BACKGROUND

Editor Ade Scott has been a professional rope specialist and operational rescuer for over 40 years, 15 of these as Head of Operations -Technical Rescue Unit. Unit personnel continue to provide training, testing and trialing of equipment for the magazines and because of the number of firefighters on the Unit also qualified as arborists it was a natural evoultion to add ARBCLIMBER as the world's only truly international title concentrating on eugipment and techniques. Our work is supported by an experienced team comprising full-time firefighters, coastguards, paramedics, arborists, doctors and water rescuers from around the world: Adam Jones is a full time firefighter and qualified arborist, Rich Hackwell qualified arborist and Asst head of Rescue UK Coastguard, Reed Thorne is TRm's US Rope Rescue Editor while our sadly missed US Editor and water rescue guru the late Jim Segerstrom's work is taken on by his co-conspirator in the evolution of swiftwater Dr Mike Crosslin. In Oz we have Roland Curll of NSW Police Rescue, Mine's Rescue's Brian Robinson (Wales), Veteran London Fire Brigade officer and now Mountain Rescue instructor Darryl Ashford -Smith keeps us up to date on UK Mountain Rescue and drones while other London verterans Rich Denham and Nick Appleton cover extrication.
