He continued to faithfully steward the growth in Brazil and all across the Amazon. Students travel by foot, plane, and boat to learn sound theology and to be equipped to share the gospel all across their region.



WOBILE WARKET

This year we officially launched Venture Cares in our community. Your generosity provided everything we needed to open our new warehouse and purchase a new box truck, forklift, pallet jack, and other necessary tools that aid in the transportation and storage of the food we use to serve our guests.

In the first three months of food distributions, 1,150 honored guests shopped through the Venture Cares Mobile Market — adding up to approximately 5,000 people receiving food at no cost. With the help of our church family, Venture Cares was able to purchase \$30,000 in food to kickstart the market last fall.











"A few months ago, Venture Cares moved into an empty warehouse and completed a soft launch of the Mobile Market. Today, our volunteers are sorting and distributing thousands of pounds of food and are serving 200 families a week. I couldn't have asked for a better response from the community, our partners, and most importantly, our church family.

When this ministry was presented, you responded to the call with love, compassion, and excitement. 181 volunteers have undergone training. On average, we have 40 volunteers serving at food distributions and 19 volunteers serving in the warehouse weekly.

YOUTH

Impactful trips like our Spring Retreat and Summer Camp allow students to grow in their relationship with Christ, resulting in many of them answering the call to ministry last summer. Many students find a sense of security and belonging in our youth group as a result of intentional mentoring and relationships.







Collaborating with FCA leaders is resulting in positive impacts. We have initiated a new Bible study program Wednesday mornings at 6:30 AM at Naples High School. Collaborating with FCA leaders is leading to positive impacts in our community through events, huddles, and Bible studies.






Our young adults served FSW students during finals by providing drinks and praying with them. They attended Passion Conference in Atlanta, where they were empowered to live boldly for Christ.

KIDS

Last year, families gathered together for different Venture Kids events. Parents and kids enjoyed picnics at different community parks and fun in the sun at local water parks. We launched a Connect Group that provided childcare – allowing parents to build new relationships and learn strategies to confidently lead their children in a growing relationship with Jesus.

Over 100 children are now enrolled in the Venture Kids Sunday morning experience. We are rejoicing that eight children were dedicated to the Lord this year.

SUNDAY SERVICES

Venture grew 27% in 2023! That means more people are hearing the gospel, learning a Biblical worldview, and joining life-giving community. Children are being taught the Bible, people are serving consistently, and our church family is leaning in during worship to praise God.

Last Easter we went to three services as 564 people, our highest attended service, came to celebrate the resurrection with us.


















75 people participating in Connect Groups

\$562,000 was invested in global missions through Leadership Outreach and our other missions partners


We invested \$250,000 to fund our Venture Cares Warehouse & Mobile Market needs to serve our community

We sponsored \$11,000 for counseling services through our partnership with Southwest Florida Christian Counseling


In 2023, an additional **\$1,500,000** was committed to our Imagine Campaign for the future home of Venture Church.























