PROGRESS CHECKS

Year 12 will sit their first set of progress checks on 11 and 12 November.

They will sit one assessment per A Level subject. We would encourage students to view these exams as an opportunity to check their understanding of the content covered to date. They do not need to do revise excessively in preparation and should ensure they get plenty of rest over the half term break. ILTs will focus on revision when we return from the break.





On Monday, students will sit their chemistry, physics, computer science and economics exams. They will be permitted to leave at lunch to revise at home, or they can stay onsite and revise with teachers' support.

On Tuesday, students will sit their core and applied maths exams. They will have sport as usual in the afternoon.

Results will be shared with students on 28 November and will be sent home to parents/carers on 29 November.

SURREY PROJECT QUALIFICATION (SPQ)

The SPQ is a programme in which our students complete collaborative research projects. Guided by professionals in industry or by academics at universities, they will work in groups of three to five on a STEM related problem. The opportunity to complete a meaningful research project relating to these subject areas will help them to develop necessary practical skills that they will need in higher education, and indeed their careers, and will give them a chance to extend their interests beyond the curriculum.
