



For those seniors designating a proxy, the proxy should come as well so they understand the process of shopping.

If you qualify, you will receive your vouchers that day. If you have questions, call 417-862-0762.

To qualify, bring:

- Proof of Income (current bank statement, 2024 tax return)
- 2. Proof of Identity (drivers license or Missouri ID)
- Proof of Residency (current utility bill or current bank statement)
- Proof of Age (must be 60 or older) drivers license or birth certificate
- Designated Proxy (if you want someone to do the shopping for you)
