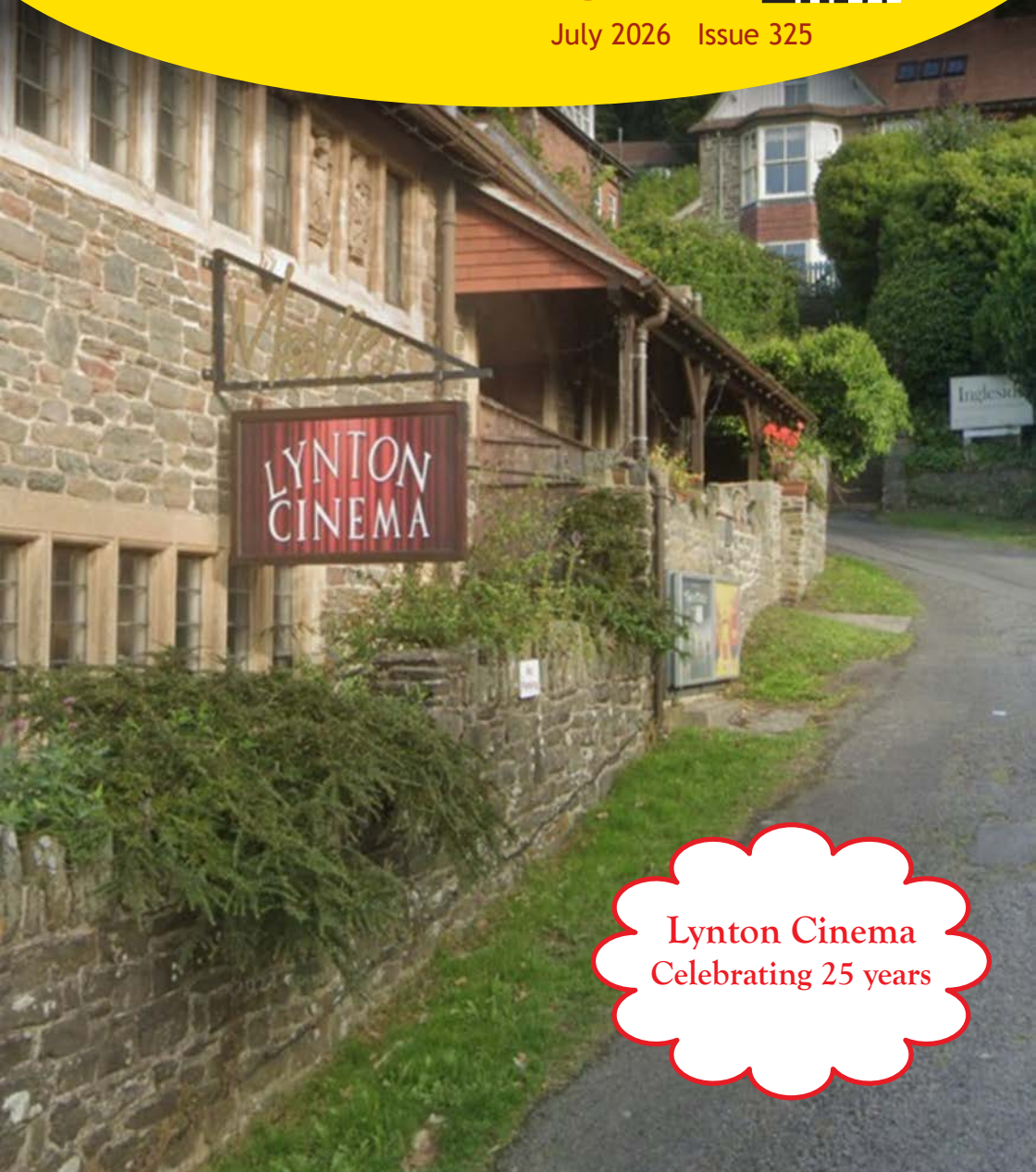

NORTH DEVON COUNCIL NEWS



14 June 2026

By the middle of July the government should announce the boundaries of the new unitary councils that will take over from the abolished District and County Councils. It should happen before Parliament breaks up for the summer on 16th July.

After that, later in the year there will be legislation that deals with implementing the new councils. That is very likely to mean that there will be elections to shadow versions of the new councils in May 2027. For the first year these shadow councils won't be delivering services like refuse collection or road maintenance, the old District/County will, instead they will be setting up new organisations. The great majority of the people that work for the current councils and deliver the services we receive will simply find that from April 2028 they will work for a new organisation with little change in their day to day activity. However, there will be a vast amount of work to do to set up the new councils.

What is this work that needs to be done? And who will do it?

Each of the current councils are quite different organisations and will have a large range of long term contracts, different employment policies, widely different IT systems, a large variety of assets and much much more that will need to be translated into a different organisation. And it will need to be done without the services you receive deteriorating. It also seems likely that the boundaries of the present councils will be

broken meaning part will be in one unitary and part in another. This change can take years; for example, in a unitary council that was created six years ago they are only now starting to breakup up the pre-existing social services arrangements that were delivered by the defunct County Council. As for who will do all this, it will be the people that presently work for the Districts and County, and who would otherwise be delivering and trying to improve the services we all receive. It is a massive challenge.

A side effect of all this is that elections to the District Councils that would have taken place next May are very likely to be cancelled with the present District Councillors (e.g me) staying for an extra year while the old councils run in parallel to the new.

Back to the present. In case you didn't know from 1 April 2026, you can add a few more items to your kerbside recycling. Tetra Paks (like orange juice and milk cartons) and crisp tubes (such as Pringles) will now be accepted. Simply flatten and pop them in your brown recycling bag with the rest of your recycling.

My apologies for not being able to make it to the councillor surgery in June, but I've recovered now. The next is on 4th July. As usual in the Lynton Town Hall Jubilee Room. I'm there from 11am to 1pm, with the Mayor of L&L there from 10am to midday.

MAKING A SCARECROW

Thanks to the late Tim Prosser who was responsible for the first Scarecrow Festival in 2008, and the following instructions).

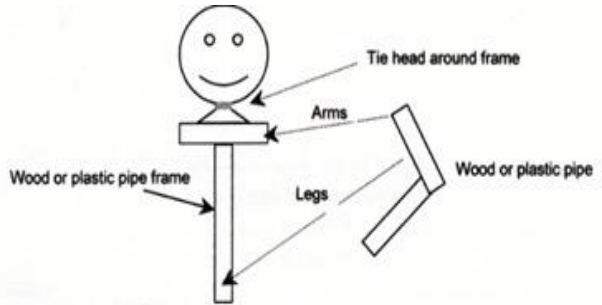
Figures are cheap and easy to make from scrap materials such as wood, cardboard, paper, plastic bags, old tights, rubber gloves and straw. If using newspaper for packing your figure, put in a plastic bag to stop rain damage. Cheap items of clothing can sometimes be found at jumble sales, at a recycling centre or in a charity shop.

Body Two pieces of 1" x 1" timber for body and shoulders will give a basic support for the figure. There is no need for a timber framework if the figure is supported, eg tied onto a bike or sat on a chair. Old pieces of plastic pipe drilled and tied together can be used as a framework.

Arms and Legs Pieces of 1" x 1" timber (or pipe) fixed to the bottom of body frame or shoulders – use two pieces of timber screwed together if elbow or knee joint is required – pad with straw, paper, bubble wrap or material. Flesh coloured tights stuffed with straw or material can be used for heads, limbs. Old rubber gloves are ideal for making hands.

Head Use a cheap plastic ball. Apply detail with acrylic paints which are waterproof when dry. You can also cut about 2ft from the toe end of a pair of tights, pack to a head shape and tie around the neck framework.

Hair can be painted or use straw, wool or a nylon wig. A mask can be used for the face but painting it with your own design will give it an individual look.



Any paper or card signs used on your display should be laminated or waterproofed with clear varnish

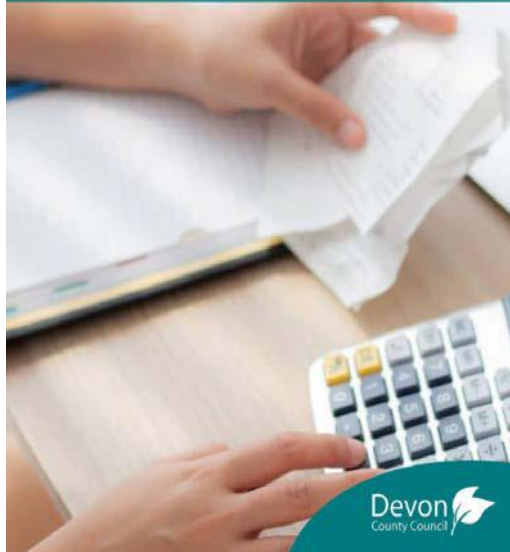

Two Moors Way celebrates 50 years and officially extends to the South Devon coast

Since its launch in 1976 the Two Moors Way has become one of the South West's most popular long-distance walking routes linking Exmoor and Dartmoor National Parks.

Originally running from Ivybridge on the southern edge of Dartmoor to Lynmouth on the North Devon coast, the trail crosses both National Parks and the mid-Devon countryside over a distance of more than 100 miles.

To mark its 50th anniversary the Two Moors Way has been officially extended to include the Erme-Plym Trail between Ivybridge and Wembury making Wembury on the South Devon coast the route's new southern terminus. While the Erme-Plym Trail retains its own identity it is now formally recognised as part of the continuous coast-to-coast journey which spans 117 miles and nearly 16,000 feet of ascent.

The extension reflects how many walkers already experience the route and highlights Devon's unique status as the only county in England with two coastlines and two National Parks. For five decades the Two Moors Way has helped thousands enjoy the physical and mental health benefits of walking while connecting communities, historic landscapes and market towns across Devon. It remains a strong example of how access to nature can support wellbeing, local businesses and a sense of place.

A third edition of the official guidebook by Sue Viccars, Information Officer for the Two Moors Way Association, will be published by Cicerone Press this summer.

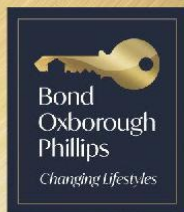

When your phone goes missing ...

Dear Readers,

There are few modern inconveniences that can create the feeling of panic as realising your phone is missing. One moment it is in your pocket, the next it has vanished into thin air. Before long, you are checking every room in the house, retracing your steps and wondering if it has been left in a shop, dropped in a car park, or simply slipped between the sofa cushions yet again.

The good news for most of us is that modern smartphones are much easier to find than they used to be provided a few settings have been enabled beforehand, which is what I will talk about today.

Firstly, iPhone. Easy to start with. Make sure 'Find my iPhone' is turned on. You can check this by opening Settings, tapping your name at the top, selecting 'Find My' and double checking this feature is enabled. If the phone goes missing you can log into your Apple account from another device and see its location on a map, make it play a loud sound, mark it as lost, or even erase it remotely if necessary. Using this last option is a last resort!

Android users have a similar feature called 'Find my Device'. This is usually enabled when you sign in with a Google account but it is worth checking. Open the Settings and look for 'Find my Device'. If your phone evaporates you can search for it online, ring it remotely, secure it or wipe the data if there is no hope of recovery. again this is only to be used as a last resort.

One tip (as I explained a few months ago) is adding emergency contact information to your lock screen. If an honest person finds your phone giving them a way to contact you can dramatically improve the chances of recovering your prized device. You would be surprised how many lost phones are returned simply because someone had an easy way to identify the owner.

The last option of remotely wiping your device is significant. There is generally no issue with using this but you must ensure cloud backups for photos and contacts, or even the full device is set up. Losing a phone is frustrating. Losing years of photographs at the same time is far worse. These days automatic backups mean that even if the device is never seen again, your memories and important information remains safe.

Obviously do not wait until the phone is missing to check these settings. Spend five minutes today making sure everything is enabled and working properly so that if you need it, you have it. To quote my wife 'my future self will thank me' and she is right.

Finally, statistics are unavailable but I suspect that half the time the lost phone is down the back of the sofa!

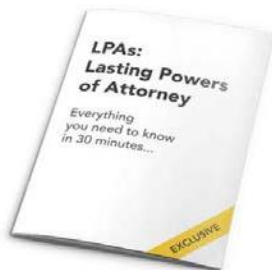

The Lynton & Barnstaple Railway Trust (L&BRT) and the Barnstaple & Yeo Valley Railway Trust (B&YVRT) have signed an agreement to work more closely together in pursuit of a shared vision: the restoration of one of Britain's most celebrated lost railways.

On 17th June 2026 at Chelfham Station, Giles Perkins, Chair of the L&BRT, and Bruce Knights, Chair of Trustees of the B&YVRT, signed a Memorandum of Understanding which formalises the relationship between the two organisations and establishes clear roles and responsibilities for future collaboration.

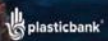

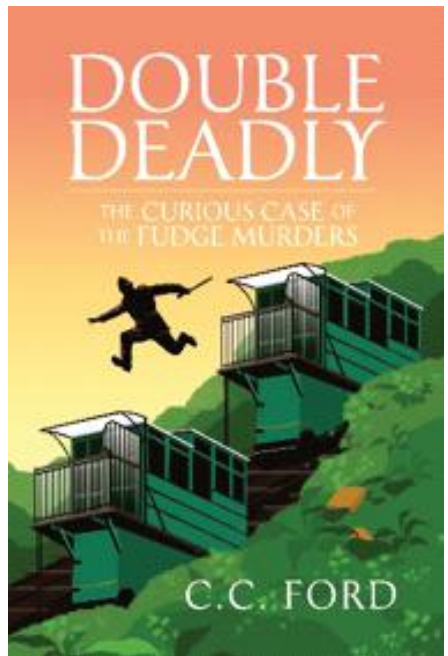
