1-1 draw in regulation time.feel.

The match was a classic cup tie—tense, physical, and full of momentum swings. Both sides came into the fixture with confidence, and it showed in the opening exchanges. Silsden, playing in front of a vocal home crowd, started with energy and pressed high, forcing Stocksbridge into early errors. The visitors, however, settled into their rhythm midway through the first half, with Elliot Owen and their midfield trio beginning to dictate play.

Despite the growing intensity, the first half ended goalless. Silsden's best chance came from a curling free-kick that narrowly missed the top corner, while Stocksbridge threatened from a series of corners, showing their aerial strength. The defensive units on both sides were well-organised, with Silsden's back four particularly impressive in dealing with crosses and second balls.

The breakthrough came in the 55th

minute. Silsden's Luke Brooksbank, who had been a constant nuisance for the Stocksbridge defence, capitalised on a loose ball in the box and fired home with composure. The goal was met with a roar from the home supporters and gave Silsden a deserved lead after a strong start to the second half.

Stocksbridge responded with urgency. They began to push higher up the pitch, and their persistence paid off in the 84th minute when Elliot Owen found space on the edge of the box and drilled a low shot past the Silsden keeper. The equaliser was a gut punch for the hosts, who had defended resolutely for much of the half.

As the match edged towards fulltime, both teams had chances to snatch a winner. Silsden's midfield, led by their captain, tried to regain control, but Stocksbridge's physicality and tactical discipline kept them at bay. The visitors looked dangerous from set-pieces, winning eight corners to Silsden's three, and nearly scored from a late header that grazed the crossbar.

Discipline became a factor late in the game. Silsden picked up four yellow cards, which disrupted their rhythm and forced tactical reshuffles. Stocksbridge, though

not without their own bookings, managed to keep their shape and composure heading into the shootout.

The penalty shootout was a nerveshredding affair. Both teams converted their first four spotkicks with confidence. The fifth round proved decisive-Stocksbridge found the net, while Silsden's final effort was saved by the visiting goalkeeper, sparking celebrations among the travelling fans and players.

For Silsden, the result was a bitter pill to swallow. They had matched their opponents stride for stride and arguably created the better chances over the 90 minutes. Brooksbank's performance was a standout, and the defensive unit showed real grit. Their manager will take positives from the display, but the missed opportunity to progress will sting.

Stocksbridge, meanwhile, will be buoyed by their resilience. Owen's late equaliser and their composure in the shootout highlighted the mental strength within the squad.
Their ability to adapt tactically and respond under pressure will serve them well in the next round.

The atmosphere at the Angel Telecom Stadium was electric throughout, with both sets of supporters playing their part in a memorable evening. The match had everything goals, drama, tactical battles, and a shootout finale.

In the draw for the First Round Proper, Stocksbridge have been drawn away for the 6th time out of 6 in all cup competitions this season with a trip to Hyde United on the cards on 25 October. This will also mean to successive trips to Hyde with the League game taking place on the Tuesday beforehand (21 October).

Before that, Warrington Town are at Bracken Moor on Saturday afternoon (3 pm) in a vital league clash. Warrington are one place and one point behind Steels but with two games in hand so it is important for Steels to get something out of the game.

Hallam Dig Deep, Show True Grit



allam FC may not have come away with maximum points this week, but their performances against two of the division's strongest sides showed grit, growth, and glimpses of promise that fans can rally behind.

Saturday's clash at Sandygate against Emley AFC was billed as a mismatch on paper — Emley, flying high in the top three, arrived with a reputation for free-flowing football and clinical finishing. But Hallam had other ideas. In front of a passionate home crowd, the Countrymen dug deep and delivered a disciplined, determined display that earned them a well-deserved o-o draw.

It wasn't a game for the goal-hungry, but it was a masterclass in defensive organisation. Hallam's backline, led by the ever-reliable Jon-

athan Hedge between the sticks, stood tall against wave after wave of Emley pressure. Hedge was in inspired form, pulling off a series of crucial saves, including a fingertip stop from a curling effort that looked destined for the top corner.

The midfield trio worked tirelessly to close down space and disrupt Emley's rhythm, while the full-backs showed real tenacity in oneon-one duels. Though Hallam didn't create many clear-cut chances, they showed flashes of attacking intent, particularly on the counter, with Calum Ward and Jack Brown linking up well in transition.

The final whistle was met with applause from the home faithful — not for goals, but for guts. Holding one of the league's most potent sides to a goalless

draw was no small feat, and it gave Hallam a platform to build on heading into Tuesday's away fixture.

That trip to Matlock Town was always going to be a tough test. Matlock, unbeaten in six and brimming with confidence, started the game on the front foot. Hallam, however, didn't shrink from the challenge. They matched Matlock's intensity early on and created a couple of promising openings, with Ward again lively down the left flank.

The breakthrough came in the 21st minute, when Matlock's Cameron Wilson found space in the box and slotted home with precision. It was a blow, but Hallam didn't fold. They regrouped, tightened up, and pushed for an equaliser. Their best chance came just

after the break, when a slick move down the right saw a low cross fizzed into the box — Ward slid in but couldn't quite connect cleanly.

Matlock's second goal, another from Wilson, was a moment of individual brilliance – a low drive from distance that beat Hedge at the near post. But even at 2-0 down, Hallam kept fighting. Substitute Ben Thornton added energy in midfield, and the team continued to press, refusing to let the game drift.

While the result wasn't what Hallam wanted, the performance showed character. Against a side tipped for promotion, Hallam held their own for long stretches and showed they're capable of competing with the best. The defensive structure that earned

them a point against Emley was evident again, and with a bit more sharpness in the final third, they could have made it a much closer contest.

Ahead of Wednesday evenings games, Hallam sit 15th in the table — a position that doesn't quite reflect the quality of their recent performances. With a solid defensive foundation and attacking players beginning to find their rhythm, there's every reason to believe the team can climb the standings in the coming weeks.

For supporters, this week offered plenty to be proud of. The draw against Emley was a statement of intent, and the fight shown at Matlock was encouraging. Hallam may not have taken all the points, but they've taken a big step forward in belief and cohesion.

White Hart Wadworth Back With a Bang

ometimes it can be hard being the new kid on the block. However, in the case of White Hart Wadworth, the newcomers to the Mexborough & District League are finally beginning to find their feet.

Initially formed in 2015 as Sporting Wadworth, the club started out in the bottom divisions of the Doncaster and District league. Multiple promotions followed which propelled the village side into the

Premier Division, where the side landed a credible 6th placed finish.

Wadworth's achievements didn't go unnoticed. The bright lights of mainstream Saturday afternoon came calling. When the current management took on the Yorkshire Main job, the majority of players soon followed and enjoyed a spell playing Central Midlands football. That left Wadworth up the proverbial creek without a paddle and the club

folded in 2021.

Manager Paul Roidl explained that the change wasn't all that it cracked up to

"Due to work and family commitments, it was agreed that Sundays suited the managers and players more, so the reforming of the Sunday team was agreed under the new name White Hart Wadworth FC."

Rather than revert to type and rejoin the Doncaster ranks, Roidl sought a blank canvas for his rechristened team and new opponents to pit his footballing wit against. He also explained the reasons for the name change.

"We wanted a new start so had to change the name, but still wanted to represent the village of Wadworth. Playing in a league with most teams representing a pub, we decided to do the same and our village only has the one, but they are great and look after us. It's actually our first time in the Mexborough League, but we've relished the new challenge. It's been enjoyable so far, despite a slow start

against some tough opponents."

Following a mixed start to their Division One campaign, the domestic cup competitions have seen an upturn in form. Sunday saw the side post their best score yet by way of a 5-2 victory against New Masons Arms in the Supplementary Cup. Thomas Doherty set Wadworth on their way, but Tristan Taylor grabbed the headlines and match ball with a four goal haul.

Roidl was quick to talk up the skills of the long serving Taylor after the game. "He's been with the club for over a decade and could have got 6 or 7, but for some great goalkeeping from the opposition."

White Hart Wadworth will now hope to transfer their upturn in footballing fortunes to future league fixtures.

In other Supplementary Cup news, Queens Head Hoyland won 2-1 at Highgate WMC, while Swinton Athletic saw off Barnburgh WMC 5-3.

In the Peter Walker League Cup, a Patrick Swift hat-trick was in vain, as Denaby United were edged out 4-3 by Ville.

ocal teams did not fare well in Sunday's Adobe Women's FA Cup third round qualifying ties.

Dronfield Town were 3-0 winners at Netherton United in their tie between two teams at East Midlands Regional League Division One level. The pair have enjoyed contrasting starts to their League campaigns and the tie went according to the form book with Division One North Dronfield, maximum points from their two games to date, progressing thanks to goals from Regan Barnes Annabel Davies and Maia Taylor. Netherton, bottom of Division One South, had lost their two games to date by an aggregate 12-0.

Having been in the Midlands group of ties for the game at Netherton, Dronfield found themselves transferred to the Northern group for the first round proper where they were again given an away tie, but this time much tougher, against Durham Cestria.

The first round groupings were 28

teams (Northern), 36 teams (Midlands) and 48 teams (Southern). The geography of the draws is such that teams can move between regions depending on the results from the previous round and the influx of any previously exempt teams. Consequently, even armed with the numbers assigned to each team in the first round proper draw, trying to say "if only we had got through, we would have had a tie against" is an impossible task.

Barnsley Women trailed at the interval at home to Mancunian Unity, but a stronger second half display saw them finish the 90 minutes on level terms, Freya Walton scoring for a 1-1 scoreline, but it was the lower (fifth) tier North West Regional Premier Division visitors who prevailed 3-0 in the penalty shoot out.

Stocksbridge Park

away to tier four Blackburn Rovers. While
Steels, from tier seven,
were beaten 11-2, they
can be greatly encouraged by their goals

scored by Anna Davis (pen) and Olivia Winstanley and also the relatively narrow margin compared to many meetings between teams from the FA Women's National League and County Leagues over the years.

While Rovers have had their problems after voluntarily dropping down from the second tier, they will have welcomed the one bright spot in their season so far. Without a League point to date, they were beaten 13-0 by Burnley in the League Cup a week earlier and the pair meet again in the first round proper.

Tier six Handsworth had a tough home tie against Northampton Town who were FAWNL Division One Midlands runners up last season. Even though they lost 3-0, Handsworth gave a good account of themselves. Bianca Luttman put Town ahead midway through the first half, but it was the key second goal, less than two minutes after the interval by Jemima Foottit which gave the visitors a welcome cushion. Gabby Maia completed the



scoring from a penalty with just over ten minutes to go.

Sheffield FC were beaten 1-0 at home by Boldmere St Michaels in and all FAWNL Division One Midlands clash. The visitors, second in the table with maximum points from their five league games, advanced thanks to a goal by Janelle Starker and survived strong pressure in the closing stages by Sheffield to force penalties.

Like YP, both Barnsley Women Reserves and Stocksbridge Park Steels also have maximum points from two games, while half the twelve strong division are still unbeaten.

Sophie Norris was a hat trick scorer for leaders Frickley Athletic who have 13 points from five games following their 5-3 win at Oughtibridge War Memorial whose goals came from Ebony Deans, Dionne Lawton and Roxanne Reid.

Moments later. Will Smith broke through midfield and linked with Elliot Fisher, who surged into the 22. A missed final pass denied a certain try, but the momentum was building. Fullback George Castledine then bulldozed his way over on the left flank, and Posa again defied the wind to convert, making it 14o after just 16 min-

Preston responded with a spell of pressure, aided by a string



of penalties. A lineout five metres out gave them the platform, and centre Sammy Russell finished off a well-worked move. Sam Freeman missed the conversion, but the visitors were on the board at 14-5.

Sheffield, however, weren't done. Re-

placement prop Alex Reid crashed over for the third try just before the break, and Posa's third conversion gave the hosts a commanding 21-5 lead at halftime.

The second half began with Sheffield opting for a scrum from a penalty in front of the posts. Another infringement led to a repeat, and this time Zak Poole peeled off to score the bonus-point try. Posa added the extras, stretching the lead to 28-5.

Five minutes later, Chris Hooper added the fifth try, and Posa's boot made it 35-5. The game was slipping away from the visitors, and their frustration boiled over when Billy Glover was sin-binned for a reckless tackle. Sheffield capitalised immediately, with winger Cameron Catleugh finishing off a sweeping move for the sixth try. Posa missed the conversion, but the scoreline read 40-5.

To their credit, Preston battled on despite the worsening conditions. Jacob Browne crossed for a late consolation try, but Freeman's conversion attempt was blown off course. The final whistle came with Sheffield firmly in control and the scoreboard reflecting their dominance.

Sheffield level on
points with Tynedale,
who also boast five
wins from five, but
Sheffield edge the top
spot on points difference. Their attacking
prowess has been
matched by defensive
resilience, conceding
just 66 points across
five games while
scoring a staggering
194.

Next up is a mouthwatering clash away at Fylde RFC, who themselves are unbeaten after a dramatic 22-19 win over Macclesfield last weekend. Fylde showed grit and composure to snatch victory late on, and will pose a serious challenge to Sheffield's perfect record.

With confidence soaring and the squad firing on all cylinders, Coach Posa will be hoping his side can carry this momentum into what promises to be one of the season's defining matches.


