FOLLOW CCA UPDATES

FOLLOW FLEMING ISLAND CAMPUS LAUNCH



One of our Rooted initiative objectives is to grow the local church. The local church is the hope of the world and God's plan to multiply the Gospel. We are doing this by reviving and planting healthy local churches that reach and impact their community for Jesus.

In addition to prayer and building a church partner database, one of our first steps of this initiative is launching our Fleming Campus to become a fully autonomous local church that is self-funding, operating their own ministry programming, guided and served by their own leadership and under a new independent church name (to be announced soon).

IT MAKES SENSE that one of the first priorities of this initiative would be our Fleming Campus. Clay County is a rapidly growing community, projected to increase from 227,000 to more than 300,000 in just over a decade. After 18 years as a multi-site, there are countless opportunities for growth and multiplication that Fleming can pursue as an independent local church to make an even greater Kingdom impact within a growing community.

Pastor Lucas Johnson will remain as the Lead Teaching Pastor surrounded by a transition management team comprising of Josh Serre, Tom Shelton, Todd Bussey, Ken Marquis and Mike Speer. This team is tasked with helping to plan and ensure a successful launch.

TRANSFORM DISCIPLESHIP & MARRIAGES

It's truly exhilarating to witness the incredible movement of God in Spain. For those who joined the trip in July, the experience was a powerful reminder that **HIS SPIRIT IS ON THE MOVE!** Over 70 dedicated volunteers traveled more than 18,000 miles to cover all 17 regions of Spain in prayer. Not only did we visit the 54 major cities we planned, but we also reached 61 additional cities with populations over 5,000 that lack an evangelical presence.

There are now 55 vibrant house churches operating throughout Spain! This is just the beginning. Five more churches in the US have joined our mission and we're diligently working on a 10-year plan that includes a student trip scheduled for May 2025 and another prayer and evangelism event in the southern part of Spain next summer.

BAKER RE-ENTRY

We've experienced remarkable growth since the launch of the Baker Re-Entry prison church plant on November 5, 2023. Attendance has grown from 10 to an average of 35 men each Sunday and the Discipleship Class that started with 8, now hosts 32 men every Tuesday.



WE ARE GRATEFUL for our 85 Prison Ministry volunteers. Their dedication, along with your support, is making a life-changing impact.

The Assistant Warden has invited us to develop new programs on mental health, family reunification and a Grief Share program starting in January 2025.

This year, our Christmas Shop includes the opportunity for the men at Baker Re-Entry Center to pick gifts from a registry for their children/grandchildren. The Christmas Shop will host a party for the children to receive the gifts.

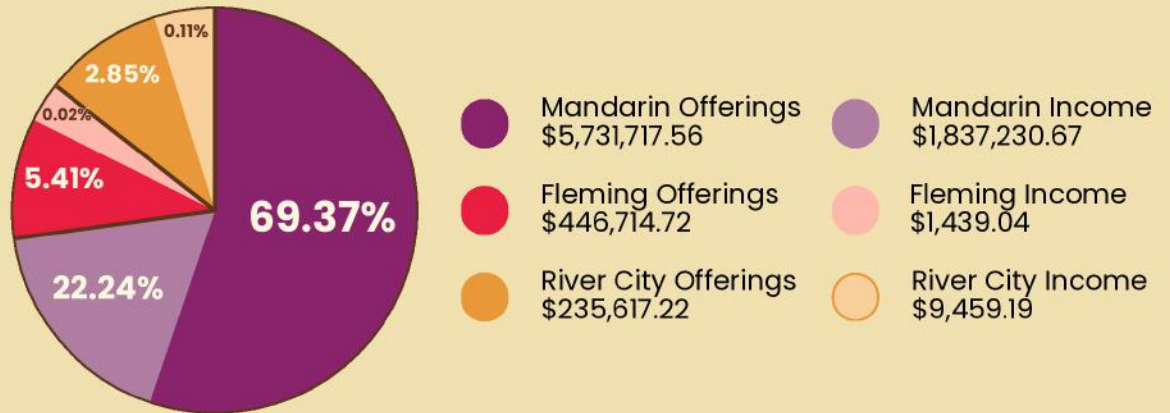
At Christ's Church, we believe that stewardship and transparency are at the heart of our mission.
