



## Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship will be offered for the first time in 2024 with the intention of funding an Academic Scholarship for a resident of The Women's College.

The donation to The Women's College is an initiative of Ann Warrell Robilliard an alumna who resided from 1972 – 1974 at The Women's College.

The Terms of the Scholarship are as follows:

1. The name of the Scholarship shall be 'Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship' and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a resident of The Women's College who is enrolled or seeking to be enrolled at The University of Queensland in Brisbane.
3. In awarding the Scholarship, preference will be given to a student from rural or regional Queensland to assist with offsetting residential fees.
4. The Scholarship is awarded to a resident who will make a valuable contribution to the life of the College. The recipient must be an all-rounder demonstrating a combination of achievements and proven excellence in academia, sport and/or cultural pursuits, community service, and leadership.
5. The Scholarship will be awarded on achievements in the field of Science and proven excellence in academia.
6. The recipient of the Scholarship will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.
7. The Scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year only.
8. The Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:
  - a) is no longer enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland;
  - b) not maintaining high academic progress at university; or
  - c) is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
