



Robinson Family Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Robinson Family Scholarship, to be awarded for the first time in 2025, aims to support and advance the academic pursuits of a resident of The Women's College. The scholarship will cover the annual residency fees for one resident for one academic year.

This scholarship represents a significant and transformative contribution to The Women's College, made possible by a major gift from David Robinson. In honouring his mother, Joan Robinson, for her dedicated service as President of The Women's College Standing Committee, David Robinson seeks to continue her legacy of fostering academic excellence.

The terms of the scholarship are as follows:

1. Name and Awarding Body

The name of the scholarship shall be the Robinson Family Scholarship and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College & CEO.

2. Eligibility

The scholarship shall be awarded to a resident of The Women's College who is enrolled or seeking to be enrolled at The University of Queensland (UQ) or the Queensland University of Technology (OUT) in Brisbane.

3. Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded based on proven academic achievements in the field of mathematics and/or science. The recipient must demonstrate the potential to make a valuable contribution to the life of The Women's College.

4. Exclusivity

The recipient of the Robinson Family scholarship will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary during the same academic year.

5. Duration

The scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year only.

6. Termination

The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:

- a) Is no longer enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland or Queensland University of Technology;
- b) Fails to maintain outstanding academic progress at university in the field of mathematics and/or science;
- c) Is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
