
# **GUITAR CERTIFICATES**




















# HUGE CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR NEW WORLD CHAMPION JUDE!

We are so incredibly proud of Jude in Y7, he recently returned from the World Kickboxing Championships in England with a gold, two silvers and one bronze medal.

Jude was part of a team of five young people aged nine to sixteen from Lurgan's Fight Club NI who punched well above their weight to bring home a medal haul of 11 golds, 14 silvers and four bronzes, finishing 10th out of 150 clubs, which was a remarkable achievement as they were one of the smallest clubs at the championships. Jude trains three nights per week at the club and this world title is a result of hard work and determination.






# **6H - NUMERACY**
