




The Health Partners Program

Promise for Haiti supports healthcare in Pignon through the Health Partners Program. First, staff member John Robert identifies families according to financial need. Doctors provide tests, medication, surgeries, and hospitalization as needed for both preventative and urgent healthcare. The invoice is then forwarded to Promise for Haiti and paid out of the Health Partners fund. In partnership, Our Savior's sponsors ten Haitian families. The team received gratitude and thanks from the families when visiting during the trip.

All cookie sales will be supporting the OSLC youth for their trip to the New Orleans 2024 ELCA Youth Gathering from July 16 -20.


YOUTH COOKIE WALK DECEMBER 10 FOLLOWING CONCERT

"It is a time and a place to acknowledge your true feelings of grief, sadness, and isolation, and to know you are not alone. It's a place for your reality to be honored."






Mission Possible **EVERYONE IS** WELCOME HERE






ADVENT AT OSLC
