**Content** Children will enjoy seeing a beloved character in a new genre. The illustrations support understanding of the plot.

(pp. 21–25) Why do you think the author chose to tell this story as a play? How does the play format suit this story? How does the play end?

### Reading Tips: fl

**Before Reading**

- Read aloud the title of the book. Have children use the title and the cover illustration to make predictions about what the story will be about.
- Introduce the *fl* sound. Explain to children that the letters *fl* are a blend that is used in words like *fly*. Write the word *fly* on the chalkboard and have a volunteer circle the letters *fl*. Go through the pronunciation of the word with the children. Ask them to suggest other words that contain the *fl* sound.
- Have children listen as you read the title again. Ask them to name all the words in the title that have the *fl* sound.
- Tell children that this book has lots of words with the *fl* sound and that the words are in boldface type. Skim the book with children and look for words containing the *fl* sound. Have children point to a few of them as you read them together. Run your hand under each letter as you blend each word aloud. Say and hold each sound in the word, blending the sounds together. Then have children repeat the word.
