Hen says, “Go over the fence and see.”




Rooster says, “I want to see the other side of the forest.”

Goat says, “Go through the forest and see.”




Rooster says, “I want to see the other side of the mountain.”

Rooster says, “I want to see the other side of the river.”


Fish says, “Go across the river and see.”

Snake says, “Go across the plains and see.”




Rooster says, “I want to see the other side of the jungle.”
Eagle says, “Go under the trees and see.”




Rooster says, “I want to see the other side of the city.”
