In the first three months of the year, Honduras recorded a total of 55 fires in approximately 540

hectares of forest nationwide, according to a report by the Institute of Forest Conservation (ICF). Although in many occasions we as a population want to say that the factor that incites these fires is the high temperatures, the reality is that in most cases there is an arsonist who is satisfied to see every tree, bush and even animals deteriorating in this unforgivable action.

For the good fortune of our nature the State of Honduras will be

in charge of granting five to twelve years in prison to people who are denounced for committing this crime, Honduras is filled with mourning for each hectare of forest that is damaged, let us be promoters of raising awareness to people that for each burned forest, a home is destroyed, shelter for our animals since not all have shelters, many are in the different Honduran forests, protect and conserve our natural wealth.







The creation of this place arose from the director of the Centro de Rehabilitación Jesús es la Solución, Dylon Price, to support people in conditions of addiction to any type of narcotic that live in Roatán conjunction with Mayor Ron Mcnab who has been of great help in this unique project in the island area.

his shelter installs people who have the will to change, currently, there are 5 ministries with people from Guanaja, Utila, the coast of the country, and Tegucigalpa, many of them have already graduated, this institution makes human rights prevail, providing dignified treatment to each inhabitant, guiding them to take their process by the hand of God. The process to leave is supervised, every person who wants to visit his family must be accompanied by a supervisor, likewise, those who

no longer want to continue in the place are made a note of suspension, a total recreation is provided with soccer fields, animal area and all have their respective beds and personal care items necessary for their stay.

"Our main help is Mr. Ron, he is such a human man, Roatán will not find another mayor like him, being the first official to offer help, his staff treats us very well, just like the churches which I invite to contribute their service to administer". Rehabilitation routine

The 20 people currently housed must wake up at 5:00 am, then at



7:00 in the morning a general cleaning of the ministry is done, they have breakfast at 8:00 in the morning, going to a bible study from 9:00 am to 11:00 am.

In the afternoon they practice "work therapy", which consists of each individual recreating his or her mind, this is a four-hour day, giving a space to play any sport from 4:00 pm, then the last teaching is done which is directed by Dylon Price, at 6:00 pm it is dinner time and then they can meet to watch a Christian movie, arriving at night everyone must be in their beds without making noise to be

able to fall asleep.

Weekends are family recreation days, they are allowed to talk to their families and even receive visits from them, without leaving aside church attendance.

This work has been ongoing since 2018 with the entire team of the rehabilitation center, churches, and the mayor's office of Roatán so that these people can live in a healthy way and without temptations, all the people of Roatán and neighboring departments can contribute clothes, hygiene products food or other useful products for this cause.


FTHNICITY

he Mayas exercised their dominion on this site leaving the artistic quality of the high range, reflected in its mosaics, altars, and three-dimensional sculptures carved in stone, distinguishes Copan from other Mayan cities for its architecture and especially the hieroglyphic staircases where the most extensive text of the entire Mayan area is engraved.

According to research, it is said that the first humans who settled in the Copan Valley arrived around 1500 BC and it is believed that they had links with southern Mexico, what is admirable was how this culture showed great architectural progress raising pyramids, temples and palaces, using crafts implementing the use of dyes in fabric and clothing, spinning fabric, the religion of this people was polytheistic due to their belief in various gods linked to nature.

Undoubtedly, this is a spectacle of culture although it has countless attractions, and highlights its sophisticated mathematical and astronomical systems the most advanced in its time, Honduras is a fortunate territory to contemplate and share with the world the great processes in various fields that left the Maya, is currently the subject of study for several scholars in this field, a civilization that came to an end in the sixteenth century with the Spanish empire which brought down the last Mayan city in 1697.

Roatán Mayor's Office announces construction of new morgue and Forensic Medicine

An important project was announced for the population of Roatán, the construction of new facilities for the morgue and Forensic Medicine in the insular zone, the collaboration bond is constituted by Mayor Ron McNab, the Public Ministry (MP), and the American Embassy.

However, the American Embassy committed to donate supplies, materials, and equipment following the support exercise as with the municipalities of Santa Rosa de Copán, Choluteca.
