Food Policy Highlights

- Meals include meats (beef, chicken, duck, pork; no offal, chicken heads, or feet) and vegetarian options.
- Dishes are free of peanuts, nuts, peppers, peanut oil, and other allergens. Meals can be adjusted to accommodate any specific allergy-related requirements.
- Daily water and fruit are provided, with restaurants ensuring clean barreled water for hydration.

1 (D)	[Recommended flight: TG614 Bangkok BKK 10:00-15:45 Beijing]	WildChina staff will pick you up at Beijing Airport and we drive to the hotel for check-in and introductions.	Enjoy a Peking duck dinner —one of Beijing’s most iconic dishes, renowned for its crispy skin and tender meat. This meal marks the beginning of your cultural journey.
2 (B, L, D)	Visit Tiananmen Square to learn about China’s modern history. Explore the Forbidden City , the imperial palace, through an interactive “choose-your-own-adventure” , uncovering stories of emperors and dynasties.	After lunch, head to Jingshan Park for a panoramic view of Beijing’s ancient and modern landscapes to see how the city has evolved. Visit the National Museum of Art .	Enjoy a hearty Beijing-style mutton hotpot , known for its warming, flavorful broth.
3 (B, L, D)	In Brickyard Art Museum , discover Beijing’s contemporary art scene, then get hands-on in a fun cooking class where you’ll make zhajiangmian —a beloved Beijing-style noodle dish!	Head to the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall , one of China’s most well-preserved sections. The cable car ride provides a bird’s-eye view of the Wall’s sprawling length, followed by a hike along this historic wonder, learning about its significance in ancient defense and Chinese culture.	Enjoy dinner in Beijing and take an early rest.

4 (B, L, D)	Visit the Temple of Heaven , an iconic symbol of China's architectural and spiritual heritage. Join locals practicing Kung Fu —a centuries-old martial art that blends physical skill with philosophy.	Dive into Peking Opera . Learn about its history and vibrant characters, practice some basic movements, and try your hand at painting your own Peking Opera face mask .	Pearl Market Shopping Adventure : Put your bargaining skills to the test at this famous market!
5 (B, L, D)	Beijing Hutong Tour : Travel back in time as you explore the city's ancient alleys. Enjoy a traditional rickshaw ride through Beijing's historic hutongs, followed by a group scavenger hunt activity.	Experience traditional Chinese arts firsthand through paper cutting and calligraphy —the crafts that have been practiced for centuries and carrying cultural significance and deep symbolism. Visit a traditional Siheyuan courtyard home to see how Beijing's past has shaped its present.	Enjoy a farewell dinner and reflect on your time in Beijing.
6 (B, L)	Explore Beihai Park , one of the oldest imperial gardens in China. Discover its historical significance while enjoying a peaceful boat ride . Along the way, marvel at the Nine-Dragon Wall , a masterpiece of traditional Chinese art, and the White Pagoda that stands as a symbol of the park's royal history.
