MR. ALPHEUS “HAWK” FINLAYSON

A LIFE OF ACHIEVEMENT, SERVICE, AND PASSION

Alpheus Finlayson was born in 1947 to parents Alpheus and Diana (née Deveaux) Finlayson, growing up in "The Valley" Nassau, Bahamas. Raised in Carew Street West, near the historic Birdland nightclub, he attended the Annex Baptist Church before the family moved to St. George's Anglican Church. His education began at Sands School and continued at St. Augustine's College in Nassau, where his athletic prowess began to shine.

In 1960, Finlayson began his athletic career by joining St. Bernard's Sporting Club, marking the beginning of a lifelong love for track and field. His first competition was in the 800 meters at St. Augustine's track during the Friends of the Bahamas competition. His early achievements included winning a bronze medal in the 400 meters at the Anglican Diocese Track Meet in 1961, followed by success in the long and triple jump events. He attended St. John's University in Minnesota, where he was a standout on the track team, excelling in the triple jump and co-captaining the team.

After graduating with a bachelor's degree in Mathematics in 1970, Finlayson started his career as a statistician at the newly formed Department of Statistics in the Bahamas. His career path eventually led him to the insurance industry, where he joined Imperial Life in 1980. By 1982, he had qualified for the prestigious Million Dollar Round Table, an achievement he maintained for five consecutive years, making him a Life Member. Throughout his career, Finlayson became a leader in the insurance industry, even serving as Vice President of the Life Underwriters Association of the Bahamas.

Parallel to his professional accomplishments, Finlayson was deeply involved in sports administration and promotion, particularly in track and field. Affectionately known as "Hawk," he dedicated himself to the growth of the sport, serving as President of the Bahamas Amateur Athletic Association (BAAA) from 1989 to 1997. His leadership helped to establish performance incentives for athletes and a subventions program supported by the government. Finlayson was also elected Vice President of the North American, Central American, and Caribbean Athletic Association (NACAC) in 1996 and made history in 1999 when he became the first Bahamian to be elected to the 27-member Council of the International Association of Athletic Federations (IAAF).

Over the course of his career, Finlayson traveled to every continent, attending five Olympic Games and all 13 IAAF World Championships between 1983 and 2013. His passion for track and field extended beyond administration—he was a historian, journalist, and promoter of the sport, producing a weekly column, *Track World*, in *The Tribune* from 1980 to 1986, and later publishing a book in 2009 titled, "From

Vancouver to Athens, Fifty Years of Bahamian International Track & Field Competition”, which became a local bestseller. He also hosted a weekly radio show, Track World with Alpheus Finlayson, and served as a media advisor for several major track and field events, including the 2014 IAAF World Relays held in the Bahamas.

Despite his numerous professional commitments, Finlayson remained committed to community service. His civic-mindedness led him to Rotary in 1982, where his leadership skills were quickly recognized. He served as President of the Rotary Club of West Nassau and was awarded a Paul Harris Fellowship in 1994 in recognition of his service. He was also a founding member of the local chapter of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, the first Black Greek-letter fraternity, serving as its president from 2006 to 2008.

Finlayson’s personal life was equally rich. He was married to his beloved wife, Dawn (née Rolle), for 44 years. The couple had three children: Levaughn, Wayne, and Alexis, though both sons tragically predeceased them. Their family, which includes six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren, worships at St. George’s Anglican Church, the very church that played a central role in Finlayson’s early years.

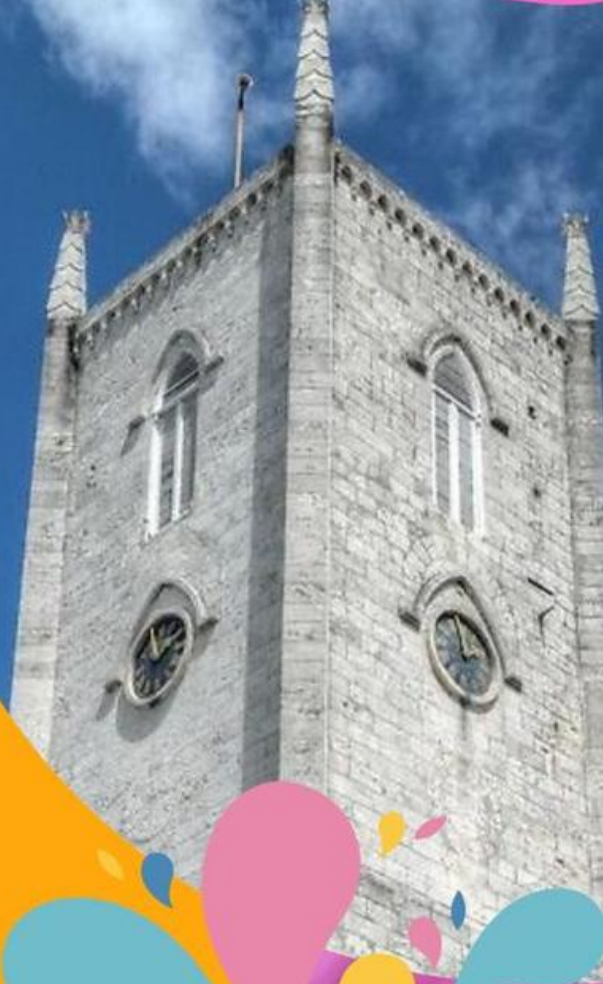
Throughout his life, Finlayson nurtured a deep love for jazz music, dancing, and traveling. To celebrate his 70th birthday in 2017, he organized Guitar Fantasy, a sold-out jazz concert. His interest in music, coupled with his love of meeting people from all walks of life, made him a true Renaissance man. Finlayson’s zest for life extended to frequenting jazz clubs around the world, where he immersed himself in the music and culture of different places.

As a lifelong servant to his community, Finlayson received numerous honors, including the prestigious Silver Jubilee Award for Sports Administration from the Bahamian government in 1998 and his induction into the Bahamas Sports Hall of Fame in 2013. His contributions to both sports and public service in the Bahamas have left a lasting legacy, cementing his place as one of the nation’s most respected figures.

Finlayson’s life is a testament to the power of dedication, whether in athletics, professional pursuits, or community service. From his beginnings in the "Valley" to his international contributions to track and field, he remains an enduring figure in Bahamian history, admired for his achievements and his unwavering commitment to uplifting others.

DAVIES FAMILY

The Sporting and Community Legacy of the Davies Family

The Davies family has left an indelible mark on Bahamian sport, church life, and culture, spanning multiple generations of leadership, talent, and service. From soccer fields to dance studios, from church vestries to Olympic delegations, their story is one of dedication to excellence, faith, and community.

Roscow A. L. Davies — Bahamian Soccer Legend & Mason

Roscow A. L. Davies stands out as a pioneer in Bahamian soccer and community leadership. A distinguished player, he later became instrumental in soccer administration, serving as President of the Bahamas Football Association for an unprecedented 25 years. His contributions extended beyond the pitch as Vice President of the Bahamas Olympic Committee, where he represented the nation as Chef de Mission for several Olympic and World Championship teams.

Peers described him as calm, precise, and deeply committed to both church and community life. In recognition of his influence, the Roscow R. A. L. Davies Developmental Center was named in his honor. His legacy also shone brightly within the Anglican Church, where he faithfully served as Treasurer of the Anglican Church Men, Vestry member, and Church Treasurer, as well as a vital part of the Discovery Team.

Kevin Davies — Player, Coach, and Church Leader

Carrying forward his father's legacy, Kevin Davies made his name as a striker with Cavalier FC and as a member of the St. George's Strikers in the early 1980s. He represented the Bahamas national team between 1986 and 2000, earning six caps and scoring two international goals. His impact grew even more as a coach. From 2011 to 2014, he served as Head Coach of the senior men's national team, guiding the Bahamas to a dominant performance in the 2014 FIFA World Cup CONCACAF preliminary round with a 10–0 aggregate win over Turks & Caicos Islands. He also coached youth teams at U-15 and U-17 levels, supporting both boys and girls programs, and later assisted the senior squad during the CONCACAF Nations League.

Beyond the pitch, Kevin has been a stalwart in community and church life. He served as President of the St. Ambrose Guild, was honored for his contributions to the Anglican Church Men, and continues to serve as a Lay Reader and Chalice Bearer, helping to lead worship and inspire others in faith.

Canon Stephen Davies — Mentor, Coach, and Multi-Sport Athlete

Canon Stephen Davies combined athletic versatility with mentorship. A leading player for the Dynamos Football Club in the late 1970s, he later joined Cavalier FC as a youth coach and player-manager of the Senior Men's team. He also mentored the St. George's Strikers youth squad, helping players transition into the senior league. His influence was not limited to soccer; he coached basketball at Mangrove Cay High School, led the Andros team in the inaugural Bahamas Games, and participated in softball, volleyball, and lawn tennis as both player and coach. His legacy reflects a passion for nurturing talent and building community through sport.

Trent Davies — Mentor and Church Leader

Trent Davies has been a dedicated member of the Cavalier soccer team throughout his childhood and young adult life. His passion for the sport continues as he now contributes to the team in a leadership role, assisting with coaching and mentoring younger players.

Beyond the soccer field, Trent serves as Vice President of the Anglican Young Adults and is actively involved in the life of the church. He is a Lay Reader and Chalice Bearer and a consistent presence in church activities, contributing his time and energy to the growth and spiritual life of the church community.

The Next Generations — Continuing the Legacy

The Davies legacy continues to thrive through the younger generations: Kaitlyn Davies represented the Bahamas on the Girls' U-15 national team in 2018 at the CONCACAF Championship in Florida. She later played collegiate soccer at St. Andrews University in North Carolina and remains active in church life through the Anglican Young Adults.

Stephen Davies II progressed through Cavalier's youth program in the 1990s before moving on to the senior team, continuing the family's strong soccer tradition.

Simone Davies-Seymour and Sydney Davies have carried the family's impact into the arts, each serving as members of the Dance Bahamas School and the National Dance Company for over 20 years, enriching Bahamian culture through performance and dedication.

Samuel Edwin Price Davies — The Foundation

The roots of this extraordinary family can be traced to Samuel Edwin Price Davies, father of Roscow A. L. Davies. A multi-talented athlete, he excelled in rugby, football, cricket, track, and field, becoming a sprint and long jump champion of The Bahamas. He was also a founding member of the Bahamas

Amateur Athletic Association (BAAA), laying the groundwork for national athletics long before his children and grandchildren built upon it.

The Davies family exemplifies the power of intergenerational commitment to faith, sport, and community. From Samuel’s pioneering role in athletics, to Roscow’s transformative leadership, to Kevin, Stephen and Trent’s coaching and mentorship respectively, and finally to the younger generations shaping today’s sporting and cultural landscape, their contributions remain a cornerstone of Bahamian life. Their story is not just one of athletic excellence but of service, leadership, and devotion—an enduring legacy for the nation and the church.

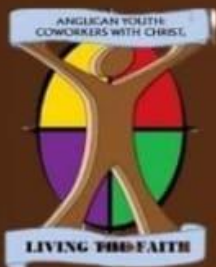

RULES & REGULATIONS

NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED

In addition to or as an amendment of the [DYD Hawk Classic Rule Book 2024](#), the following must be adhered to.

Division Teams must have one person from each church within the division participate. In Divisions with five churches, the alternate must be from the 5th church.

The New Providence Updated Divisions For the DYD Hawk Classic:

North	South	East	West
Saint Agnes (SA1) Saint Barnabas (SB) Christ Church (CC) Cathedral	Saint Ambrose (SA4) Saint Christopher (SC) Saint Matthew (SM) Saint Georges (SG)	Holy Cross (HC) Holy Trinity (HT)	

For Division events all participating churches qualify for the same number of points based on their position. All persons/churches that form the team will receive the same number of points. For example, participating division team members from the North Division (CCC, HS, SA1 & SM1) and cross the finish line first will all receive first place points (10 points each) for their respective churches (CCC, HS, SA1 & SM1). As St Matthews (SM2) in this instance would not have a participant they would not qualify for points.

Points Allocation

1st = 10	2nd = 8	3rd = 6	4th = 5
5th = 4	6th = 3	7th = 2	8th + = 1

Family/Multi Generation Categories will consist of (one) **7-14**, (one) **15-35**, (one) **36-50**, (one) **51+**

Family (teams) for the purpose of these games is not exclusively a genetic designation, though genetic affiliation is preferred, teams can be made up of either a traditional family or from the church family.

Walk events can have up to two (2) persons from one parish competing.

Participant Qualifications:

[Para Athlete Definition/Qualification](#)

Auxiliary Organisations (Sports Clubs, Brigades, Scouts, Guides etc) are welcome to participate in the Second Half (fun) events. However, the entire Church and/or event team can not consist of auxiliary members. We will accept 50% participation or less. NOTE: Submit your Auxiliary Club attendance roster with your initial registration (Friday, 19th August 2025) and no later than the Scratch Meeting, (Thursday, 25th August 2025). Persons registered on the day must be on the auxiliary or church membership roster submitted with the registration.

[Athlete Registration](#) Fee: \$12 per athlete. Up to three free volunteer coaches. New registrants on the day (no later than one hour before the event) \$12 plus \$2 late registration fee.
