Sustainability strategist:

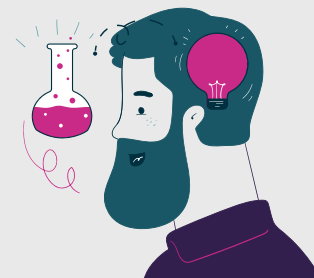
" I've been working on integrating and introducing workshops to upskill colleagues on sustainability.

Media & Communications Manager:

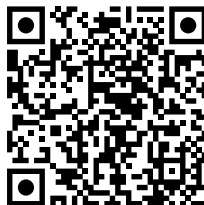
" It's not all lab work, there's so much more to the pharmaceutical industry – so many roles that you can get into.
