



I've caught a tasty tent spider for my egg. When the grub hatches, it can feast for days.




I need to drag it back to my nest hole. Phew!




Home sweet home.



I'll leave it here while I check the size of the entrance hole.




Hmmm. The spider should fit easily.




Let's get this inside—it looks like rain.




I can't quite—make it—fit. Argh!




Okay, I'll measure the hole. So, it's about this big ...




... and the spider is about this big.




I just need to make this hole a little wider.
