


#### **BHM Professional Talk Series -**

Attendees of the online seminar gained knowledge of essential skills and techniques, as well as guidance on career planning in this dynamic field.







## Visit to Hong Kong Monetary Authority Information Centre

On 12 November 2024, a visit to the Hong Kong Monetary Authority Information Centre was organised for Business Management students. This visit provided an overview of the central bank's history and operations, enhancing students' practical understanding of financial services. The experience aimed to integrate theoretical knowledge with real-world applications in finance.
