As a young mother of a child with severe disabilities, I quickly learned that the world was not set up for someone like my son, Nicholas. Access and Inclusion to the world outside of our home was often problematic.

So, 14 years ago, I founded SMILE (Small Miracles In Life Exist) Mass to help families raising children or adults with disabilities enjoy happy, healthy memories through education, recreation and vacation experiences.

Today, SMILE Mass serves approximately 30,000 families with a wide range of programs that are built around inclusion and accessibility:

- Donated over 180 floating beach wheelchairs throughout New England.
- Purchased a handicap-accessible beach house on Cape Cod and made it available to families with severely disabled family members.
- Developed a thriving, adaptive equipment loaner program that improves access and quality of life.
- · And, most recently, created "Club SMILE Mass," a robust, adaptive-fitness program at a local gym.

In fact, Club SMILE Mass has been so successful, we have outgrown our current space. Therefore, I am thrilled to announce our next project: We are going to build a state-of-the-art activity center customized to serve thousands of children and adults with severe disabilities right here in Metro West. Club SMILE Mass

We currently host most of our weekly services at a local gym for over 60 children and young adults. Activities include one-on-one gym, swim, music therapy, storytime, and so much more. The Club SMILE Mass program is built on movement, in an effort to stimulate the frontal lobe of the brain which promotes communication, voluntary movement, happiness, social skills, and many other benefits while using a cross therapeutic approach.

Beach House

SMILE Mass purchased and outfitted a beautiful, fully handicapaccessible vacation beach house in Truro, MA, specifically designed for families caring for loved ones with disabilities.

Beach Wheelchair Program

SMILE Mass has donated over 180 floating beach chairs to public beaches so that everyone can enjoy full access to fun in the sand, sun and water.

Equipment Loaner Program



Introducing Club SMILE Mass

Phase 1 (2023-2024)

- · Purchase 30 acres on the Framingham/Sudbury line.
- · Design trails, create driveway and parking lot.
- Renovate interim clubhouse, gym, music room, art space, kitchen and so much more.

Phase 2 (2025)

- · Install heated pool for therapeutic swim classes.
- · Expand trails throughout the property and around the pond.
- Build a Universal Design treehouse, sanctuary, pavilion, benches and evolve the outdoor leisure space.

Phase 3 (2028)

- · Build 8,000 sq. ft. state-of-the-art clubhouse.
- · Further expansion of the trail system.
