PLASMAFER THE MOSAIC INTERVIEW

Following our monthly interview trend, this month we had the opportunity to interview Plasmater! His comedic sketch videos and energetic styling have earned him a sizable viewership, amassing a massive 2.1 million likes and 12 million views on TikTok.

How went one on one with Plasmafer, diving deep into the topics surrounding content creation and VRChat as a whole. (We even went on a tangent about trading card games and Magic The Gathering).

Howl: How long have you been doing content creation for VRChat specifically?

Plasmafer: If I kept going until September this year, I think it would have been 2 years

H: So 12 million views in 2 years, thats honestly pretty unheard of for a lot of creators.

P: Well the first year was maybe just 1 million and then I just had a good year [...] if only I learned how to monetize it, you know?

H: Do you have any advice for future content creators, or people that are just starting off?

P: First is the easiest one, its the grind. Grind grind grind, the more you post the more eyes that are going to see you





P (continued): The second one, I gotta say though, is when it comes to editing take your time, you see so many people make so many of the dumbest mistakes, [...] go over your grammar on your captions and everything, people may not realize its important but it is, unless you have a video blow up and your grammar's wrong so now you're getting dogged on for three months straight for fucking up your grammar. [...] If you're starting out with TikTok, its really easy if you follow trends, but don't just follow trends, because your audience is just going to fall off at that point.

H: If it wasn't VRChat, what would have been your creative outlet?

P: Probably still would have been videos, I was never a fan of the side entertainment things I've tried. Like, radio show host was alright, but it started to hurt my voice every now and then and having to put on the announcer voice 24/7 kinda sucked. [...] It was rough, and obviously having all those guidelines you gotta follow, I don't like that, I like to have freedom. But I honestly probably would have started posting car vids and stuff, I probably would have been part of the car community.

H: [...] being digital creators, we have the ability to separate our real life and our virtual life, how do you feel thats an advantage versus a standard streamer?

P: Having the advantage of just having it separate from our real lives, the only thing I've ever had to deal with is one time someone recognized my voice. [...] It's great being able to go out and do fun activities and everything and I don't have to worry about being hounded or dealing with that weird parasocial relationship.
