Good morning, everyone.

It is an honor to be here with all of you today. Thank you for taking the time and making the sacrifice to come so far for our District conference. You are role models for people of our community.

A very warm welcome to our distinguished guests:

RI President's Representative PDG Rufino "Penny" Policarpio & spouse IPP Joan, Endowment/Major Gift Advisors PDG Sam Showet Hossain, Governor of D3420, Our beloved D3410 Past District Governors, Future leaders: District Governor Elect, District Governor Nominated, District Governor Nominated Designated, Fellow Rotarians, Rotaractors, Members of the Media and Ladies and Gentlemen.

One of the chief highlights of a Rotary District Governor's year is the annual District Conference. It is therefore with great pleasure that I welcome you with heartfelt sincerity this morning to the 11th District Conference of District 3410. The main purpose of the official visits was to meet with the boards of all the clubs, each with its own personality, successes, and problems.

Most clubs are healthy and doing good work in their community, while a few clubs are struggling. In many areas, I had the privilege of meeting with the greater family of Rotary—Rotaract and Interact clubs—where it was a joy to witness the enthusiasm of our youth.

Most of the Rotary Clubs in our district were proud to take me on a tour of some of their most worthwhile projects. I witnessed every manner of project, whether related to Health, Literacy, Environment, Community Development, or Water and Sanitation. There are many outstanding projects happening in our District, covering all of Rotary's areas of focus.



In this district, most clubs are very concerned with improving reading skills in their respective communities. They have carried out various projects, such as providing books and school supplies to schools, storytelling sessions for elementary school students, and renovating schools in Rumpin, Bogor.

In Medan, the Clubs are involved with retirement homes, providing staple food for the needy, and opening several Medical Clinics for free treatment. In the environmental area, Clubs in Yogyakarta and Bandung are educating and supporting densely populated areas to manage and segregate household waste and convert it to organic fertilizer.

I have highlighted but a few of the wonderful projects that are being done by our clubs in this District. Tomorrow, at the breakout rooms, there will be presentations of these projects. You may get an in-depth view of some of the work being done by the Rotary Clubs of District 3410.

We also urge you to spend time in the House of Friendship, visiting the various booths where clubs will be showcasing their special projects.

Goals for the District:

As governor of the district, I had goals for the district at the outset of my year. The first goal was to increase our support for the Rotary Foundation. Today, we will hear from our Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator, PDG Rudy Balmater, and Endowment/Major Gift Advisors PDG Sam Showet Hossain on ideas to increase TRF donations.



The ever-difficult goal of increasing membership was my second goal. Rotary membership is dwindling worldwide, and in District 3410, we have been struggling to keep the numbers above 1100. The District membership Chair PDG Keliek placed a good strategic plan to increase our members, and in the first semester, we experienced a fairly large increase in members by 10%. Thank you, PDG Keliek, for your dedication and commitment.

On the bright side, I am proud to announce that two D3410 Rotarians have been chosen for prominent roles in Rotary International and at the regional level:

- On the regional side, PDG Rudy Balmater has also been appointed as Regional Rotary Foundation Chair in Zone 1B. Congratulations to both of you!



Rotaract and Interact:

On the Rotaract/Interact scene, two Rotaract clubs in Purwokerto have received their charters, while we have lost one Rotaract Club in Bandung.

Not everything that happens in a district is positive. On a sad note, eight Rotarians have passed away this Rotary year. We will have a special tribute for them at the Governor's Banquet tomorrow night. Additionally, one club in the Bandung area has withdrawn from Rotary.

We were also plagued with an earthquake in Sumedang, a landslide in Subang, and a flash flood disaster in West Bandung. I would like to take the time here to express my thanks to RC Bandung Dago and RC Bandung Kota Kembang and their members who carried out the responsibility of providing assistance to help disaster locations.

Water Resources and Use

Indonesia has over 5,590 rivers, most of them short and steep. Because of high rainfall intensities most rivers carry large quantities of sediment. Average rainfall is above 2,000 mm (79 in) on most islands, except for the Lesser Sunda Islands where it is 1,500 mm (59 in). 80% of rain falls during the rainy season (October to April). While water resources are quite abundant in Sumatra, Kalimantan, Sulawesi, Maluku and Irian, water shortages occur during the dry season in parts of Java, Bali and the Lesser Sunda Islands. In particular in Java, the dry season flows are inadequate to meet the demand, leading to irrigation shortages. Irrigation accounts for 93% of water use. The total storage capacity amounts to only 5–6% of the river flows. Construction of reservoirs is constrained by lack of good reservoir sites, high density of population at possible reservoir sites and expected short reservoir lifetimes due to siltation. Groundwater potential in Indonesia is very limited.

Water Resources and Use

However, much of the eastern islands depend on groundwater because of surface water scarcity. Groundwater overexploitation occurs in heavily populated coastal areas of Java, including in Jakarta and Semarang. In Jakarta, it has caused seawater intrusion up to 10 km (6.2 mi) from the coast and land subsidence at a rate of 2–34 cm/year in east Jakarta. In Semarang, land subsidence occurs at a rate of 9 cm/year.


Water utilities abstract water from rivers and lakes (60%), springs (25%) and groundwater (15%). For example, the main water source for Jakarta is the Jatiluhur Dam on the Citarum River 70 km (43 mi) southeast of the city. For those who are self-supplied or receive water from community-based organizations, shallow groundwater and springs are by far the main sources of water on most islands. On Sumatra and Irian, however, rainwater harvesting is also an important water source.

Pollution

Domestic sewage, industrial effluents, agricultural runoff, and mismanaged solid waste are polluting surface and groundwater, especially in Java. Indonesia ranks among the worst countries in Asia in sewerage and sanitation coverage. Few Indonesian cities possess even minimal sanitation systems. The absence of an established sanitation network forces many households to rely upon private septic tanks or to dispose of their waste directly into rivers and canals. The commonality of the latter practice, together with the prevalence of polluted shallow wells used for drinking water supply in urban areas, has led to repeated epidemics of gastrointestinal infections.

Domestic Waste

According to Water Environment Partnership in Asia (WEPA), only 42.8% from 51,372,661 houses in Indonesia have domestic waste treatment. More than half of households dispose their domestic waste directly to the river body. Data from the World Bank shows that in 2008, only 52% of Indonesian population has an adequate access to excreta disposal facilities. Such facilities are important as they can help to minimize human, animal, and insect contact with excreta, thereby increasing the hygiene level and enhancing the living conditions for the slum-dwellers. Without proper construction and maintenance of these facilities, domestic wastes are disposed ineffectively and increases the rate of water resources degradation.

Industrial Waste

Industrial activities wastes such as small-scale industries, agriculture, textile, pulp and paper, petrochemical, mini ng and oil and gas also contribute to the degradation of water quality in Indonesia. Water quality in locations near to the mining areas is potentially contaminated by heavy metal such as mercury (Hg). According to WEPA, some level of mercury (Hg) concentration has been detected at 9 out of 16 sampling points and the highest level of dissolved mercury in one of the area reach 2.78 ug/L.

Therefore, the result of water quality monitoring in 30 rivers in Indonesia indicates that most of river water qualities do not end up meeting water criteria class I, i.e. water that can be used for standard water, drinking water, and or other usage that requires the same water quality with such usage, due to pollution by domestic and industrial wastes (drinking water raw based on Government Regulation Number 82, 2001, Water Quality Management and Wastewater Controlling).

The Challenge

Nearly 25 million people in Indonesia don't use toilets. They defecate instead in fields, bushes, forests, ditches, streets, canals or other open spaces. Open defecation is not only an affront to dignity, it also poses huge risks to child and community health.

Open defecation and untreated wastewater contaminate water supply and facilitate the spread of diarrheal diseases such as cholera. A quarter of all children under 5 in Indonesia suffer from diarrhea, which is the leading cause of child mortality in the country.

Water quality is poor regardless of socio-economic conditions. A 2017 survey of drinking water in Yogyakarta, a well-off urban center in Java, found that 89 per cent of water sources and 67 per cent of household drinking water were contaminated by fecal bacteria. Moreover, only 7 per cent of wastewater in Indonesia is treated.

The Challenge

Building latrines, and safely managed fecal waste – together with hand washing – is key to keeping children and families healthy.

However, the poorest Indonesians are being left behind, with significant gaps in access to sanitation among households in the two lowest wealth tiers of society – 40 and 65 per cent in urban areas and 36 and 65 per cent in rural areas.

Safely managed sanitation is recognized as a top priority for improving health, nutrition and productivity of people, and is an explicit target of the sixth Sustainable Development Goal (SDG). Reaching SDG 6, therefore, requires a closer look at strategies for reaching the poorest Indonesian children and families with better access to safely managed water supply, sanitation and hygiene (WASH).

The Solution:

UNICEF supports the Government of Indonesia to accelerate access to safely managed water supply, sanitation and hygiene.

At national level, emphasis is placed on high level advocacy and political will along with aligning WASH policies and programs with ground realities and ensuring that they are based on reliable and up-to-date information and data. One of the biggest challenges with achieving safely managed sanitation is changing behaviors – from building political will to creating a new national social norm in support of safely managed sanitation.

In Indonesia, UNICEF motivates social behavior change through high level advocacy and engagement in the Sanitation and Water for All partnership, peer to peer learning to support sub national advocacy and through social mobilization in marginalized communities where open defecation is widespread.

The Solution:

Primary schools and surrounding communities are also primary partners in strengthening hygiene behaviour. UNICEF helps to improve the capacity of teachers, parents and local village administration in developing and implementing school sanitation plans, which involve promoting healthy practices such as hand washing and menstrual hygiene management. In addition, UNICEF helps to strengthen government data quality and monitoring systems so that WASH programmes with cross-cutting relevance to health, nutrition and wider level health and social interventions can be expanded.



Klinik Sosro Anugrah - The First 10 years



Located in a small alley on Jalan Ndagen, Malioboro, Yogyakarta, there is a small clinick that is committed to providing affordable health services to the community and it is called Klinik Sosro Anugrah.

The clinic opens every day from 16.00 WIB to 20.00 WIB with a medical team consisting of four general practitioners, three nurses, one pharmacist and one admin, with at least one doctor practicing every day, ensuring consistent availability of medical services.



In its first decade, Sosro Clinic has experienced positive growth by adding dental health services. This wasrealized through close collaboration with the Foundation from the Netherlands.

In these ten dedicated years, the Sosro Anugrah Clinic in Malioboro has become an integral part of Yogyakarta society and continues toplay a role in increasing the accessibility of health services for all groups. (RCYT)

Klinik Husada Hutomo – at Keraton Yogyakarta

The palace gives trust to the Rotary Club of Yogya Tugu to jointly provide special health services for the Abdi dalem and visitors to the palace.

Husada Hutomo Clinic provides health checks for health complaints, direct health care and also checks blood sugar, cholesterol and uric acid and provides a mini pharmacy to support the needs of the clinic.

Hopefully this clinic can help maintain and improve the health of the Abdi dalem who have served the Yogyakarta palace.

Early Detection of Heart Defects in Children



Congenital Heart Disease (CHD) is a congenital heart defect. Some CHDs can be recognized from birth because they present with typical symptoms and signs, but there are some CHDs that present with atypical symptoms and signs that go undetected during childhood.

In Yogyakarta, it was found that some adult CHD patients had developed complications such as pulmonary hypertension, heart failure, or Eisenmenger syndrome.

One of the causes of the high prevalence of HAP in CHD sufferers is that there is no early detection system in Indonesia that is applied to children so that most children with mild complaints will experience a misdiagnosis.

Until now, early health detection in children does not specifically detect congenital heart defects. By implementing a tiered early detection method, CHD can be detected early before more severe clinical manifestations appear, and corrective action can be taken. (RCYT)

In Rama Dewa Village, there are 2 phases of construction. The first phase is 500 m irrigation canal for 900,000 m2 paddy field for 100 families. The second phase is 500 m irrigation canal for 900,000 m2 paddy field for 100 families.

In Rama Gunawan Village, there is 680 m irrigation canal for 450,000 m2 paddy field for 47 families.



In Rama Nirwana Village, there are 2 phases of construction. The first phase is 500 m irrigation canal for 1,000,000 m2 paddy field for 100 families. The second phase is 500 m irrigation canal for 1,000,000 m2 paddy field for 100 families.

In Rukti Harjo Village, there is 500 m irrigation canal for 790,000 m2 paddy field for 90 families.

In Gedong Tataan Village, there are 2 phases of construction. The first Phase is 530 m irrigation canal for 400,000 m2 paddy field for 50 families. The second Phaseis 170 m irrigation canal for 500,000 m2 paddy field for 60 families.

The last but not the least, in Bogorejo Village, there is 230 m irrigation canal for 400,000 m2 paddy field for 40 families.

Total irrigation canal is 4,110 m irrigation canal for 6,340,000 m2 paddy field for 687 families.

With 6,340,000 m2 paddy fields, the farmers can get 3,804 tons of rice (6,340,000 m2 x 6 tons of rice/10,000 m2). The price of rice is Rp 12,000,000/ton (USD 800). So, every harvest, they can get: 3,804 tons x Rp 12,000,000 = Rp 45,648,000,000 (USD 3,043,200.00). And every year they can get Rp 91,296,000,000 or USD 6,086,400.00 (2 harvest times every year).

Through this irrigation project, we strive for the rural economy development, that can make the farmers and their families live more abundantly.

The rice fields that are fed by irrigation canals will grow from year to year. This situation will make the farmer's economy will grow every year. This is in accordance with the concept of irrigation projects that provide benefits to many people in need in a sustainable way.

Terdapat 100 anak yang ada di Sekolah Kita, kelompok bisa baca dan tidak bisa baca yang terdiri dari: 73 anak di kelompok bisa baca dan 41 anak di kelompok yang belum bisa baca. Periode program 3 Desember 2023 sampai 3 Maret 2024. Lokasi Program di Musholla Al-Hidayah Lorong Sei Jeruju, Kelurahan Kuto Batu Palembang.

Apa dampak proyek tersebut terhadap penerimamanfaat?

 Memperoleh akses pendidikan gratis.
 Adik-adik mendapatkan pengetahuan dan materi sekolah. Adik-adik mendapatkan materi-materi yang ada di sekolah, seperti Bahasa Inggris, Matematika, Lingkungan, Budi Pekerti.

- Meningkatkan literasi dan kemampuan CALISTUNG. Adik-adik lebih lancar lagi dalam membaca, menulis, dan berhitung.
- 3. Membantu orang dalam para tua memberikan pendidikan karakter (basic manners) kepada anak-anak. Peserta didik setelah di Sekolah Kita lebih paham bagaimana cara bersikap dan telah diterapkan di kehidupan sehari-hari. Mereka mulai terbiasa mengucapkan maaf, permisi, terima kasih, tersenvum, bersalaman kepada orang yang lebih tua, makan minum duduk, dan mengambil pemberian menggunakan tangan kanan, mengantri, dan sebagainya.
- Adik-adik lebih mengenal potensi diri dan mengembangkannya. Adik-adik lebih mengenali tujuan mereka belajar dan citacita-nya, serta cara menggapainya (dengan kesabaran, ketekunan, dan kerjasama). Adikadik diberikan motivasi dan semangat untuk meraih mimpinya.


