Expanding on a strong legacy of service at OSLC, the newly formed OLSC Service Team is exploring ways to get out into the community and make a difference.

Some of the opportunities the team has taken so far include sorting food at Feeding America's Milwaukee warehouse, cleaning up a stretch of the bypass with the ongoing Adopt-A-Highway ministry led by John Swanson, and partnering with the Christmas Clearing Council to provide gifts for two families.

The youth have also been active in service, creating birthday bags for the Oconomowoc Food Pantry, cards for hospitalized kids and for Shorehaven, and providing blankets to children's hospitals and clinics with Project Linus.

delights. The Smorgasboard features Swedish meatballs, ham, turkey, lefse, rommegot, herring, rutabaga, salads, sweet breads, rice pudding, fruit soup and more. All are invited to come and eat!
