Course: Access to HE Diploma (Social Science)

Why did you choose to study the Access to HE (Social Science) Diploma?

Initially, I signed up to improve my GCSE English grade as I had been away from the workplace for quite a long time raising my children, and I was struggling to get a job without this essential qualification. Whilst on this course, quite a few of my classmates were also studying an Access to HE Diploma, so as my confidence grew, I decided that I want to better myself and work towards a professional career in education.

How has the Access to HE Diploma helped to you grow as a person?

Studying this course has completely changed me and my outlook on life. I have become more confident, not just in my studies but also in my everyday life. 3-4 years ago, I was suffering terribly with anxiety. Now, I hardly notice it, and I've learned to understand and control my anxiety. I have also found a new passion in life... psychology!

Have you had any really memorable moments?

I recently won a Student of the Month Award which made me feel really proud of my achievements. The confidence and knowledge that I've gained on a daily basis has been so rewarding alongside the progress I've made personally and in my education.

Have you been able to access any financial support?

The Advanced Learner Loan has been beneficial as I would never have been able to pay the fees in advance, so this has made a real difference to me personally.



What has been the biggest challenge for you?

Checking and proofreading my work has definitely been a challenge. With the possibility of Irlen Syndrome, it can be difficult to ensure accuracy in my academic writing.

Returning to the classroom as an adult learner, how have your tutors supported you?

I have been fully supported during the course especially in terms of guiding me academically. But, just as importantly, I have been supported emotionally. Having kids, something is always going on, but my tutors and peers have been there for me when I need advice and a kind ear. The support I have received around the diagnosis of a possible learning difficulty has also been incredible. I originally thought that I may have Dyslexia, however I am currently awaiting tests for Irlen Syndrome, a visual processing disorder, which has been arranged for me through college.

What's next for you?

I am planning to progress onto a dual honours degree in Psychology and Child Development at Staffordshire University in September. I am hoping to combine my passion for education and psychology, but still deciding on which pathway to choose - educational psychologist or psychology teacher.

Course: Level 1 Digital Skills

Why did you choose to study the Essential Digital Skills course?

I was a teacher for 30 years, and upon my retirement, I felt that I needed to improve my digital skills. I always felt that during my career that my skills in this area had not progressed at the same pace as others around me, so this course really appealed to me. I also wanted to study a course that would mean physically going out to college and meeting new people.

Stepping into college on your first day. How did you feel?

Perhaps because I had been a teacher, I felt OK on my first day as I was in my comfort zone to a degree. I really wanted to develop my IT skills, so I was very focused on learning and getting the most I could from the course. I can see why some people may feel nervous, but studying alongside other adults is nothing to be worried about.

What has been the most positive aspect of studying?

Definitely the learning environment at NSCG. The College is amazing! Everyone on the course felt valued and wanted to get involved. We supported each other and learnt new skills which was incredible. The conversations we had throughout the course covered many areas of life and much more and really made the course such a positive experience.

Has studying at NSCG given you a thirst for learning?

Definitely! I will keep up with my new skills at home and in the workplace using my new-found IT skills. So far in my new employment, I have been able to work alongside Min Charlesworth from NSCG's Multiply programme to



support clients at Stone Community Hub, which is something I can see developing further. I have decided to study the online Level 1 Award in Mental Health Awareness course with NSCG to widen my understanding of this subject area, which again will be a brilliant addition to my developing skills.

How has studying this course at NSCG changed your life?

I now feel braver and more confident when experimenting with my digital skills. I can apply my learning in my personal life such as creating Excel spreadsheets to help me to budget my finances. In terms of work, I get to apply the skills I've learnt to help others to feel empowered to learn a new skill.

What would you say to other adults in your position who are considering taking 'the leap' back into education or training?

Go for it! You're never too old or too young to learn. Follow your interests as that is always a good starting point in finding a course that interests you. Course: HNC Engineering

Why did you choose to study a university-level course at NSCG?

After completing my BTEC Level 3 course in Engineering at NSCG, I had a few options open up to me to take my education to the next level. The option that best suited me was the higher-level apprenticeship. I already knew the college well and the facilities are another level. I had forged great relationships with the teaching staff and peers, so this was the best choice for me personally and professionally. I work for Capula and they work really closely with NSCG to offer apprenticeships so the choice to study a higher education course was a no brainer.

What attracted you to studying at your local college rather than a traditional university provider?

I really enjoyed studying my Level 2 and Level 3 courses and the teaching style worked for me. The offering is industry-relevant and the lecturers know exactly which skills are needed for learners to grow and work towards successful careers.

How has studying the HNC changed your life and career so far?

How do your lecturers help you to gain the skills needed to stand out from the crowd in engineering?

The support I've received in college time and outside of college hours is impressive. I balance my studies with my full-time day job and my lecturers help me to cover the workload in a manageable and realistic way. The teaching staff are so focused on our success and help us to develop both the transferrable and specialist skills needed to feel confident to go for a promotion.

What's next for you?

I'm hoping to progress onto a degree in Leadership and Management in the near future to help me to go further in my career.

What would your advice be to anyone thinking of studying a university-level course part time at NSCG?

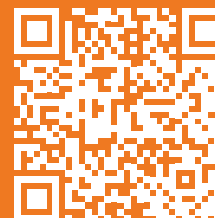

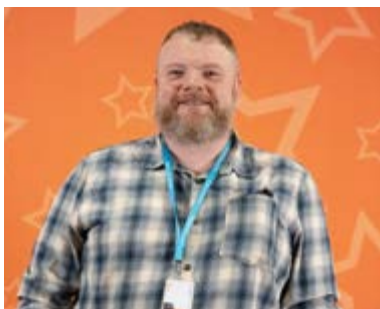

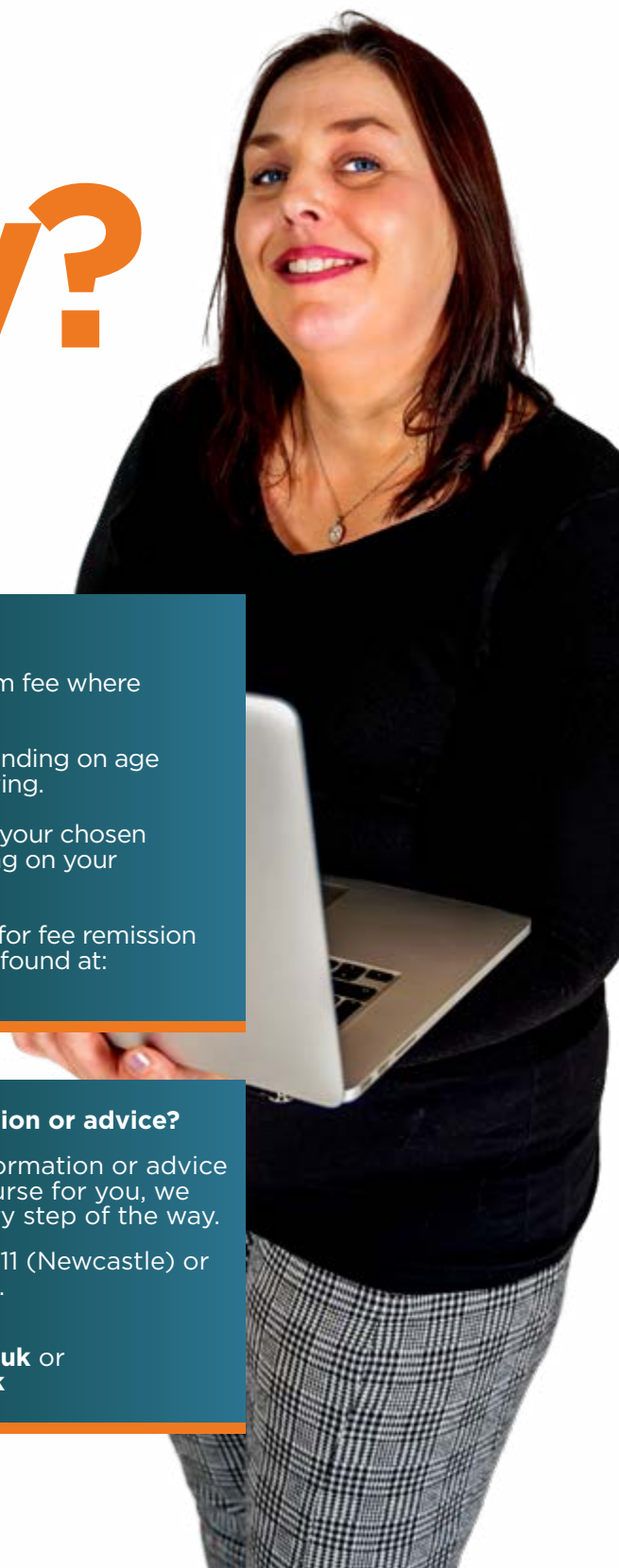
