WHO WE ARE

Yayasan Senyum Bali (Smile Foundation of Bali) is an independent not for profit organization dedicated to supporting children and families in Indonesia who are affected by cleft lip and palate, as well as other craniofacial conditions. Founded with a deep belief that every child deserves the chance to smile with confidence, the foundation works to bridge the gaps in access to essential medical care—particularly for families from underserved and remote regions.

WHAT WE DO

Yayasan Senyum Bali provides comprehensive support for patients and their families, including access to safe and timely surgery, medical coordination, accommodation, transportation, and post-operative care. Working closely with plastic surgeons, hospitals, and medical partners, our programs focus on restoring smiles while ensuring families are supported throughout the entire treatment journey. All assistance is provided free of charge to Indonesian citizens from lower socio-economic backgrounds, without discrimination based on religion, political belief, or ethnic background.



WHERE WE GO

Our work extends across **Bali and Eastern Indonesia**, supporting patients from remote islands and regions where access to specialized medical services is limited. Through partnerships with government and private hospitals, Yayasan Senyum Bali serves children from Bali, Nusa Tenggara, Java, Papua, and other parts of Indonesia, bringing hope and healing to those who need it most.

Chairperson Message



The year 2025 was a meaningful and impactful one for Yayasan Senyum Bali, which made it more special as we celebrate our 20th anniversary.

I am deeply grateful to our partners, donors, medical teams, and supporters whose commitment continues to transform lives.

In 2025, we supported 139 surgical procedures through regular surgery programs and medical outreach programs, including cleft lip and palate surgeries, bone grafts, and other more severe craniofacial procedures. Each surgery represents a child given the chance to heal, grow, and smile with confidence. Our commitment to comprehensive care continued through post-surgical speech therapy, supporting long-term recovery and improved quality of life.

Education and prevention remained essential to our work. Through a nutrition seminar in Singaraja, Bali, we helped families better understand child nutrition, particularly for children preparing for surgery. We also strengthened our impact through meaningful partnerships and

collaborations, allowing us to reach more communities in need.

Beyond our core programs, we extended support to other Yayasan i.e. Yayasan Bali Baby Home, and provided emergency assistance to flood-affected communities through donated clothing collected via the Smile Shops. The Smile Shop, established in 2007, continues to be a cornerstone of our sustainability, and we were pleased to relocate one of our shops to a new space in Nyuh Kuning, Ubud

Fundraising events such as the COMO Uma Ubud Charity Dinner and BIKU Carols Dinner played an important role in sustaining our mission and building awareness.

2025 is particularly meaningful as we celebrate our 20th anniversary. It is also a year marked by loss, as we said goodbye to our Founder, Ibu Mary Northmore. While her absence is deeply felt, her vision, compassion, and unwavering dedication continue to guide our work. We remain committed to carrying forward her legacy, and we remain committed to restoring smiles and creating lasting change. Thank you to everyone who continues to walk this journey with us.

Her passing left a deep sense of loss. Yet her values, her vision, and her belief in every child's right to smile continue to guide our work. With the support of our medical partners, donors, volunteers, and community, we move forward—honouring her legacy by continuing the mission she built with love, now carried on with hope.

By the end of December 2025, Yayasan Senyum Bali had provided transformative care to **3,899 patients** through more than **4,154 surgeries**, helping children and families to get healthier, more confident and gain a new hope

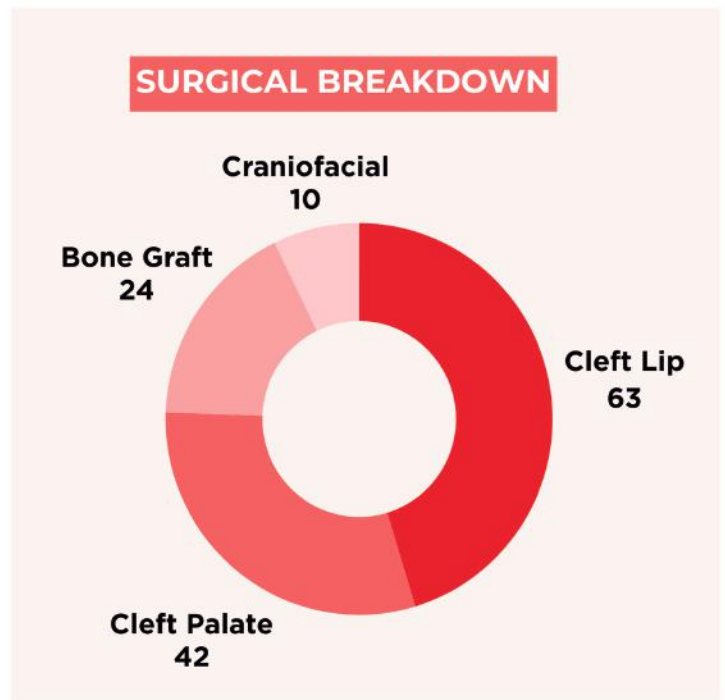
Medical Outreach

In this milestone year, we also proudly strengthened our medical network through new hospital partnerships, which helps us to provide services more efficiently across western, central, and southern Bali. These collaborations mark an important step toward our ongoing goal of expanding access to care—ensuring that every patient can receive treatment, no matter how far they come from.



Surgical Care & Medical Outreach

In 2025, Yayasan Senyum Bali supported a total of **139 surgical procedures**. The surgeries addressed diverse medical needs and were performed through a combination of regular hospital services and special medical outreach programs.



Beyond regular surgical services, several procedures were conducted through **medical outreach missions and hospital anniversary programs**, in collaboration with our medical partners:

These collaborations allowed us to reach more patients and bring services closer to communities with limited access to specialized care.

In early October 2025, Yayasan Senyum Bali welcomed a group of six patients from the **Sula Islands, North Maluku**, accompanied by volunteers who also came from the same region. Among them:

- Four were new patients
- Two were recalled patients requiring follow-up care

This visit marked the third group of patients from Maluku supported by Yayasan Senyum Bali, following similar patient groups in 2023 and 2024. Their arrival served as a meaningful reminder of our ongoing commitment to reaching children from Maluku and other remote parts of Indonesia.

In 2025, Yayasan Senyum Bali continued to support post-surgical recovery through speech therapy services as part of our comprehensive care program, made possible through the support of our partners.

The initiative was implemented as a batch program involving **eight patients per session** and plays a crucial role in helping children improve speech clarity and confidence following cleft palate surgery. In total, **35 patients** will be supported through this program.

Looking ahead, we hope to develop this initiative into a regular speech therapy program to further strengthen long-term outcomes for our patients.





Education & Awareness

Education & Awareness remains an essential part of prevention and long-term impact. In March 2025, Yayasan Senyum Bali conducted a **nutrition seminar in Singaraja**, focusing on improving community understanding of child nutrition, especially for families whose children face challenges in gaining adequate weight before surgery.

To broaden public understanding of cleft conditions and our mission, Yayasan Senyum



Bali participated in a **radio talk show on RRI Pro 2 Denpasar**, sharing insights on cleft care, patient journeys, and the importance of early treatment and community support. On this occasion, one of our patient, Atong and his sister Raiya, also tells their story.

Smile House: A Home Away from Home

Throughout 2025, Smile House continued to serve as a **safe and supportive space for patients** and families during their treatment journey—providing accommodation, emotional support, and a sense of community while children undergo surgery and recovery.

By offering a secure and supportive environment, **Smile House remains an essential part** of Yayasan Senyum Bali's holistic approach to healing—supporting not only medical recovery, but also the well-being of the entire family.

During the year, **41 patients stayed at Smile House**, each accompanied by one companion, allowing parents or caregivers to remain close throughout the surgical and recovery process. This support plays a vital role in reducing the emotional and financial burden on families while ensuring children receive proper care before and after surgery.

Smile Shop

Established in 2007, the Smile Shop is Yayasan Senyum Bali's long-standing initiative to build a sustainable and independent source of funding for operational costs. For nearly two decades, the Smile Shop has played an important role in ensuring that the foundation can continue its work effectively while directing medical support and sponsorships primarily toward patient care.

Currently, Yayasan Senyum Bali operates **two Smile Shop locations**: one in **Nyuh Kuning, Ubud**, and one in **Danau Buyan, Sanur**. Both locations offer a curated selection of new and preloved items, including books, clothing, shoes, and games. Through this initiative, everyone can take part in our mission—contributing in a meaningful way while discovering unique treasures

Income generated from Smile Shop sales is critical to the sustainability of Yayasan Senyum Bali. Proceeds from the shops help **cover administrative** and **operational expenses**, as well as temporarily **fund surgeries for patients** who do not yet have a sponsor but already have a confirmed surgery schedule, this ensures that no child's treatment is delayed, while allowing contributions designated for medical programs to be used directly to support patients throughout their treatment journeys.



In September 2025, the Smile Shop in **Nyuh Kuning relocated** to a new space approximately 50 meters from its previous location. While the new shop is more compact, the move marked a fresh beginning—creating a more intimate and welcoming environment that reflects our focus on community connection and purposeful giving. Despite limited space and parking, the shop continues to thrive through the support of our community and loyal visitors.

We extend our sincere gratitude to all donors who generously contribute new and preloved items to be sold at the Smile Shop. Your continued support has sustained this initiative since 2007 and has made a lasting impact on the children and families we serve.



Smile Bus

Senyum Bali revitalised its operational car by acquiring a **new Smile Mini Bus** —a smaller, more **efficient** vehicle purchased to replace the former Smile Bus. This transition was made to better meet current operational needs, as the previous larger bus was no longer suitable. The new Smile Car enables our team to **access patients** living in narrow streets and densely populated areas, and provides more flexible transportation to and from hospitals. This improvement is especially important as patients are now supported across multiple partner hospitals, requiring greater mobility and operational efficiency.

Beyond patient transport, the Smile Mini Bus plays an important role in **donation collection** and distribution for the Smile Shop, enabling smoother and more efficient logistics. Its compact size allows for greater flexibility and easier patient mobilization, contributing to safer, more comfortable, and more efficient daily operations.

The Smile Mini Bus also reflects our commitment to environmentally responsible practices. By using regular gasoline instead of diesel (solar), the vehicle produces **lower emissions**, making it a more eco-friendly option for urban and short-distance travel.





Our 20th Anniversary

Celebrating 20 Years of Giving Children A New Smile

During the anniversary month, Yayasan Senyum Bali had the special opportunity to gather together donors, long-time friends, hospital partners, doctors, volunteers, patients, and their families—many of whom have been part of our journey since the very beginning. These moments were deeply nostalgic, offering a heartfelt reflection on how far we have come together over the past two decades.

On 5 August 2025, we joyfully marked the **20th anniversary of Yayasan Senyum Bali at Arundina Restaurant**, together with long-time supporters including **Prof. David David of ACFU Australia, Caroline and Mrs. Ria from the Benjamin Foundation**, as well as dedicated doctors, hospital partners, volunteers, patients, and their families.

The gathering became especially meaningful as patients and former patients took part in the celebration. One patient supported by the Benjamin Foundation performed a gong together with friends, while patients supported through our long-standing partner Amadea presented a traditional dance. These performances created a powerful and emotional moment—allowing us to witness children we once supported grow into confident teenagers, sharing their talents with the very community that once supported them. It was a deeply touching reflection of the lasting impact of our work and the strong bonds formed throughout our journey.

Following this celebration, **on Friday, 8 August 2025, COMO Uma Ubud** kindly hosted a **20th Anniversary Dinner in support of Yayasan Senyum Bali** at Kemiri Restaurant. The evening brought together board members, donors, and friends in a warm and meaningful reunion, **joined by our founder, Ibu Mary Northmore**, once again reminding us how far the foundation has come over the past two decades.

The evening featured a **silent auction, raffle draw, Balinese dance performances by our patients, and a fashion bazaar and show by the Smile Charity Shop**. We extend our deepest gratitude to everyone who made this milestone celebration possible, and especially to COMO Uma Ubud for their generous support in hosting an unforgettable evening dedicated to continuing the mission of giving children a new smile.

Patient Story: Hafis & Hali

A Father and Son, One Journey, One New Smile

Hafis is an active and cheerful third child from the **Sula Islands, North Maluku**. In September 2025, he traveled to Bali with both of his parents to undergo cleft lip surgery. What makes their journey especially remarkable is that Hafis and his father, Hali, share the same diagnosis—**unilateral incomplete cleft lip**—and underwent surgery together.

Throughout their treatment journey, they were lovingly **accompanied by Hafis' mother**, who also cared for her husband during recovery. Her constant presence and patience played a vital role in supporting both father and son through consultations, surgery, and post-operative care.

The journey to this moment began earlier. In early 2024, our volunteers from the Sula Islands invited Hali to travel to Bali with another patient group for his surgery. At the time, **Hali chose to postpone his treatment**, as his wife was expecting their child. In March 2024, Hafis was born—and he too was diagnosed with a cleft lip.

It was not until September 2025 that the family was finally able to travel together, **joining a group of six patients** and our volunteers from the Sula Islands. **On 3 October 2025**, both Hafis and Hali successfully underwent cleft lip surgery, receiving their new smiles side by side.

The surgeries were performed by **dr. Putu Trisna Utami, Sp. B.P.R.E., Subsp. K.M.(K) at Kasih Ibu Saba Hospital, Gianyar**; they took place during the hospital's anniversary which made the occasion even more meaningful for everyone involved.

For Yayasan Senyum Bali, Hafis and Hali's story reflects a reality we continue to encounter. Similar cases have appeared among patient groups from the Sula Islands in 2023, 2024, and 2025, highlighting how limited access to information and medical services in remote regions can delay treatment across generations.

Their journey reminds us that cleft conditions are medical conditions—not a stigma or fate—and that early information, timely access to care, and community outreach are crucial. With the right support, even families from the most remote areas can receive life-changing treatment—together.

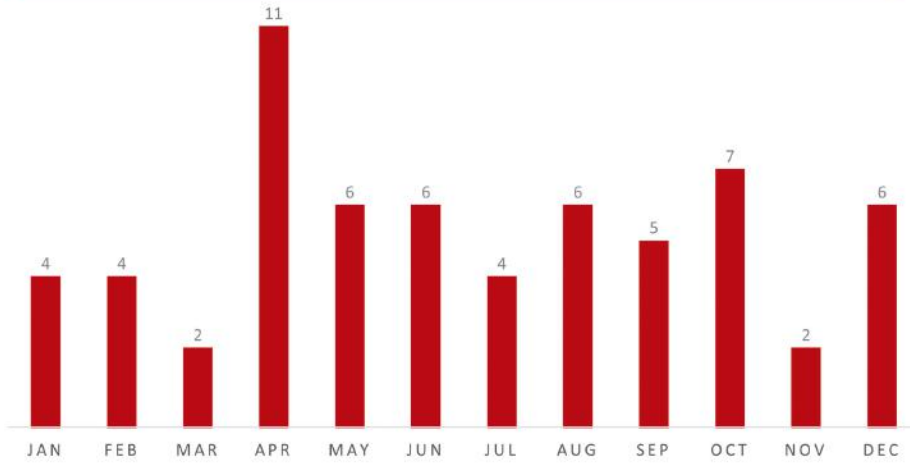

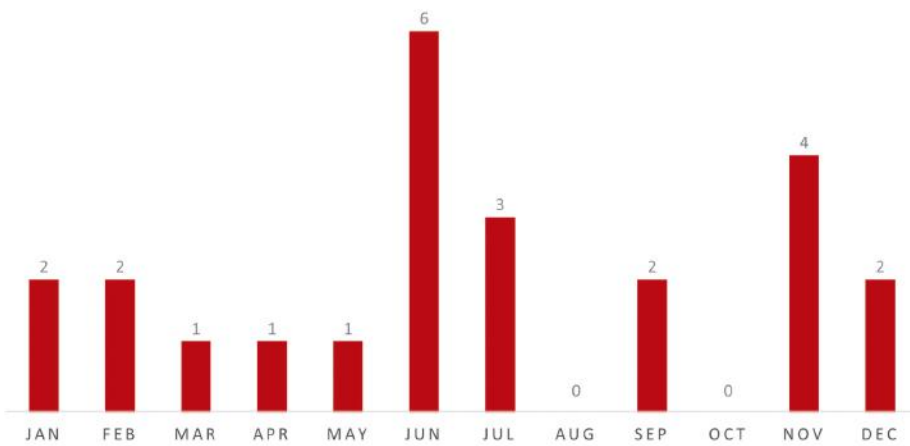

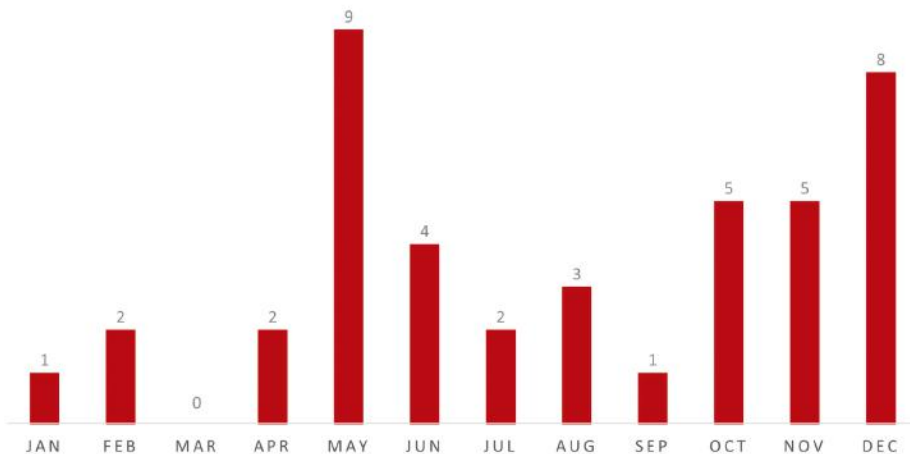
TOTAL CLEFT LIP SURGERIES OF 2025



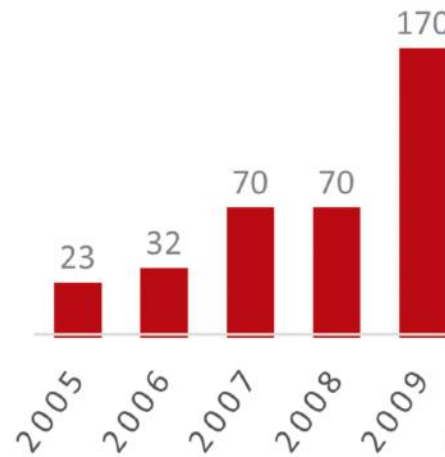
TOTAL CLEFT BONE GRAFT SURGERIES OF 2025



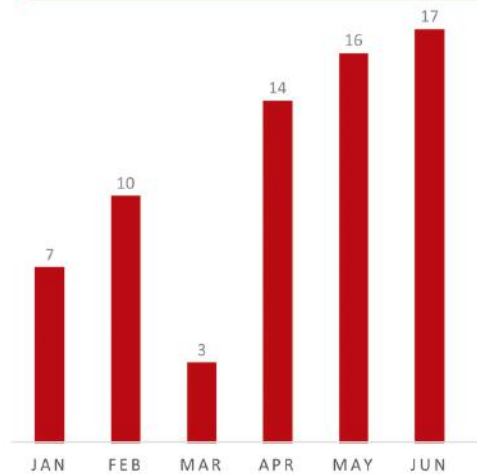
TOTAL CLEFT PALATE SURGERIES OF 2025



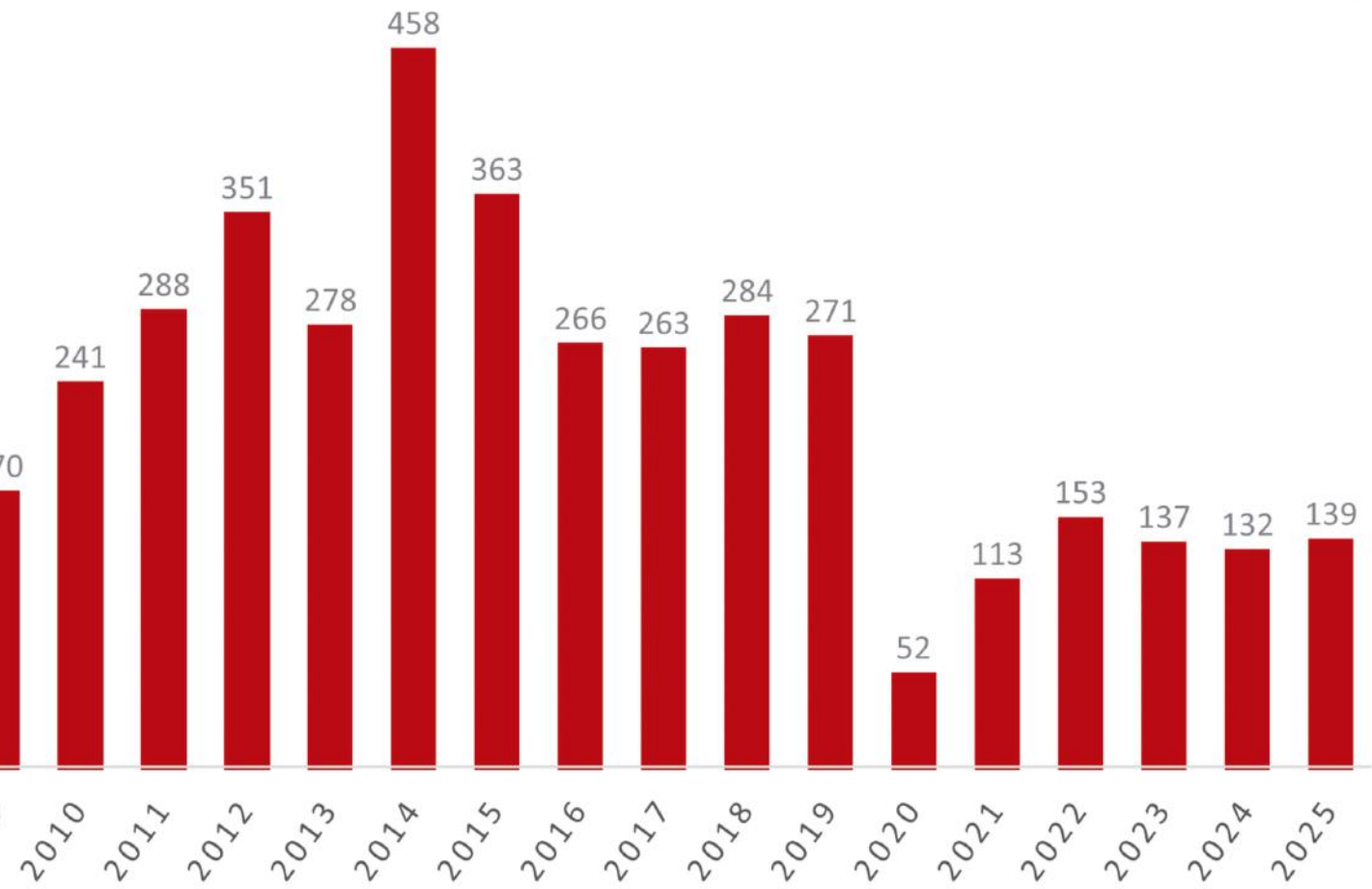

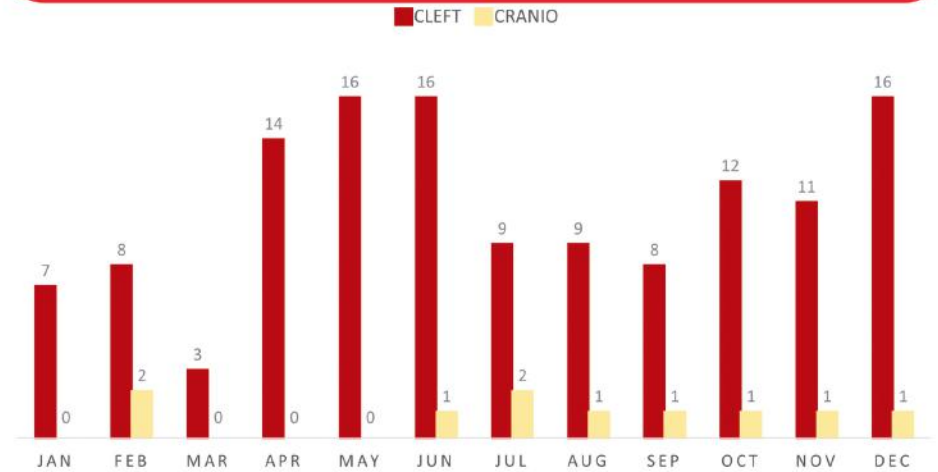
TOTAL SURGERIES 2005-2025


TOTAL CLEFT & CRANIO SURGERIES OF 2025




