SEEK: Giving Children the Wings They Need





Beach Cleaning Drive at Dadar, Mumbai

According to an article by National Geographic, a staggering 5.25 trillion pieces of plastic debris currently inhabit our oceans, with millions of tons floating on the surface and microfibers littering the deep sea.

The question is who is responsible for this disaster?

This dire situation is a direct consequence of the collective negligence of mankind towards proper waste management. As the population grows and urbanisation accelerates, consumption patterns and lifestyles have evolved, leading to a significant increase in plastic waste generation. A Bold Step Towards a TB-Free Future

In a groundbreaking move, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the TB Free India campaign, aiming to eliminate tuberculosis from the nation by 2025. This ambitious plan, set five years ahead of the target established by the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, underscores India's commitment to combating this deadly disease. With India recording 25.52 lakh tuberculosis cases in 2023, the highest globally, the urgency to address this public health crisis has never been more apparent.

Recognising the significance of this initiative, Sewa International took proactive steps to raise awareness on International Tuberculosis Day in Uttarakhand.

One of our primary focuses was on empowering adolescent girls with comprehensive information about tuberculosis– its causes, symptoms, and preventive measures. By equipping them with this essential knowledge, we aim to empower young women to take charge of their health and become advocates for tuberculosis prevention within their village.

In celebration of TB Awareness, Dr. Nidhi Bhardwaj, an ENT Surgeon from S.D.H Karnaprayag, joined us on a webinar emphasising the significance of early detection for prompt recovery from Tuberculosis (TB). Additionally, we also engaged children in interactive storytelling sessions and immersive role-playing activities to educate them about tuberculosis in a fun and engaging manner. By making learning about this disease an enjoyable experience, we instilled in them a sense of awareness and responsibility towards maintaining good health practices. Through these initiatives, we are playing a vital role in supporting India's efforts to achieve its goal of becoming TB-free by 2025. By raising awareness and educating individuals about tuberculosis, we are contributing to the larger goal of eliminating this disease from Bharat.
