This is made up of people from different child care centres (APEMS) and is specially formed for the holidays.

The educational team supports and encourages...

- CHILDREN'S PARTICIPATION

Children express their ideas and create their own activities with adult support.

- THE RIGHT TO BE DIFFERENT

Adults support children in accepting difference, so that everyone feels genuinely at home in the group.

- ENJOYING BEING TOGETHER

Children make friends, learn to get to know each other and share what they want and what interests them.

- CONFIDENCE

Adults have confidence in children's abilities, which helps them to form strong bonds and face experiences calmly.

Holiday child care for classes 1-6P (APEMS+VAC)



In brief...

- The APEMS+VAC service welcomes children from classes 1P to 6P during the school holidays and is part of the school holiday provision offered by the City of Lausanne.

Where does it happen?

In a number of APEMS child care centres in Lausanne.

Who is it for?

Places are primarily intended for families whose parents work, are taking a course or are job-seekers (registered with the Regional Employment Office – ORP). Priority is given to the youngest children.

..... MORNING

07.00 to 14.00

..... AFTERNOON

12.00 to 18.30

..... ALL DAY

07.00 to 18.30

Closed for three weeks during the summer and between Christmas and New Year
