






HIGHWAY ACCESS

U.S. Route 101: U.S. 101 is the primary highway running through Newport and along the Oregon Coast. It connects Newport to other coastal towns and cities to the north and south.

Oregon Route 20: This highway connects Newport to Corvallis, Albany, and ultimately Interstate 5, which runs north-south through Oregon's interior. It provides an inland route to and from Newport.

Oregon Route 229: Also known as the Siletz Highway, Route 229 branches off from U.S. 101 near Toledo, southeast of Newport. It connects Newport to the Siletz area and provides an alternate route to inland destinations.

Oregon Route 34: Route 34 runs east-west and connects to U.S. 101 near Waldport, south of Newport. It provides access to communities such as Philomath and Alsea, offering an inland route to and from Newport.




AIRPORT PROXIMITY
