



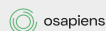

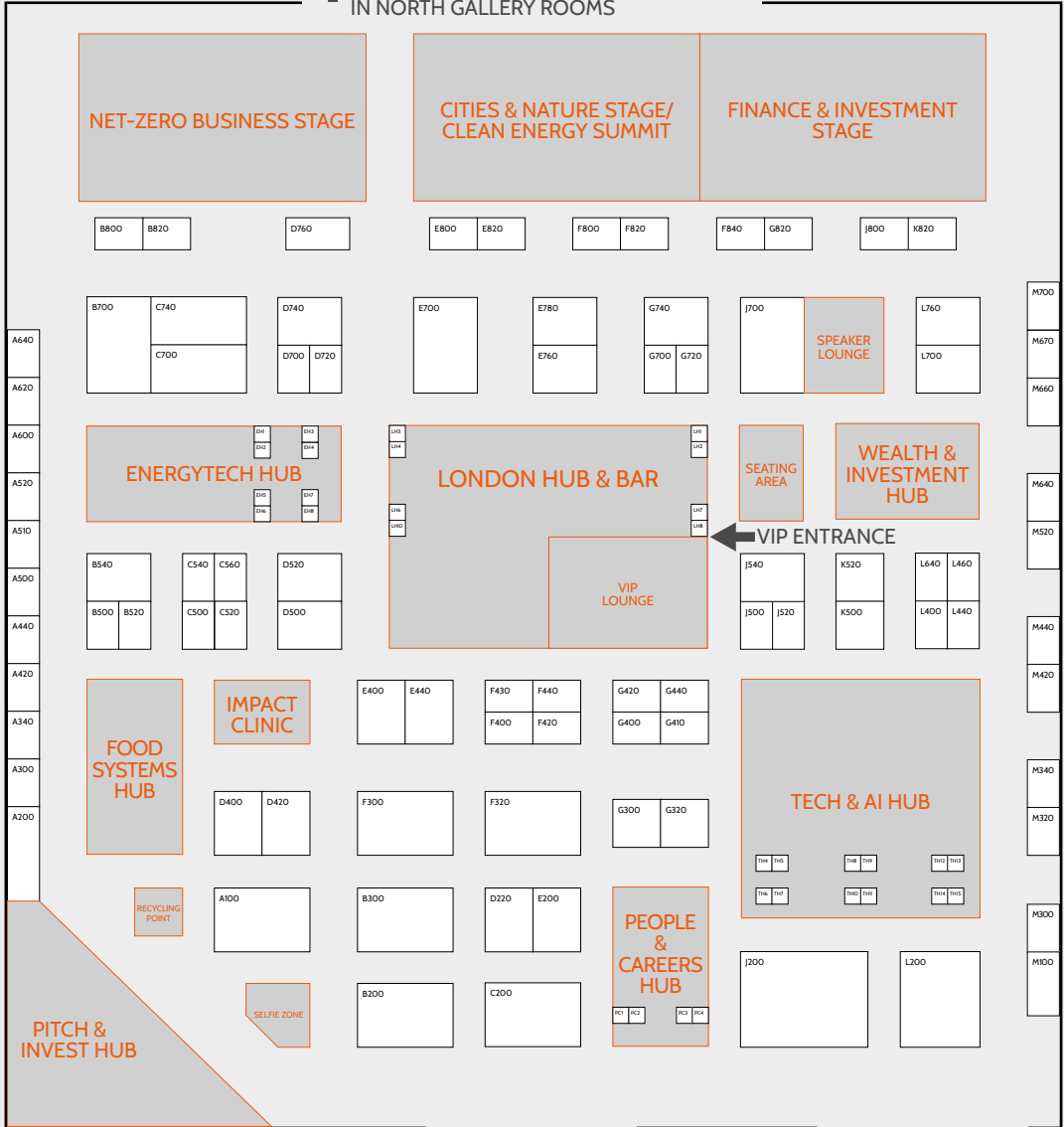

OUR SUSTAINABILITY COMMITMENTS

Our goal is to help educate and bring people together to transition their businesses and sectors to a more sustainable model as we head towards net-zero. This means doing our part too.

Last year's event was verified as carbon neutral by Green Circle Solutions.



Reset Connect 2024's emissions have been offset by TreeApp



This year we have taken the following measures:

Venue

- We chose ExCeL, London as a carbon-neutral certified venue running on 100% renewable electricity. They offset the gas, fuel, waste and water for us. They have operated a zero-waste-to-landfill policy for over a decade and house the UK's largest commercial wormery to compost food waste.

Low / No Emission Suppliers

- All suppliers have been chosen for zero or minimal emissions by using reusable stands, furniture, living floral features, digital over print, removing carpet on areas with low dwell times. All materials are reusable, compostable or recyclable.

Attendee Contributions

- With water fountains available on the boulevard throughout ExCeL there should be no need for single use plastic water bottles
- Badges and lanyards are collected for recycling and re-use
- 3 stream recycling points are available throughout the event and boulevard
- We requested attendees to use public transport where possible to keep emissions down
- We requested exhibitors to be mindful of the giveaways and materials on their stands to avoid unnecessary waste

Travel and Offsetting

- We requested all participants consider their emissions when shipping goods, providing staff, choose local, etc. However, what cannot be reduced we are offsetting with carbon capture and removal projects.

Impact

- With all content aimed at helping businesses get the tools and insights they need to create positive impact in their own organisations, this is also a social impact contribution for Reset Connect. We are looking at how best to measure this.

We have signed up for the Net Zero Carbon Events Pledge to commit to being net-zero by 2050. We will be releasing our event sustainability report and making this publicly available after the event and welcome any suggestions or feedback for improving our efforts.

BETTER STANDS INITIATIVE

Reset Connect are proud to be a part of this industry pilot programme aiming to ensure that all core elements of exhibitor stands are reusable to improve the ease, safety and sustainability of the exhibitor experience at events.



The initiative is designed to eliminate disposable stands that are only used once at a single event. They are typically constructed from poor quality raw materials onsite which are then demolished post-show and sent to either landfill or burnt for energy.

The Better Stands programme has been divided into three key stages – Bronze, Silver and Gold. This helps facilitate a gradual transition from disposable to reusable stands for all exhibitors.

All Exhibition Pods, Enhanced Pods, Standard Stands and Enhanced Stands at Reset Connect London are constructed by Whitespace, and comply to meet the framework's gold standard.

How do you define a better stand?

Stands are classified into categories depending on the particular elements that are used or recycled.

All elements of a particular structure category must be shown to be reused or recycled in order to achieve that classification. If a stand does not meet all the elements in the bronze level then it is classified as disposable.

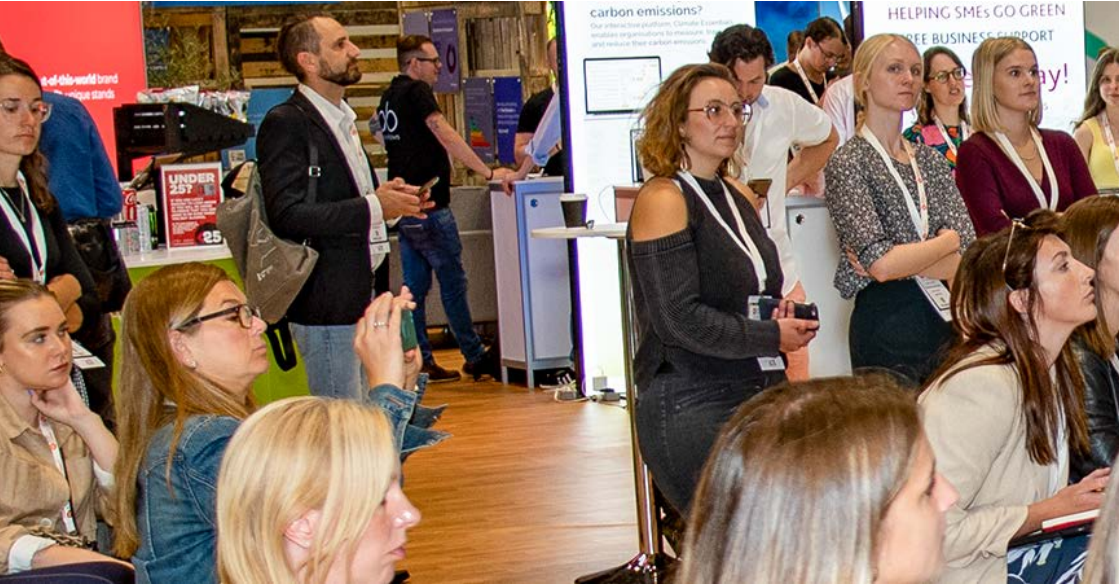

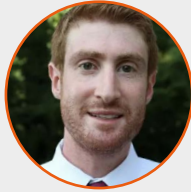

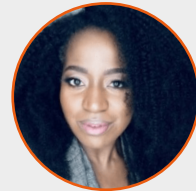
