

Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship will be offered for the first time in 2024 with the intention of funding an Academic Scholarship for a resident of The Women's College.

The donation to The Women's College is an initiative of Ann Warrell Robilliard an alumna who resided from 1972 – 1974 at The Women's College.

The Terms of the Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. The name of the Scholarship shall be 'Ann Warrell Robilliard Scholarship' and is awarded by The Women's College on the recommendation of the Head of College.
- 2. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a resident of The Women's College who is enrolled or seeking to be enrolled at The University of Queensland in Brisbane.
- 3. In awarding the Scholarship, preference will be given to a student from rural or regional Queensland to assist with offsetting residential fees.
- 4. The Scholarship is awarded to a resident who will make a valuable contribution to the life of the College. The recipient must be an all-rounder demonstrating a combination of achievements and proven excellence in academia, sport and/or cultural pursuits, community service, and leadership.
- 5. The Scholarship will be awarded on achievements in the field of Science and proven excellence in academia.
- 6. The recipient of the Scholarship will not be eligible for any other Women's College scholarship or bursary in that year.
- 7. The Scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year only.
- 8. The Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:
 - a) is no longer enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland;
 - b) not maintaining high academic progress at university; or
 - c) is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
