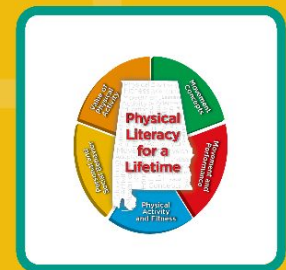
## PowerSchool Information
