Discover over 125 authentic heritage buildings, fascinating displays, museums, restaurants, shops and cozy accommodations in the heart of the Cariboo. Nestled on the traditional, ancestral, and unceded territories of the Lhtako Dene Nation and Secwépemc Peoples, Barkerville Historic Town & Park stands as a living monument to BC's golden heritage. Step back in time to the extraordinary town named after William 'Billy' Barker, whose 1862 discovery sparked a twenty-year, multi-billion dollar gold rush that helped build a Province.

Declared a National Historic Site of Canada in 1924, Barkerville offers an unparalleled immersive experience for visitors of all ages. Several Indigenous nations have history and territory in the area, and evidence of settlement in the region dates back over 10,000 years. Barkerville emerged virtually overnight through word-of-mouth following Barker's strike in 1862 and within a few years, its population swelled to between 3000-5000. On September 16, 1868, a devastating fire destroyed the town, but rebuilding occurred remarkably fast with ninety buildings completed within six weeks. By 1880, the Barkerville School opened with thirteen students and a single chalkboard. The town's population declined sharply by the century's end, leaving few residents. Fully restored in the 1960s, Barkerville now appears as it did during its peak years.

Students and teachers alike will delight in established world-class public programs where history comes alive. Barkerville's dedicated staff will ensure that your visit is truly outstanding, whether you come for a day trip or extend your stay for a full historical adventure. With so much to see, Barkerville offers everyone the freedom to play, learn and explore. Students can pan for real gold, ride

in a genuine stagecoach, dress up for historic photographs, and enjoy the spectacular Theatre Royal variety show. Shops, restaurants, and museum exhibits are also open and ready to educate your class on the history of the Cariboo Gold Rush.

Immerse your class in educational programming that features Indigenous and Chinese cultural sessions, authentic school lessons that transport children back in time to a Victorian classroom, and guided tours through the largest living history museum in western North America.
