We also offer **Claims Authentication** — third-party assurance that a sustainability claim has been substantiated through in-depth review. 2 GREEN BUILDING SCHEMES RECOGNITION

GECA standards are recognised by green building schemes such as the Green Building Council of Australia (GBCA), Infrastructure Sustainability Council (ISC), WELL Building Standard, National Australia Built Environment Rating System (NABERS) and Living Future Institute Australia (LFIA). It also aligns with some criteria requirements from Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED).

CERTIFICATION PROCESS

1

Pre-Application

Review the relevant GECA standard and meet with the GECA team to discuss the certification process.

You will then be sent the pre-assessment survey for you to complete, along with an ingredients template to fill out, to ensure you are ready for certification.

2

Request a Quote

Once your pre-assessment survey has been approved by the GECA team, you will be sent further details on how to obtain a quotation within the GECA Portal.

You will then receive an **obligation free** quote from our third-party Assurance Providers.

3

Accept Quote

Once you've received quotes from Assurance Provider Organisations, select one to conduct your assessment.

A one-off application fee of \$950+GST is payable to GECA prior to the commencement of the assessment.

This fee only applies if you are not an existing ecolabel licensee.

NEW CERTIFICATIONS

Once you approve the proposal, the assessment must be completed within 12 months from the date of allocation of assessor with the Assurance Provider. If the conformance assessment is not achieved within 12 months, you may be required to re-apply for certification and restart the assurance process, which will result in additional costs.

Note: if you need to address major non-conformances or exceptions that cannot be completed within the normal timeframe, a clearly defined extension period may be agreed on a case-by-case basis

CERTIFICATION PROCESS

4

Assessment

A **conformance assessment** is conducted.

All standards except, GECA's International Ecolabelled Products standard, **require an onsite audit**.

A verification report is produced as a result of the conformance.

All product information remains confidential.

5

GECA Certified

Upon completing your successful assessment, you will be awarded a **GECA licence certificate**.

You will receive a **licence agreement to sign**, the **GECA certified logos** with a brand guideline, and a **GECA Marketing Toolkit** to assist you in communicating your globally recognised GECA certification.

6

Recertification

To uphold your certification, an annual licence fee is required and **re-assessment is required every 3 years**.

This process is then repeated.

*Please note our Sustainable Products and Services (SP&S) standard requires an LCA and so the process differs to the above. You can view this certification process and learn more about this standard [here](#).

RE-CERTIFICATIONS

Please note; All licensees undergoing recertification must finalise their assessment before certificate expiry, and if the assessment has started but not yet finalised and the certificate expires, they must hold a current letter of support.

Only 2 x letters of support will be issued, valid for 3 months each giving an additional 6-months post expiry, and these will now be charged at \$500 + GST.

TIMING & INVESTMENT

The time required for the Audit Process varies and takes on average **6 months**, assuming all data and documentation have been provided. Please see conditions for completion of assessments on page 9 to 10.

Our pricing model aims to make GECA certification achievable and fair for all business sizes and sectors.

It is an annual fee reflective of that year and only the revenue of your GECA certified products. As a not-for-profit, revenue is put back into developing more standards and initiatives to create solutions for sustainable consumption and production.
