COMPONENT 1: ACADEMIC PROGRAM INTEGRATION

Grades 8-12 are automatically enrolled into Career Education Courses including Career Life Education and Career Life Connections (B.C. Dogwood)

Students Explore:

- Skills, values, personal interests
- Job markets and labour trends
- Diverse educational pathways
- Scholarships and scholarship application
- Summer schools and summer camps
- Work and volunteer opportunities

Students set goals and take action while collaborating with peers, practice their presentations and develop interview skills, and have the opportunity to interact with guest speakers in diverse career areas as well as guest presenters from a variety of universities and colleges across Canada.

COMPONENT 2: INDIVIDUAL COACHING AND COUNSELLING

The Individual Coaching program includes:

- Regular meetings with our University Guidance counsellor
- Teacher, parent, student triad support meetings
- Virtual and in person check ins
- Support navigating university websites and applications
- Advise on personal essay writing
- Assist with university course selection
- Advise on best fit institution and location selection for study and career

COMPONENT 3: COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

Throughout the year, we invite parents and students to events, in order to build a community of support to students.

Events include:

- Info sessions on DP and BC Dogwood program and graduation pathway selection considerations
- Information on IB course selection and university pathways development, to help guide DP course selection
- Info sessions on the University application process and how parents, students and teachers can work together
- Other guest speaker events to help enable career and university planning
