Level 7 Apprenticeship Funding Update

The Government have announced an update about the future of funding for Level 7 apprenticeships. Starting in January 2026, government funding for the Level 7 Advanced Clinical Practitioner Apprenticeship in England will be limited to individuals who are:

- **16-21 years old at the start of their apprenticeship.**
- **Under 25 for care leavers or those with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) at the start of their apprenticeship.**

We're currently looking closely at all the details of this announcement, including how it might affect situations like breaks in learning. We promise to give you another update as soon as we have more information from our HEI partners.

Current Situation: Please be assured that HEI's are still actively recruiting for the September 2025 intakes, and these programmes will largely run exactly as they have in previous years.

Current Funding Remains: It's important to note that the current funding model will continue to apply to all apprentices whose programmes start before the January 2026 deadline.
