


Our Mission

- 3. Click the *Register* button.

Session Confirmation

You will receive a confirmation email from PS. If a session is canceled, filled, or if there is any change, we will notify you by the email address you provided in PS.

You are encouraged to register as soon as possible for the courses you would like to attend this summer. A course must have a minimum of five (5) participants enrolled five (5) days prior to the start of the course in order to make. If the course does not meet the minimum enrollment requirement, it will be canceled and any registrants will be notified by email.

PowerSchool Course Credit

- Educators must be present for the entire scheduled session.
- Your attendance will be recorded in PowerSchool as "Complete Pending Survey" following the completion of the course.
- Educators must return to their PowerSchool dashboard to complete a required survey from the state department of education.
- The course should be listed on your PSPL transcript.




PowerSchool Information
