# Chiefs Primed for Pivotal Pottington Road Clash Against Cinderford

Barnstaple Chiefs are set for their toughest and most electrifying test of the season this afternoon as they host fifth-place Cinderford in a showdown that promises to set the tone for the National Two West campaign.

Both sides have stormed out of the gates this season, but it is the Chiefs who hold the psychological edge, sitting 5 points above their rivals. The Chiefs' home turf advantage and recent resilience suggest they are the side with the momentum.

The Chiefs are riding a wave of confidence following a monumental performance last week against Hinckley. In a display of sheer grit and tactical genius, the squad powered through a second-half gale-force wind to not only secure the win but also plunder all five league points.

Cinderford, by contrast, arrive here having started the season with three good wins, however their last two games saw a 33-24 loss to Hornets followed last weekend beaten at home 21-34 by Taunton.

While the history books show Cinderford have overall bragging rights with their encounters with Barnstaple, a closer look reveals a far more compelling story

The narrative shifts dramatically when these two clubs meet at the fortress of Pottington Road. The stats speak for themselves: in the six previous encounters here, every single contest has been decided by a nail-biting seven points or less. This is a stage set for drama, and the Chiefs have thrived in it.

The last two home fixtures against Cinderford are a perfect microcosm of this intense rivalry: a commanding 21-13 victory for the Chiefs, followed by a heart-breaking 18-20 loss that was decided by the slimmest of margins. That narrow defeat will undoubtedly be burning in the memories of the Barnstaple players, providing a powerful source of motivation for this highly-anticipated rematch.

All evidence suggests that today's match will be another brutally close, physically demanding affair. But with the passionate Barnstaple faithful behind them and a proven ability to win the tight battles, the Chiefs have every reason to believe that this time, the result will swing in their favour. Expect a full-throttle contest where every penalty, every scrum, and every moment of brilliance could be the difference.

# Gale-Force Grit: Chiefs Overcome Elements and Adversity in Stunning Second-Half Rout

In a display of character that will be talked about for seasons to come, the Barnstaple Chiefs authored a second-half masterclass to turn a halftime deficit into a resounding victory, conquering not only a determined Hinckley side but also the truly ferocious elements at Pottington Road.

The first half was a story of two contrasting chapters, played out in a nightmare gale blowing straight up the pitch. The Chiefs began with commanding authority, dominating possession and territory for the first 30 minutes. The pressure told early, as a series of powerful pick-and-goes culminated in Arthur Marks crashing over the line, converted coolly by the ever-reliable Henry Sellick.

The momentum continued as the Chiefs' forward pack laid the foundation, with Johnny Carter powering over for a well-deserved try. When Arthur Marks grabbed his second just five minutes later, the home side seemed to be cruising with a 17-5 lead.

However, in conditions where every pass and kick was a lottery, a calamitous final ten minutes of the half saw the game turned on its head. Two misjudged kick-offs, cruelly exploited by the wind, gifted Hinckley the platform to score three rapid-fire tries, stunning the home crowd and sending the Chiefs into

the break trailing 17-22.

What followed after halftime was nothing short of spectacular. Facing the same gale-force wind that had betrayed them, the Chiefs produced 40 minutes of near-perfect, controlled rugby that left Hinckley utterly bewildered.

Playing with ferocious intensity, the Chiefs took the game by the scruff of the neck from the first whistle. The forward pack turned the screw, earning a technical yellow card against the visitors for persistent infringements. From the ensuing pressure, Johnny Carter blasted through a gap from a Ross Swales pass to bag his second try and level the scores.

Then, just two minutes later, the moment of magic that ignited the crowd. Full-back Henry Sellick received the ball deep inside his own 22 and proceeded to slice through the heart of the Hinckley defence, jinking and accelerating on an incredible 80-yard solo run to score under the posts, leaving a trail of defenders in his wake.

From that point, the Chiefs were rampant. The scrum became a dominant weapon, shunting Hinckley backwards at will. Brendan Darley burrowed over from close range, and Brandon Moore provided the exclamation point scoring a brace in the final 10 minutes, the last of which saw the scrum in action as Brandon from the base of a scrum that had marched Hinckley back ten metres and powering through multiple tackles to score.

While Hinckley managed a late consolation, it did little to

dampen the spirits of a side that had just put 35 unanswered points on the board against the wind. The 4th win of the season was secured in the most emphatic style imaginable.

This was more than a win; it was a statement. The discipline and ball control exhibited in the second half, starving a talented Hinckley side of possession, was a tactical triumph. While every player in a Chiefs shirt was a hero, a special mention must go to Henry Sellick. Not only for his breathtaking solo try, but for a kicking performance that defied logic—slotting six out of eight conversions in a gale, a contribution that rightly earned him Man of the Match honours.

The hiccup before the break was not a sign of weakness, but merely a prelude to a stunning demonstration of this squad's stamina, fitness, and unshakable belief. To come back and win so convincingly in such conditions sends a clear message to the rest of the league: this Barnstaple Chiefs side has the heart of a champion.
