1980

The club was formed under the name **Montagu FC** by former secretary **Russell Yezek**, before being renamed to **Sun FC**.

1995

The club was renamed to its current name, **Huntingdon Town**, following a move from the West Anglian League to the Cambridgeshire League, and entered the Cambs League Division 2B for the 1996-97 season. The club committee had decided it wanted to progress through local football, and chose to resurrect the then-defunct **Huntingdon Town** name, the name formerly used until the 1940's by a **Huntingdon**-based team that then merged with **Huntingdon Wanderers** to form **Huntingdon United** in 1948.

1998-2003

The club was promoted from Division 2B to 1B in 1997-98, before winning Division 1B in 1999-2000, as well as winning the **Huntingdon Junior Cup**. The following year, the club retained the **Hunts Junior Cup**, but was defeated in the **Hunts Scott Gatty Cup**.

The 2001-02 season saw more success, with the club going one step better to win the **Scott Gatty Cup**, and retaining the **Hunts Junior Cup** for the third year in a row. The club also finished runners up in the **Cambs League Senior B Division** and the **Percy Oldham Cup** in that season.

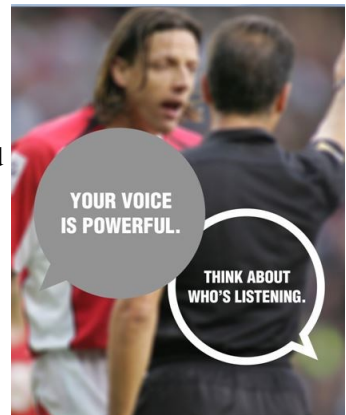
In 2003, the club moved to its current-day home, **Jubilee Park** (presently known as **Hunters Stadium**), which allowed work to be undertaken on facility upgrades needed to continue the club's progression through the leagues.

2003 also saw the club debut in the **UCL Division 1**, having transferred from the **Cambs League** at the end of 2002-03.

2003-08

The club's first four years in the **UCL** were more challenging, with the club finishing 17th, 14th, 12th and 14th respectively. However, the club's fifth season in the **UCL** was much more fruitful, the 2007-08 season seeing the club finish 4th, only missing out on promotion by goal difference. The reserve team won the **Reserve Division 2** title and won the **Hunts Benevolent Cup**.

In July 2004 the new floodlighting system was opened with a friendly against League 1 side **Peterborough United**, which attracted a crowd of nearly 1000 spectators.

2009-15

The new clubhouse was opened for the 2009-10 season, at a cost of £1.1 million. The only on-field success this season was the U18 side, who won the treble, the league, the League Cup and the County Cup.

2010-11 was an up-and-down year, with the team starting the season slowly until Ricky Marheineke & Paul Swannell took charge in February 2011, with the team sitting third bottom, and eventually guided the club to 5th by the end of the season. The pair built on this success in their first full season, 2011-12, storming to the United Counties League Division 1 title, scoring over 100 goals along the way, with Marheineke winning two Manager of the Month awards. Town also reached the semi-finals of the Hinchingsbrooke Cup but lost 3-0 to St Neots Town. 2011-12 also saw a 50-seater stand erected.

2012-13 saw Town finish a lofty 4th in their first season in the Premier Division, scoring over 100 goals, and reaching the final of the Hunts Senior Cup, however the club were beaten on penalties after a 0-0 draw, once again to St Neots Town. The second 50-seater stand was erected.

In 2013-14 Town finished 2nd in the league, but won the league KO cup and the Hinchingsbrooke Cup for the first time.

2014-15 and 2015-16 were far more difficult campaigns, with the club staving off relegation in 2014-15, before finishing rock bottom in 2015-16, however Town were reprieved from relegation by circumstance. 2015-16 also saw the loss of the Reserve and U18 teams by the end of the season.

Town finished bottom of the league again in 2016-17, and this time were relegated to Division 1, however the U18 team was restarted during the season.

Town finished 12th in Division 1 in its first season back (2017-18), but reached the final of the Hinchingsbrooke Cup.

2018-19 was another tough campaign for the club, finishing 3rd bottom.

2019-20 looked like more of the same, although investments were made to improve the pitch and other facilities at Jubilee Park. The club was 2nd bottom, however, when lockdown hit, and the season was suspended.

2020-21 was another curtailed season, with the club 10th when the season was suspended again. The club transferred to the Eastern Counties League Division 1 for 2021-22.

The club finished 7th in the ECL Division 1 in both 2021-22 and 2022-23, before being transferred again, to the Spartan South Midlands League Division One for 2023-24.

Under the new ownership of Richard Maxwell, and with a new coaching staff, ethos and new players, with facility upgrades over the off-season, the club finished 14th in 2023-24, and with more upgrades to the ground and facilities ahead of 2024-25, will be looking to move up the table.

DORKING WANDERERS owner Marc White took to the club's official twitter account on Monday afternoon following the FA Cup second round qualifying draw.

“Good luck to Horsham in the third qualifying round,” joked the colourful Wands boss, who has taken the club from park football to the top of the Non-League Pyramid.

Since first entering the competition in 2013, Dorking are yet to reach the first round proper.

For the last two seasons – because of their then Step 1 status – White's side had a bye until the fourth round qualifying stage.

Last year, with just one win required to reach the first round, they were drawn away to...you guessed it, Horsham. The Step 3 Hornets beat them 2-0 and went on to earn a famous 3-3 draw against Barnsley and a televised replay.

They were then reinstated after their League One opponents were found to have played an ineligible player and had a second bite of the cherry against Sutton United.

So White, with his trademark humour, is expecting the worst for his side when they meet next weekend with the National League North and South clubs now entering the competition.

At the time of writing there are still some replays to be sorted but the latest draw has thrown up some intriguing games.

The first round is still three ties away but, over the coming weeks, eyes will widen as it gets nearer. For many clubs, even getting to this stage feels like making it.

How about Newcastle Town drawing former EFL side Scunthorpe United?

The National League North leaders only dropped two points in their first six games, but they haven't won an FA Cup tie since 2018.

Newcastle, 15th in NPL West, beat Long Eaton United last Saturday. They've not reached the third qualifying round since 2010.

Nails & Tickenham hosting Chippenham Town is another tie that stands out.

It's only Nailsea's second season in the competition, and they've landed a plum draw against a side three divisions above them. Having beaten Cinderford Town, Reading City and Hartpury University, they won't roll over against the Bluebirds.

West Didsbury & Chorlton welcoming Darlington catches the eye too, as does Shifnal Town hosting Redditch United, while Wessex League AFC Stoneham take on Step 2 Salisbury.

Talking of good cup runs, Maidstone United's run to the last 16 was the FA Cup story of last season. That adventure began at Steyning Town Community. This time it starts against fellow National League South Hampton & Richmond Borough.

Who will make it through to the third round qualifying? Other than Horsham, of course!

CLUB HISTORY

Buckingham Football Club is a football club based in Buckingham, Buckinghamshire, England. Formed by a merger of Buckingham Athletic and Buckingham United in 2023, they are currently members of the Spartan South Midlands League Division One and play at Stratford Fields.

The club was first formed in 1933 as **Buckingham Juniors**, but it was three years before a ground was found, allowing the club to enter the Brackley and District League. When they got their ground, it was originally called Timm's Meadow, before later becoming Stratford Fields. In 1939 the club adopted **Buckingham Athletic FC** as its name. It then took the club 27 years to win its first trophy when in 1960–61 they won their first trophy, the North Bucks League Shield.

In 1965 they applied and was accepted to the Hellenic League where they played in Division 1 finishing a creditable mid-table position in their first season but also won the Berks & Bucks FA Junior Cup. Their success continued and in 68/69 was promoted to the Premier Division after finishing Division runners-up.

The late 60's brought about some good success for the whole club with the Youth, Reserve and First teams all picking up trophies with the First winning the Buckinghamshire Senior Cup for the first time.

After a steady decline in fortunes in 78/79 the club returned to the North Bucks League and it wasn't until the mid-80's that further success was achieved.

This was the start of a successful period for the club and after winning the North Bucks Premier League title they moved to the South Midlands Division 1 in 1985 winning the league at their first attempt, losing only 3 games throughout the season.

However, success came too quickly, and the ground facilities were not ready for promotion to the Premier Division so they had to remain in Division 1.

The following season they were once again knocking on the door of the Premier League as they finished runners-up but a last minute hold up on planning permission once again stalled promotion. However, promotion was achieved the following year when they did the league and cup double and with correct ground grading in place the club was promoted to the Premier League for the first time.

Throughout the 90's all the teams in the club consistently won trophies

although the highest the first team achieved in the Premier League was in 97 when they finished 5th.

The late 90's the club struggled financially, and they made a very difficult decision to drop out of the top flight and they were placed back in Division 2. A level of stability was brought about the club and in 2003 they were promoted back to Division 1.

Once again ground grading held the club back as in 2004 they finished runners-up in Division 1 and promotion back to the Premier league was denied.

Since 05/06 a huge amount of work has taken place to upgrade the clubhouse and football facilities but unfortunately success on the field has been sparse.

In 2023 Buckingham Athletic started talks with Buckingham United to bring the two clubs together with the sole purpose of having one senior football team in the town.

Buckingham United FC were formed in 2011 with the sole aim of providing local grassroots football. This began as a single Sunday side playing in Deanshanger due to a lack of local facilities. After the first season the club moved to Tingewick but it was not until 2016 when the club finally moved into Buckingham to the new Lace Hill Sports and Community Centre. The club joined the North Bucks and District League before joining the South Midlands League Division Two in 2019. Here the club grew quickly providing grassroots football across various levels and abilities which peaked with eight teams by 2021, this included Saturday First and Reserves, Sunday League A & B sides, Veterans, Ladies along with an Under 21s and Under 18s.

The club reached many cup finals across the teams including winning the North Bucks and District League Division One shield in 2018. In the final season under Buckingham United the ladies side really gave the club a wonderful finally winning the Northants Premier Division Title and League Cup double.

As a result of many meetings between the clubs, both Buckingham Athletic & Buckingham United formally agreed to pass the motion to combine both clubs, creating Buckingham Football Club, which now has one of the largest offerings of adult football in the region with a structured youth pathway with our strategic partners Moretonville Junior FC.

This is not an end to Buckingham Athletic or Buckingham United, this is very much a continuation in the story of these clubs and football within the town. The history of which won't be forgotten.

The ultimate aim of combining the clubs is to provide the town with a sustainable non-league football club by sharing resources, passionate volunteers, and great sporting facilities. A club with the aim of pushing up the pyramid while also providing structured football for the community, maintaining the fun and enjoyment of the game that everyone loves.
