## Campaign Kick-Off Event a Success!

Enthusiasm filled the room at last Sunday's Campaign Kick-Off, marking the official launch of the *Rebuild 2 Serve* campaign and its critical Advance Gifts Phase.

More than 120 attendees gathered for an afternoon of food, fellowship, and shared purpose, listening as detailed plans for the campaign were unveiled.

Encouragement was strong, with over \$700,000 already pledged at the time of the event—an excellent start.

Personal outreach for gift commitments now begins, starting with a small group invited to prayerfully consider leadership-level contributions.

Those not included in this phase will have the opportunity to make their commitment during Commitment Weekend on May 30–31.

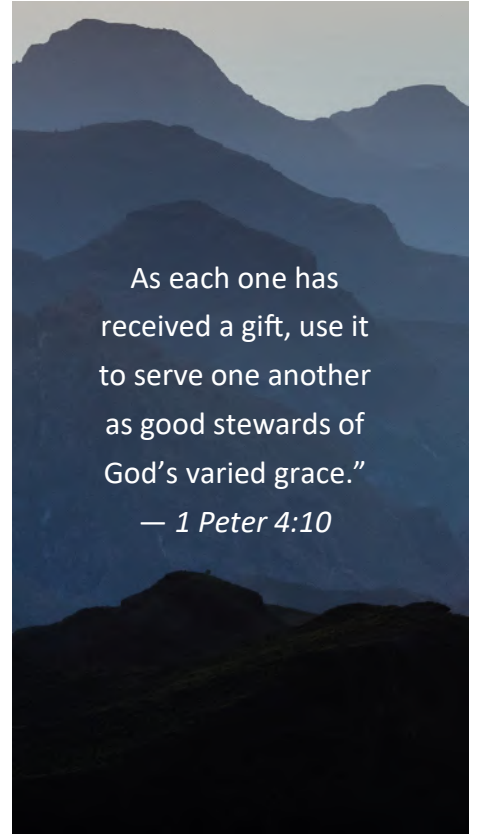

# Financial News

**Our Rebuild 2 Serve campaign's purpose** is to raise a minimum goal of \$6.0 million. This amount, **plus** the \$2.8 million raised in the previous campaign will enable us to demolish the existing build and begin construction on the new Parish and Child Development Center and enable us to complete the first-floor plans with some debt.

Setting the ultimate goal for this campaign of \$8.0 million, **plus** the \$2.8 million previously raised will enable us to complete the first floor of the building without debt and begin planning the second-floor buildout.

## Giving Options

To help us reach our full financial potential, all parishioners and friends of our church are invited to consider a special gift above and beyond their regular contributions. Campaign gifts may be made in several ways:

**Pledges** allow you to spread your gift over three years, making it more manageable while playing a vital role in achieving our goal. Payments can be made monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, or annually by cash,

credit card, or direct debit. An initial payment of 10% or more is encouraged.

**Non-Cash Gifts\*** provide another meaningful way to give. These may include in-kind contributions such as labor or materials; securities like stocks, bonds, or IRA rollovers; real estate; or valuable personal property such as artwork, collectibles, jewelry, or vehicles.

**Deferred Gifts\*** offer future support through arrangements made today. These can include life insurance policies, certain trust agreements, or bequests through your will.

\*All non-cash and deferred gifts are subject to diocesan approval prior to acceptance.

# Giving Opportunities

A variety of special giving opportunities are available for donors at designated levels. These opportunities illustrate how gifts at different amounts can support our church's needs and offer a meaningful way to honor or remember a loved one.

*The listed amounts are not intended to reflect actual costs, but rather the significance of each opportunity, our priorities, and the giving capacity of our community. While these commitments may be fulfilled over a three-year period, recognition will be provided once the gift is fully received.*
