We also provide an integrated mindfulness curriculum to help our students cope with pressures of living in a digital age, as well as preparing them for life beyond Myddelton.




















Student Support

Myddelton College is a close and friendly learning community that prides itself on the quality of the relationships between staff, students and parents

Our student support consists of:

- 1. Regular meetings with pastoral tutors
- 2. Peer support groups
- 3. Cultural workshops

We incorporate support within the classroom as required through targeted help within small groups and individual assistance from specialist teachers.

Regularly updated Individual Support Plans are written for students with either pre-existing or newly-identified learning needs or disabilities, with input from the student, their parents, and their teachers.

Every student has daily care, which is managed by their tutor. During the school day, Heads of Houses oversee the pastoral care of the students in their houses. Our Boarding Team work with all staff to ensure the wellbeing of our boarding students is carefully monitored. This enables a seamless and enjoyable transition between the school day and boarding life.

Students are encouraged to care for one another, disputes and disagreements are dealt with through restorative practices.

We encourage students to manage their state of mind and relationships positively.

We place great importance on establishing a nurturing atmosphere in which everyone feels secure, happy and is positively engaged.

We encourage friendships with fellow students from all over the world, and within their Houses and Year Groups who become family during their time at Myddelton.

There are a variety of regular House activities throughout the year. Students are encouraged to be a part of our Prefect Team and Student Parliament as they progress through the school.

Myddelton Prep



Myddelton Preparatory School teaches students between the ages of 3 1/2 - 10 (Reception - Year 6)

At Myddelton Preparatory School, we understand that our role is not only to teach our students the skills and knowledge wanted by their future employers, but also to equip them with the skills needed to thrive in the 21st Century.

In addition to being taught the core subjects, English, Maths and Science by their classroom tutor, our pupils are also taught subjects such as Spanish, performing arts and sport by subject-specialist teachers.

In order to help our young Myddeltonians become well-rounded individuals, they are introduced to mindfulness from an early age. We teach the Paws B curriculum which has been developed by the Mindfulness in Schools Project.

In addition, our students enjoy Outdoor Adventure classes every fortnight. During these sessions, not only do they have the opportunity to apply, develop and enhance the skills learnt in their classroom sessions, but they also get to learn new skills, such as working as a team, adapting to change, taking responsibility for themselves, and most importantly, having fun!

Technology has changed the way we learn at Myddelton Prep, bringing an era of genuine personalisation. Students are able to access support and challenge within lessons, which encourages them to become independent learners.

We fully encourage the integration of the Prep School into Myddelton College through the use of our House System. Students are assigned to Houses when they begin their journey at Myddelton, and will take part in many activities in their Houses throughout the school year.

Our students are happy, confident and articulate individuals, we are looking forward to welcoming you to our Myddelton Prep family, where small class sizes and a diverse student community go hand-in-hand with personal development.









Senior School

Moving into the Senior School is an exciting stage in the educational journey.

From the first year in Senior School, students start making choices about what they study, with GCSE options considered in the Spring term of Year 9. It is also a time where the pressure on students can be at its greatest: which is why we place importance on mindfulness and excellent pastoral support within the curriculum.

Lessons are designed to use each student's full capabilities, and field trips are memorable visits that bring studies to life.

Students are encouraged to take an active part in the classroom conversation, as well as participating in extra-curricular activities.

Students will undergo classes on; personal profiling, understanding their skills, and developing an individual development plan. This plan focuses on providing a platform to help them realise their full potential in entering the middle school.

Specialist teachers and support staff inspire our students to work to the limits of their potential and prepare them for the next steps in life while learning more about themselves and developing a broad range of interests. Our diverse community celebrates kindness and ambition. Over the years ahead, our students will find many opportunities coming their way. We ask them to make the most of these; get involved, ask questions, and discover new ways to express themselves.

We offer a wide variety of subjects; English, Mathematics, Sciences, Art, Business Studies, Computer Science, Drama, Geography, History, Outdoor Adventure Education (OAE), Music, Physical Education, Politics, Philosophy and Ethics (PPE) and Spanish.

Years 10 - 11 GCSE

This is an important time when pupils make personal and academic choices regarding future studies

Students choose and study their GCSE options between the ages of 15-16.

Our philosophy at Myddelton College is to inspire in our students a love of learning. We do this through our small class sizes, passionately committed staff and a broad curriculum that offers a strong core of academic subjects alongside creative and other options. This desire to learn carries our students through to successful results in exams and on to the universities and careers of their choice.

Challenge, collaboration and communication are core skills that are focussed upon at GCSE. Students must share their knowledge and skills. Challenge themselves and their peers daily and above all, have fun.

GCSE years are a time of hard work however we also encourage students to pursue other talents and interests beyond the classroom.

Teachers strongly support the decision to participate in extracurricular activities, in order to develop wider learning and passion projects.

There is a common core of subjects, comprising of; English (Language and Literature), Mathematics and Science. Science can be studied via two different pathways, individual or combined.

In addition to this, students can select from the following optional subjects: Art, Business Studies, Computer Science, Drama, Geography, History, Music, Physical Education, Religious Studies, Spanish and Additional Mathematics and Statistics.









Sixth Form A Level

We inspire a thirst for knowledge in all of our students and a desire to succeed that prepares them for life beyond Myddelton

The Sixth Form is a time of new opportunities and challenges; to study a smaller number of chosen subjects in depth, to broaden intellectual and cultural horizons, and to have the experience of leadership.

From entry into the Sixth Form there is expert career advice and guidance given from the Head of Sixth Form, University advisers and Oxbridge graduates.
Students receive an in depth UCAS training programme, with coordinated Open Days and Career Exhibition Days.

At this stage, students are encouraged to participate in work experience in the careers that they seek to embark in when they leave school. The grades they achieve in the Sixth Form are pivotal in terms of opening doors to the next stage in your life, whether that is into university or employment.

In addition to academic excellence, we inspire physical, mental and creative talents.

All pupils in our Sixth Form are educated and guided within the curriculum and have the opportunity to be entered for the Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award and will receive in depth UCAS coaching led by Oxbridge alumni.

Students in the Sixth Form take on key areas of responsibility with the opportunity to be Prefects, Peer Mentors, Sports Captains, Performance Directors and Commanders in the Combined Cadet Force (CCF).

Our Sixth Form department strives to take a global perspective on Higher Education, inspiring students to consider not only universities within the United Kingdom, but also around the world.

Our Sixth Form education is an interactive process which empowers our pupils to become proactive and independent learners. Teachers encourage students to effectively manage their time to find the perfect balance between work and play.

Weekend Activities

We offer an extensive range of trips and activities which take place each weekend and throughout half term breaks. Parents are welcome to visit students in the evenings and weekends. Our trip programmes include visits to a number of cities such as Manchester and Liverpool. There are regular outings to the cinema, ice skating, and local towns and shopping centres to do a bit of shopping. We also offer more active excursions that allow students to explore the rural areas of Wales such as Zip World and Flip Out!

We offer students the opportunity to remain in school over half terms and to participate in several trips and activities. Popular activities include team sports, baking and cinema trips as well as seasonal fun such as Halloween pumpkin carving and Christmas decoration making.

Food

Myddelton students come from across the world, and we are equipped to cater for all dietary requirements. Breakfast ranges from traditional British to continental, and lunch and dinners consist of hot and cold food to suit all needs. Themed nights are a regular occurrence and are based on nationalities like Spanish Tapas Meals, or events such as Chinese New Year and the Mid-Autumn Festival.

We also offer the opportunity to complete official LTA (Lawn Tennis Association) Coaching badges, which can demonstrate leadership, organisation and enhance your personal statement and UCAS application.

Football Academy

Myddelton College partner with Advance Player Development (APD) to offer an opportunity for pupils to excel both in the classroom and on the pitch.

The Football Academy aims to help young footballers experience a professional environment and unlock their potential. You will develop skills such as teamwork, leadership and resilience which will be vital later in life.

Outdoor Adventure

Our Outdoor Adventure Education programme is tailored to each individual student.

It begins at the starting point of each learner, taking into account levels of self-esteem, confidence as well as communication and organisation skills

Students in Years 3 to 10 have one OAE day every other week.

Activities include mountain walking, navigation skills, bushcraft, climbing, abseiling, kayaking, canoeing, raft-building and sailing as well as various team challenges.

Senior students concentrate on stress management, resilience, and future goal setting, all of which are important skills to learn in preparation for exams and life after school.

We acknowledge the elements of risk with OAE, as with every aspect of life. At Myddelton we are not averse to exposing our students to risk, we manage it by preparing students with the skills to identify and respond appropriately and self regulate through following instructions and using the appropriate kit.



OAE is such a great opportunity for the children. It builds resilience, stamina and independence, and the children really look forward to it! It's so important for children to be outdoors and connect with themselves and their surroundings, challenge what they're capable of.



Performing Arts



We have a 100% A* - A grades at GCSE and A Level, in all Performing Arts subjects!

Myddelton students are highly successful in the arts.

We offer examinations at GCSE, A Level and LAMDA graded performances, as well as producing both small and large scale productions in school.

Students and staff have experience of working professionally in the industry.

All students who have applied for high calibre acting degree courses have been offered places in prestigious acting schools such as East 15 Acting School. On our campus we have a full scale 300-seat theatre and dance studio with a sprung floor.

We offer high quality tuition and myriad facilities to support a wide variety of instruments, several private practice rooms and numerous performance spaces. We also have a bespoke music room and a recording studio.

From Prep School to Sixth Form, there are many opportunities for students to express themselves through a variety of annual school performances.

Activities


















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
